Zero deaths from COVID

Zero deaths from the coronavirus (COVID-19) were registered yesterday by the Ministry of Health.

The overall number of lives taken by COVID-19 in the Kingdom remained at 316.

Out of 11,413 tests conducted yesterday, 232 new cases were detected.

These included 51 expatriate workers, 172 contacts of active cases, and nine travel-related cases.

There were additional 289 recoveries.

The total number of active cases in the Kingdom rose to 80,765.

Inspectors from the UN's atomic watchdog have confirmed Iran has started building an underground centrifuge assembly plant after its previous one exploded in what Tehran called a sabotage attack over the summer, the agency's head said yesterday.

Iran also continues to stockpile greater amounts of low-enriched uranium, but does not appear to possess enough to produce a weapon, Rafael Grossi, director-general of the Inter-

national Atomic Energy Agency revealed. Following the July explosion at the Natanz nuclear site, Tehran said it would build a new, more secure, structure in the mountains around the area. Satellite pictures of Natanz analysed by experts have yet to show any obvious signs of construction at the site in Iran's central Isfahan province.

"They have started, but it's not completed," Grossi said. "It's a long process." He would not give further details, saying it's "confidential information".

Iran's mission to the United

Nations did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Natanz hosts the country's main uranium enrichment facility. In its long underground halls, centrifuges rapidly spin uranium hexafluoride gas to enrich uranium. Natanz became a flashpoint for Western fears about Iran's nuclear programme in 2002, when satellite photos showed Iran building an underground facility at the site, some 200 km (125 miles) south of the capital, Tehran. In 2003, the IAEA visited Natanz, which Iran said would house centrifuges for

its nuclear programme, buried under some 7.6 metres (25 feet) of concrete. That offers protection from potential airstrikes on the site, which also is guarded by anti-aircraft positions.

Natanz had been targeted by the Stuxnet computer virus previously, which was believed to be a creation of the US and Israel. Iran has yet to say who it suspects of carrying out the sabotage in the July incident.

Suspicion has fallen on Israel as well, despite a claim of responsibility by a previously unheard-of group at the time.

Nine days alone!

Baby abandoned and left to die

● Mother thought four-month-old son was with his father

A four-month-old baby in Egypt has died after both his parents left him alone for nine days in the house.

According to report, the incident happened in Qalyubia, when the 28-year-old father and 24-year-old mother abandoned their child, Anas, for nine days. Both have been arrested. According to the report, the wife lied to her husband after an argument with him,



and left the house with her elder son, saying she was going to buy groceries. She instead went to her parents' house.

The husband, on the other hand, went to work, which causes him to be away from home for a week or more. When he returned, he found that the

baby had died.

He reported the matter to the police and accused the mother of abandoning the baby.

The mother said that she thought the baby was with his father, who had in turn left the apartment thinking she will return, but she didn't.

Defamation suit against Trump to proceed

A federal judge yesterday denied the Justice Department's effort to effectively end a defamation lawsuit against President Donald Trump brought by a longtime magazine columnist who has alleged he raped her in a luxury department store dressing room, paving the way for the case to proceed.

The DOJ had sought to intervene in the case and substitute itself as defendant in the lawsuit filed by E. Jean Carroll, a move that likely would have curbed the proceedings, since the federal government can't

be sued for defamation.

Writing in her 2019 book, Carroll claimed Trump raped her in a dressing room at a luxury Manhattan department store in the 1990s. Shortly after Carroll's allegations became public, Trump denied them, telling reporters, "She's not my type," and accusing Carroll of lying to boost her book sales.

Hit-and-run driver remanded

A 21-year-old man, who is accused of being involved in a hit-and-run accident last week that left four persons dead and three others severely injured, has been remanded by the Public Prosecution pending further investigations.

Traffic Prosecution Chief Mohammed Al Dhahrani said that the prosecution interrogated the suspect and explained to him the charges he is facing.

Al Dhahrani said that the Public Prosecution received a report on a traffic accident that took place on Wali Al Ahad Road in the Northern Governorate.

"The details of the accident indicate that the accused was driving his vehicle in a way that exposes his life and the lives of others to danger, and he was bypassing the vehicles in a wrong way, as he overtook the victim's vehicle from the left lane to the right lane," Al

Dhahrani explained.

