Travel Unlocked

OKTB scrapped, visa printouts required

● OKTB scrapped from September

● Online visa checks sufficient

● Gulf trend simplifies travel

Bahrain has announced the end of the 'Ok to Board' (OKTB) requirement for travelers flying in from India, easing a

decades-old process that often added extra steps and delays at airline counters.

Effective September 1st, passengers heading to Bahrain on Air India and Air India Express will no longer need the additional clearance message, according to an advisory issued by the airline. Instead, travelers must present a printout of their valid visa, which will be checked at check-in and immigration counters.

Regional trend

The move puts Bahrain in line with other Gulf states, including Qatar and the UAE,

which have already scrapped the OKTB procedure in favor of direct visa verification. Industry observers say the change will particularly benefit Indian expatriates, who make up one of the largest communities in the Gulf.

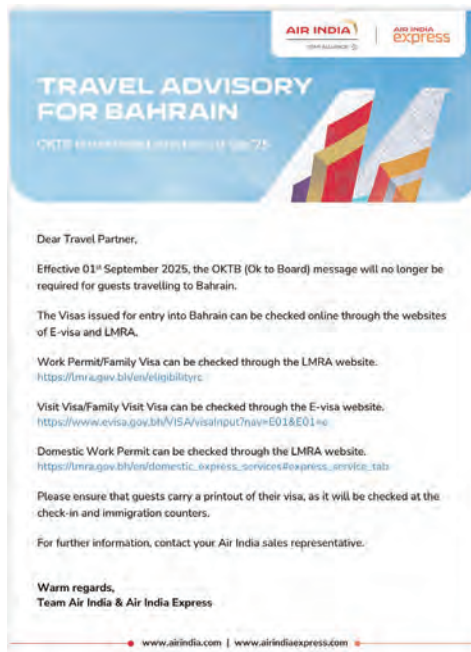
Online verification

Visas for Bahrain can now be confirmed online through the official E-Visa portal or the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) website. Separate links are provided for work permits, family visas, and domestic work permits. The airline urged passengers to carry printouts of their visas for

smoother processing.

OKTB had long been a source of confusion for first-time travelers, especially those on ECR (Emigration Check Required) passports, as it required coordination between the visa holder, travel agents, and the airline. Its removal, observers say, signals a shift toward digitised border and airline checks in the region.

The advisory notes that the requirement will no longer apply from September 1st, simplifying travel formalities and potentially cutting delays for passengers flying to Bahrain.



Glory for Bahrain

Naser shines with women's 400m title in Switzerland

Salwa Eid Naser made Bahrain proud once more by capturing the women's 400 metres title at the Weltklasse Zurich meeting in Switzerland.

Naser surged to an impressive victory, claiming the third Diamond Trophy of her illustrious career while shattering the record with a time of 48.70 seconds in this event, the grand finale of this season's Wanda Diamond League.

She outpaced reigning world and Olympic champion Marileidy Paulino of the Do-

minican Republic.

Competing against a stacked field seeking her first win since April over her fierce Dominican rival, the Bahrain star athlete led from the blast of the gun and held on to the lead, crossing the finish line in an exceptional meeting record.

This latest triumph complements Naser's previous Diamond League titles from 2018 and 2019, marking the sixth overall Diamond Trophy ever won by a Bahraini athlete in the history of the Wanda Diamond League.

Enhanced Bahrain-Singapore commercial ties

Council for International Dispute Resolution Secretary-General participates at MENA Meet Singapore Forum during Singapore Convention Week

Professor Marike Paulsson, Secretary-General of the Council for International Dispute Resolution of the Kingdom of Bahrain, spoke on Panel during the Building Bridges in ADR: MENA Meets Singapore – A SIDRA Forum, held during Singapore Convention Week 2025.

The panel explored the evolving landscape of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) institutions in the Middle East and North Africa, with a focus on innovative frameworks and cross-regional collaboration.

The Forum opened with a keynote address by Guest-of-Honour Mr. Murali Pillai SC, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Law and Ministry of Transport, Singapore.

In his remarks, Mr. Pillai spoke of the deepening collaboration between Bahrain and Singapore in the field of international commercial dispute resolution.

Joint initiative

He welcomed the joint initiatives of the Supreme Court of Singapore and the Bahrain delegation, highlighting the sig-

nificance of their engagement with users and leading law firms on the pioneering joint venture between the two commercial courts.

He further noted the honor of hosting Bahrain's senior delegation in Singapore to advance this important partnership.

Before the forum session, Professor Paulsson held a side conversation with the Mr. Murali Pillai, where they briefly touched upon the success of the Bahrain International Commercial Court (BICC), and the Minister extended his congratulations

to the Kingdom of Bahrain for this achievement.

Innovative leadership

In her intervention, Professor Paulsson underscored Bahrain's innovative leadership in advancing ADR and transnational justice, as well as its role in shaping collaborative court-to-court initiatives with Singapore.

She spoke alongside key representatives from across the MENA region, where the panel emphasized Bahrain's innovative role in mediation, the unique judicial joint venture

between Bahrain and Singapore, and the rising influence of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) in handling international commercial disputes.

Professor Paulsson further shared recent developments including Bahrain's signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with the International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID), the Host Country Agreement with the Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA), and Bahrain's active leadership in UNCITRAL Working Groups.

Judicial partnerships

She also detailed the evolving role of the Bahrain International Commercial Court (BICC) and its deepening relationship with the Singapore International Commercial Court (SICC) as a model for judicial partnerships bridging regions.

This panel underscored Bahrain's position at the forefront of advancing ADR globally.

At the same time, the dialogue reflects the growing momentum behind joint initiatives that strengthen ADR ecosystems and build lasting bridges between Asia and the MENA region.

