Taiwan's weather agency, which put the magnitude at 7.0, said the quake hit at 23:05 pm (1505 GMT) at a **Taiwan: USGS** depth of 73 kilometres (45 miles) in the sea off Yilan county, southwest of Taipei. The Yilan County Fire Bureau told AFP there were no immediate reports of casualties or damage. Local media said the quake caused buildings in the capital Taipei to sway and was felt across Taiwan. Taiwan is frequently hit by earthquakes due to its location on the edge of two tectonic plates near the Pacific Ring of Fire, which the USGS says is the most seismically active zone in the



# Russia pummels Kyiv ahead of Zelensky's US visit

Russia pummelled Ukraine's capital with drones and missiles yesterday, killing a woman and cutting power to hundreds of thousands, ahead of President Volodymyr Zelensky's latest talks with US leader Donald

Zelensky said the attack showed Russia did not want to end its invasion launched in February 2022 that has left tens of thousands dead.