"The victim attempted to avoid collision and he turned to the right of the street on the unpaved road, which led to his loss of control of the vehicle and his deviation to the left strongly.

"The uncontrolled vehicle moved onto the middle pavement and then onto the opposite direction of the road, where another vehicle collided with the victim's car, led to its overturning and jamming the passengers inside the wrecked

car. This resulted in the death of four people on the site."

According to Al Dhahrani, three other people sustained severe injuries and were rushed to the hospital, while the suspect didn't stop and escaped the scene. However, he was later identified and arrested, as confirmed by the General Directorate of Traffic last Thursday.

Al Dhahrani added that the necessary procedures are being taken to refer the case to the concerned court.

Efforts paying off

Bahrain ‘most serious’ Arab country in fight against money laundering

● Kingdom ranked second in the Middle East

Bahrain was ranked first in the Arab world, and second in the Middle East, in terms of the least risk of exposure to the crime of money laundering and terrorist financing, according to the annual Basel Index for Combating Money Laundering.

Bahrain has a risk score of 4.41 points – according to the report, which is considered the only independent indicator issued by a non-profit organisation, and classified countries according to money laundering risks.

The Kingdom came second in the Middle East after Israel, with 3.62 points, in the field of combating money laundering. Egypt is in third position with 4.96 points, while Saudi Arabia and Lebanon are ranked fourth and fifth, respectively, with identical 5.33 points.

Countries with high scores, based on a 10-point scale, are classified as having a significant risk of money laundering and terrorist financing.

Among the riskiest countries in the Middle East include Tu-

nisia (6th), Morocco (7th), Qatar (8th), UAE (9th), Jordan (10th), Algeria (11th) and Yemen (12th).

The report indicates that risk levels in the Middle East region are higher than the global average in all areas.

The report urges hard work to improve its performance in all categories, especially those related to public accountability, as well as financial secrecy.

According to the report, Latin America was the weakest region in the world in terms of combatting corruption and bribery, as

90% of its countries are listed, with the US as frontiers for money laundering crimes.

The Basel Anti-Money Laundering Index is an independent annual classification that assesses the risks of money laundering and terrorist financing around the world.

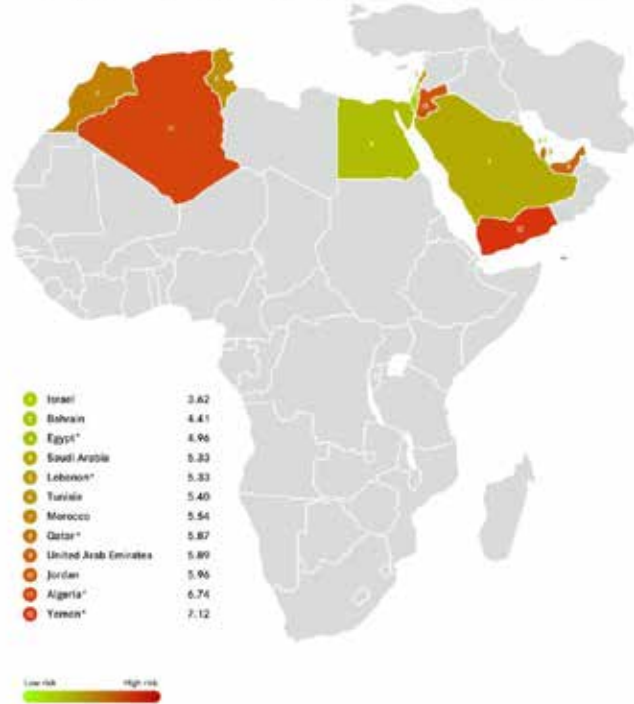

Oman, the report said, would shrink 4.9pc this year respectively from the contraction of 4.7pc in July. Oman is expected to grow 2.5pc next year, versus a July estimate of 3.0pc, and 2.7pc in 2022.
“Things are looking less favourable, particularly for leisure and tourism,” Maya Senussi, senior economist at Oxford Economics, said on Oman.
“Non-residents are still barred from visiting as we head into the peak season,” she said, adding analysts generally have a clearer view of how the dual shock has influenced activity.

