'I lived all my dreams' - Stones bids farewell to City

John Stones has said he has "lived all my dreams out" at Manchester City after confirming he will leave the club at the end of the season.

The England defender, whose contract expires this summer, has made 293 appearances since joining from Everton in 2016 for £47.5m. During his decade at the Etihad Stadium, Stones has won six Premier League titles, the Champions League, two FA Cups, five League Cups, three Community Shields, the Club World Cup and the UEFA Super Cup.

In an emotional social media message, the 31-year-old reflected on his journey with the club. "It has been my home for

the past 10 years and it will be my home for the rest of my life," he said. "I came as a kid and now I'm leaving as a man. I lived all my dreams out and lifted all the things that I came here to achieve."

Stones also paid tribute to manager Pep Guardiola, calling him a major influence on his career. He described himself as "grateful" for their relationship and the success they achieved together, adding that City would not have been as successful without the Spaniard.

Signed as Guardiola's second recruit and once the world's second most expensive defender, Stones endured early criticism and injury setbacks before becoming a key figure in City's dominant era. Known for his composure on the ball,

he was even deployed in midfield during the club's 2023 Champions League triumph as part of a historic treble-winning season.

Despite recent injury struggles limiting his appearances, Stones has remained a respected figure in the squad and a favourite among supporters. He has also been an important player for England, earning 87 caps and playing in multiple major tournament finals.

Stones now departs as part of a wider transition at City, with several long-serving players already leaving the club. His next move remains uncertain, with reports linking him to clubs in England and abroad as he prepares for the next chapter of his career.