Oil rises towards \$41

Oil rose yesterday towards \$41 a barrel as oil companies shut down some US Gulf of Mexico oil output due to a hurricane, although surging coronavirus infections and rising Libyan supply limited gains.
Companies including BP, Chevron and Equinor ASA evacuated rigs, and so far producers have shut 16 per cent, or 293,656 barrels per day (bpd) of oil output due to Hurricane Zeta.
Brent crude was up 20 cents, or 0.5. per cent, at \$40.66 per barrel by 1344 GMT. US oil gained 18 cents, or 0.5pc, to \$38.74. Both contracts fell more than 3pc on Monday.
“Whilst Hurricane Zeta could provide a price relief under the current circumstances, it will be very brief,” said Tamas Varga of oil broker PVM. “The mood is, indeed, souring.”
Oil has declined because of rising coronavirus infections

globally and a lack of progress on agreeing a US coronavirus relief package. Still, US House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi is hopeful a deal can be reached before the Nov. 3 election.
“The rising number of infections, lockdowns and travel restrictions is a serious threat,” said Paola Rodriguez-Masiu of Rystad Energy. “The situation at the moment looks more pessimistic than not.”
Libyan production is expected to reach 1 million bpd in coming weeks, the country's national oil company said on Friday, complicating efforts by other OPEC members and allies to restrict output.
The Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and allies, known as OPEC+, are planning to increase production by 2 million bpd from January after record output cuts this year.
But Russian President Vladimir Putin, speaking last Thursday, did not rule out extending the cuts for longer.

◆ **At least seven students were killed and scores more wounded Tuesday in a bomb attack on a Koran study class at a religious school in northwestern Pakistan, officials said.** More than 60 people had been taking a lesson when the explosion tore through the madrassa in Peshawar, about 170 kilometres (around 100 miles) west of Islamabad, said Waqar Azim, a senior police official. “The blast took place in a seminary during a Koran class. ◆ **Nearly 230,000 tonnes of plastic is dumped into the Mediterranean Sea every year**, a figure which could more than double by 2040 unless “ambitious” steps are taken, the International Union for the Conservation of Nature said yesterday. Egypt, Italy and Turkey are the countries that release the most plastic into the sea, mainly due to large coastal populations and huge amounts of “mismanaged waste,” an IUCN report found.

Prime Minister Yoshihide Suga has pledged to provide enough vaccines for the coronavirus for the public by mid-2021. Japan has struck deals for hundreds of millions of doses from companies including AstraZeneca Plc and Pfizer Inc.

Gunmen kill ‘wanted’ Yemeni rebel minister

Unidentified gunmen in Yemen’s rebel-held capital Sanaa shot dead a Huthi government minister as he drove his car, also wounding his daughter, officials said yesterday.

Hassan Zaid, minister for youth and sports in the Huthi administration, was wanted by the Saudi-led coalition, which had offered a \$10 million bounty for information leading to his arrest.

In 2017, Zaid sparked anger when he proposed suspending school for a year and sending pupils and teachers to the frontline instead.

The Huthi interior ministry said Zaid was driving his car when it was shot at, leading to his “martyrdom” after suffering serious injuries.

Israel to approve settler homes

Israel is set to approve construction of Jewish settler homes in a flashpoint area of the West Bank city of Hebron for the first time since 2002, the anti-occupation group Peace Now said Tuesday.

It condemned what it called an attempt to “squeeze in” the approvals before next week’s US presidential election when Donald Trump faces Democratic challenger Joseph Biden, who views such settlements as illegal.

Peace Now, which tracks settlement construction in the occupied territory, said Israeli military authorities had given the green light to the construction of 31 settler housing units “in the heart of Hebron”.

Brazilian says ‘no regrets’ for killing 48 fellow inmates

A thief-turned-serial killer nicknamed Iago has been blamed for murdering 48 other inmates during his 25 years behind bars in Brazil. First jailed for petty theft as a teenager in 1993, the 41-year-old Marcos Paulo da Silva is known to cut off the heads of his fellow inmates before disembowelling their bodies.

In one case he is said to have murdered five inmates in one go in Serra Azul Jail in Sao Paulo in 2011 in the deadliest attacks to date.

He now faces dying behind bars himself after a killing spree left him with multiple convictions and jail terms totalling 217 years, although according to local media he has yet to be tried for many of his crimes.

Da Silva is said to have told a judge recently he has no regrets about killing all these people.

“They were rapists and thieves who took advantage of other inmates and robbed them.”

While he has officially been charged with carrying out six murders and ordering the killings of two others, he told the judge that he had killed as many as 48 inmates in state prisons.

Psychologists who have evaluated da Silva say his killing career began in prison, after he had never been convicted of any murders on the outside.

His astonishing prison history was laid bare in a recent report by Brazilian online firm UOL which was picked up by newspapers in South America and Portugal.

He has been described as the leader of a gang known as the PCC, one of Brazil’s leading gangs said to have been formed by inmates as a self-protection group in response to the country’s brutal prison system.

Da Silva switched allegiances and turned against the PCC after joining the gang as a 19-year-old following a teenage conviction.

He quit the group because it started to focus on capitalism, profit and abandoned the struggle for the ‘freedom of the prison population’, according to news magazine UOL.

Prison guards told UOL it was only a ‘question of time’ before da Silva, covered in tattoos which include

Malnutrition among young children has soared to the highest levels ever recorded in parts of war-torn Yemen, the UN said yesterday, as coronavirus and shortfalls in aid funding worsen a humanitarian crisis. More than half a million cases of acute malnutrition among children under five were recorded in the south, and the results of a survey of the north currently under way are expected to be “equally concerning”, it said.

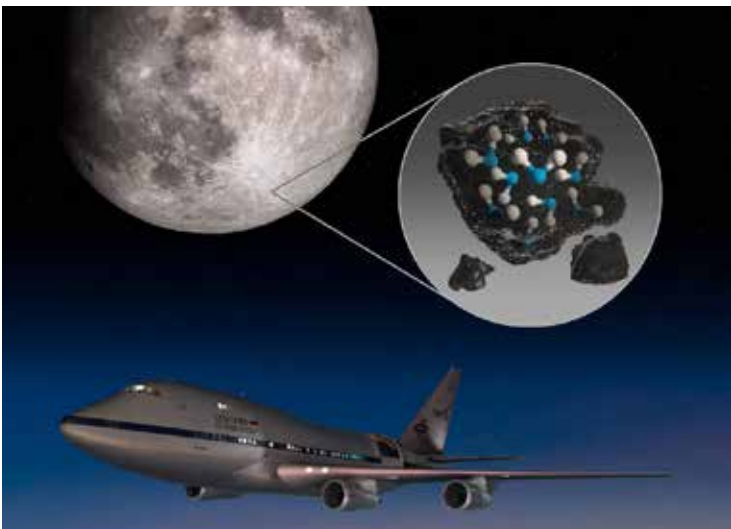
NASA’s SOFIA discovers water on the Moon

● **SOFIA has detected water molecules (H2O) in Clavius Crater**

NASA’s Stratospheric Observatory for Infrared Astronomy (SOFIA) has confirmed, for the first time, water on the sunlit surface of the Moon. This discovery indicates that water may be distributed across the lunar surface, and not limited to cold, shadowed places.

SOFIA has detected water molecules (H2O) in Clavius Crater, one of the largest craters visible from Earth, located in the Moon’s southern hemisphere. Previous observations of the Moon’s surface detected some form of hydrogen, but were unable to distin-

US to share satellite, sensor data with India

The United States and India signed off on a series of accords including one which will allow the US military to share sensitive satellite and sensor data with its Indian counterparts.

US Defence Secretary Mark Esper, in a statement, said, "We stand shoulder to shoulder, in support of a free and open Indo-Pacific for all, particularly in light of increasing aggression and destabilising activities by China."

India's External Affairs Minister Subrahmanyam Jaishankar and Defence Minister Rajnath Singh called for a "multi-polar Asia".

This will help New Delhi to better use US technology in targeting missiles and placing its troops.

It will also allow the United States to provide the latest navigational technology on

any fighter jets it supplies to India.

Esper has been pressing the case for India to buy US F-18 jets and move away from its reliance on Russian weaponry. But India wants more of its military equipment made domestically and is demanding greater investment.

Pompeo and Esper had already called for a deeper relationship during one-on-one talks with their Indian counterparts on Monday. Jaishankar tweeted after his meetings with Pompeo that relations between the emerging allies have "grown substantially".

Esper and Singh "welcomed the expansion of information-sharing", a US statement said, while the Indian Defence Ministry reported the two officials had discussed "potential new areas of cooperation", without giving details.

India is shopping for US cold-weather equipment, officials said, and has also agreed to expand naval manoeuvres in the Indian Ocean next month to include Australia.

Traditionally, the MALABAR exercises have involved India, the United States and Japan.

'Very Nice!': Kazakhstan taps Borat movie to woo tourists

Ridiculed once again in a film featuring fictional Kazakh journalist Borat Sagdiyev, the ex-Soviet state of Kazakhstan has embraced the joke this time round and adopted Borat's catch phrase to try to attract tourists.

"Borat Subsequent Moviefilm: Delivery of Prodigious Bribe to American Regime for Make Benefit Once Glorious Nation of Kazakhstan," a follow-up to a 2006 film featuring the same sexist and racist character, was released on Amazon Prime last week.

Borat's first outing caused anger



in Kazakhstan where authorities discouraged its screening and threatened legal action over what they saw as an insult to their national character.

This time round, they have taken a different approach and adopted Borat's catchphrase "Very Nice!" to try to promote tourism in the vast Central Asian country.

– trapped in a cubic meter of soil spread across the lunar surface. The results are published in the latest issue of Nature Astronomy.

"We had indications that H₂O – the familiar water we know – might be present on the sunlit side of the Moon," said Paul Hertz, director of the Astrophysics Division in the Science Mission Directorate at NASA Headquarters in Washington. "Now we know it is there. This discovery challenges our understanding of the lunar surface and raises intriguing questions about resources relevant for deep space exploration."

As a comparison, the Sahara desert has 100 times the amount of water than what SOFIA detected in the lunar soil. Despite the small amounts, the discovery raises new questions about how water is created and how it persists on the harsh, airless lunar surface.

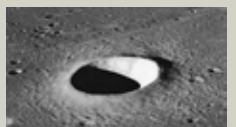


When the Apollo astronauts first returned from the Moon in 1969, it was thought to be completely dry.

Meanwhile, several spacecraft – including the Cassini mission and Deep Impact comet mission, as well as the Indian Space Research Organization's Chandrayaan-1 mission – and NASA's ground-based Infrared Telescope Facility, looked broadly across the lunar surface and found evidence of hydration in sunnier regions. Yet those missions were unable to definitively distinguish the form in which it was present – either H₂O or OH.



Orbital and impactor missions over the past 20 years, such as NASA's Lunar Crater Observation and Sensing Satellite, confirmed ice in permanently shadowed craters around the Moon's poles.

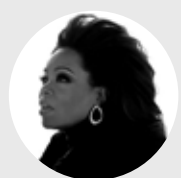

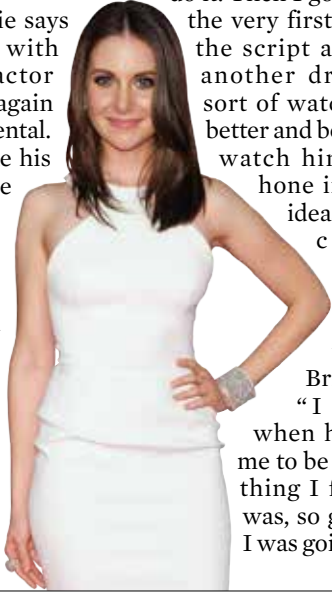
Alison Brie: Being directed by husband David Franco was romantic

Wridhiman Saha stamped his class with a 45-ball 87 before Rashid Khan dished out a clinical bowling performance as Sunrisers Hyderabad kept themselves alive in the race for IPL play-offs with a whopping 88-run win over Delhi Capital, yesterday.

Asked to bat first, splendid knocks by Saha (87), skipper David Warner (66) and Manish Pandey (44) powered Sunrisers to 219 for two.

Star spinner Rashid then led a fine bowling display to end with the impressive figures of 4-0-7-3, his best in this season. The Afghan bowled an astonishing 17 dot balls in his quota of four overs, helping his side bowl out the Capitals for 131 in 19 overs.

Sunrisers (10 points) have now moved up to sixth from seventh position with this win, while the Capitals, who slumped to their third consecutive loss, were pushed down to the third spot with 14 points.

Chasing a stiff target, it was a rather ordinary performance

by the the Capitals batsmen. Shikhar Dhawan (0) and Marcus Stoinis (5), who was elevated to number 3, perished in the first two overs.

Ajinkya Rahane (26) and Shimron Heytmyer (16) quickly started the recovery work, stitching a 40 run stand, the highest for their team. The duo targeted Jason Holder, collecting 22 runs in the sixth over as Delhi reached 54 for two at the end of the Powerplay overs.

However, Rashid dealt Delhi with twin blows, getting rid of both Rahane and Hetmyer in the seventh over. Skipper Shreyas Iyer (7) was next to depart as wickets continued to tumble at regular intervals.

Seven of Delhi's batsmen failed to reach double digits with Rishabh Pant (36) being the top scorer.

While Rashid was the pick of the bowlers for Sunrisers, Sandeep Sharma (2/27) and T Natarajan (2/26) picked two wickets apiece. Vijay Shankar(1/11), Shahbaz Nadeem (1/8), Holder (1/46) took a wicket each.

Norris apologises for ‘stupid and careless’ comments

McLaren's Lando Norris publicly apologised yesterday, but without naming anyone, after the Briton played down compatriot Lewis Hamilton's record 92nd Formula One win at Sunday's Portuguese Grand Prix.

The 20-year-old, the youngest driver on the grid, had also been strongly critical of Racing Point's Canadian Lance Stroll

after the pair collided during the race.

Norris finished 13th while stewards punished Stroll for the incident.

"I owe an apology," said Norris to his 750,000 followers on Twitter. "I've been stupid and careless with some things I've said lately in media and interviews, and haven't shown the respect I should have to certain people."

"I'm not that kind of person, so know I should apologise to them but also everyone reading/listening. Sorry."

Norris was asked after the race in television interviews what he made of Hamilton becoming the most successful F1 driver in terms of wins, overtaking Ferrari great Michael Schumacher in the record books.

"I'm just happy for him, nothing more," the Briton had replied.

"It doesn't mean anything to me, really. He's in a car which should win every race, basically."

"He has to beat one or two other drivers, that's it. Fair play to him, he's still doing the job he has to do."

Hamilton has won eight of 12 races this season and is heading for a record-equalling seventh title, which would confirm him as the most successful driver in the history of the sport.

The Briton has averaged 10 wins a season in the V6 turbo hybrid era that started in 2014.

Mercedes have won the last six constructors' championships and are set to clinch a seventh in Italy next weekend.

Norris, who made his Formula One debut last year, has made 33 starts so far with one podium finish.

Mourinho shares credit for potent Kane-Son partnership

Tottenham Hotspur's Harry Kane and Son Heung-min have formed the Premier League's most potent partnership under Jose Mourinho this season but the Portuguese manager says some of the credit has to go to his predecessor Mauricio Pochettino.

Son scored his eighth goal of the season in Monday's 1-0 win at Burnley after Kane had headed an Erik Lamela corner into his path. Spurs are fifth, two points behind leaders Everton, and lead the league in scoring with 16 goals.

It was the ninth goal the pair had combined for this season, with Kane assisting on seven of Son's eight goals, while the Korean has assisted on two of the England's forward's five strikes.

The duo have combined for 29 goals in their Premier League careers, second only to the former Chelsea partnership of Frank Lampard and Didier Drogba (36), according to Opta statistics.

"It is an understanding that comes from Mauricio's time," Mourinho told reporters.

"I don't want all the credit myself, let's share with Mauricio. They play together for a long time, probably a different

way because Harry is not always a nine now.

"What pleases me more about them both is that they are two top players but close friends, no jealousy, they both play for the team."

Kane said Spurs were showing signs of progress under Mourinho as they chase a first major trophy since their 2008 League Cup triumph.

"I think we are at a stage where we have been so close for so many years, a lot of us have been together for four or five years," said Kane.

Aguero ruled out for two to four weeks, says City boss Guardiola

Manchester City striker Sergio Aguero was ruled out yesterday's Champions League trip to Olympique Marseille through a hamstring injury and could be out of action for two to four weeks, manager Pep Guardiola said.

Aguero was withdrawn at halftime in Saturday's 1-1 Premier League draw at West Ham United with Guardiola confirming the 32-year-old suffered a muscular problem, only a week after making his first start of the season following knee surgery.

"It depends on the injury. We expect 10-15 days for sure minimum, or it could be three weeks or a month," Guardiola told reporters. "When you are out for four or five months with a knee problem, you always have a risk when you come back."

"We tried to handle it the best as possible, (playing him) 50-55 minutes in the games, but it was not enough to maintain it and get him through the games."

"We knew he was not in the best condition against Arsenal but without strikers that we had, it was important that he played 60 minutes. We have to be calm and hope he recovers as quickly as possible."

Guardiola confirmed midfielder Kevin De Bruyne and defender Aymeric Laporte were available for yesterday's clash in France, while new signing Nathan Ake (groin) and striker Gabriel Jesus (thigh) were edging closer to their return.

"Nathan is so close to come

back, Gabriel is 7-10 days to coming back," he added.

City lack an experienced centre forward against Andre Villas-Boas' Marseille in the absence of injured duo Aguero and Jesus.

When asked if the Etihad club could have bought a striker in the close season to add more options, Guardiola said: "Maybe we considered it and thought about it and another type of striker, but we could not."

"You know when you decide to buy a striker they have to be at the level of Aguero and Jesus and we could not afford it. This is the reality."

Cleiton “Predator” opens up ahead of title defense: ‘My mind is molded for war’

Brazilian veteran Cleiton “Predator” Silva shocked the world last year by capturing the BRAVE CF Lightweight world title from arch-rival Luan “Miau” Santiago, who was the overwhelming favorite to keep the crown. A year on from that triumph, Cleiton is riding high and ready to defend his title. He takes on Amin Ayoub in the main event of BRAVE CF 44, his first fight away from South America, which takes place on November 5th, in Bahrain.

It was the realization of a dream for “Predator”, who has

admitted previously that he was close to quitting mixed martial arts before the call to join BRAVE CF came and changed the course of his career.

During a special Live Interview on BRAVE Combat Federation’s Instagram profile, Cleiton opened up on his mindset for fighting, and expressed his wishes that his new rival came up with a different, “more exciting” game plan.

“Amin is an awkward fighter, isn’t he? He’s weird, he has that weird style. I’m asking God for him to not come in with that same striking style he had at BRAVE CF 31. It was so boring, he didn’t do anything. I want it to be an exciting fight”, said “Predator”, who waved off his opponents’ credentials in his past fights.

“Yeah, he has six victories by submission, but the guys he fought don’t impress me. I don’t think these guys train proper

jiu-jitsu. I’m a legitimate brown belt in jiu-jitsu, I train jiu-jitsu.

And my jiu-jitsu is geared towards MMA, I go for the finish,

always. My goal is to hurt my opponent, to knock him out or submit him”.

When asked about the psychological side of fighting, Cleiton spoke at length about how the difficulties he endured during his life molded his mind towards fighting.

“I’ve been in the business of fighting for 25 years, first with muay thai and then with MMA. I’ve been through a lot, some unbelievable scenarios, that only the people who have been with me since the beginning know about. I don’t have any specific psychological preparation, because I feel these difficulties I’ve endured have molded me. My mind is geared towards war, it’s molded for war, for combat. I take this as another fight. For me, the next fight is always the hardest. So, in my mind, it’s all about winning, maintaining my title and looking forward to my next challenge”.

With three wins in as many BRAVE CF appearances, Silva is hoping to add a fourth straight victory and become the first-ever BRAVE CF Lightweight world champion to successfully defend his crown, something that the four previous champions haven’t been able to achieve.