Court shuts down company for expired bakery goods

Court fines owner BD100,000 and orders products and tools confiscated and destroyed

A defendant has been convicted of tampering with expiry dates on bakery ingredients and dealing in expired stock. The Second Lower Criminal Court fined him BD100,000, ordered the confiscation and destruction of the goods and the tools used, and ordered the company closed, the Public Prosecution said in a statement yesterday. The case began after Khamis Police Station (A) passed on information from the Ministry of Industry and Commerce about

a warehouse holding expired stock and suspected trade fraud.

Bakery inputs

Ministry inspectors entered the site and found bakery inputs with expiry dates peeled off and covered with new labels, along with other out-of-date goods. The Ministry shut the warehouse. Prosecutors visited the site, secured the store and took statements from 23 suspects and witnesses. They asked Ministry staff to take stock, list expired items and seize any that had already reached the market.



The court found expired foods and rolls of labels bearing production dates. In a separate shop, officers seized products supplied by the company with altered dates.

A forgery expert at the Directorate of Forensic Evidence examined samples and found the original expiry dates had been removed and replaced, including by swapping labels. **Findings** Police inquiries supported these findings.

The Public Prosecution then sent the case to court, which issued the ruling. This is the second trade-fraud case of this kind in this period, involving a different company and defendant, and that the Prosecution will enforce the law to protect consumers' rights, health and safety.

500 new smart cameras a 'milestone' in enhancing road safety in Kingdom

The signing of a contract to equip the directorate with 500 high-quality smart cameras, featuring the latest technologies capable of detecting various types of traffic violations, represents a major step forward in strengthening traffic discipline and enhancing public safety on the roads. This was emphasised by the Director-General of Traffic, Major-General Shaikh Abdulrahman bin Abdulwahab Al Khalifa. He explained that this initiative comes within the government's directives, led by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime

Minister, to support the traffic system and upgrade its technical infrastructure in line with international best practices. Be wary of fake car tinting accounts online!

Fake accounts posing as car window tinting businesses are spreading across social media, the Interior Ministry's General Directorate of Anti-Corruption and Economic and Electronic Security has warned. These pages claim to offer low prices and quick service, but the directorate said their real aim is to cheat people out of their money. Members of the public were urged to be wary of such offers and to avoid transferring funds without first checking that the business has a commercial registration and a verifiable premises. **Caution** The directorate cautioned that the images and promises used in these adverts are deceptive and intended to trap victims. The ministry body said it continues to watch and trace

Arrested over hoax organ sale video

African national suspect admits faking clip online and creating false BD58.900 cheque and cash transaction

A man has been remanded in custody after admitting he filmed and posted a video that falsely claimed he was selling one of his organs for money, the Cybercrime Prosecution said.

The clip showed the man, an African national, holding a signed cheque and taking cash, which suggested a deal was about to be completed.

The Cybercrime Directorate identified him, then arrested him and referred him to the Public Prosecution.

Evidence

Questioned by prosecutors and confronted with the evidence, he confessed to recording and publishing the footage. He said it was staged for hu-



mour and to attract followers, and that no sale took place.

Prosecutors ordered further police enquiries and asked the bank on which the cheque was drawn for details.

The cheque was valued at BD58.900.

Witnesses were called, including the issuing company's employee and the beneficiary.

Labour dues

Investigations found the claims in the video were false; the cheque covered labour dues owed to a colleague.

The Cybercrime Prosecution Chief said the Public Prosecution will continue to act against misuse of social media platforms.

asked people to check what they share and to consider the legal and social consequences, and said legal steps will be taken to prevent disturbances to public order.

Bahrain airport passenger volume up 11% to 865,753

Bahrain International Airport handled 865,753 passengers in July 2025, up 11 per cent on June's 780,000, according to Civil Aviation Affairs at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

The month-on-month rise was close to 85,000 travellers. Departures reached 453,944. Arrivals totalled 411,617. Transit passengers numbered 192.

Aircraft movements stood at 8,748 flights, split between 4,376 departures and 4,372 arrivals.

A further 47,832 aircraft crossed Bahraini airspace.

Cargo and airmail

Total cargo and airmail came to 35,129 tonnes, made up of 13,760 tonnes of imports, 8,614 tonnes of exports and 12,755 tonnes of transit shipments.

The fastest growth in passenger routes in July 2025 versus July 2024 was on the Indian cities of Bangalore and Hyderabad, up 117 per cent with 37,266 passengers.

Abu Dhabi rose 31 per cent to 57,301 passengers, and Doha increased 18 per cent to 54,101.

Global efforts against illicit drugs



The Kingdom of Bahrain took part in a large-scale international operation led by the International Security Alliance, targeting narcotics and psychotropic substance traffickers. Conducted simultaneously in multiple countries from June 10 to August 7, 2025, the operation involved cooperation with Europol, Ameripol, and 25 countries across all continents. Interior Minister highlighted Bahrain's active role in the operation, which successfully seized over 822 tons of drugs valued at more than \$2.9 billion and led to the arrest of 12,564 suspects. The coordinated action disrupted the operations of global drug gangs and cut off their sources of income. The operation underscores the effectiveness of international cooperation in enhancing community security, promoting strategic partnerships, and reinforcing Bahrain's commitment to global efforts against illicit drugs. Bahrain's participation reflects its leadership and proactive engagement in advancing regional and international security initiatives.

Markets mixed on growth, Nvidia

Chip giant's shares fall despite \$26.4B profit as data center revenue declines

● Markets fluctuate on US data

● US economy grew 3.3%

● Nvidia posts \$26.4 billion profit

Stock markets fluctuated yesterday as investors digested stronger-than-estimated US economic growth and record earnings at AI chip giant Nvidia.

The broad-base S&P 500 index and the tech-heavy Nasdaq opened higher but the Dow was flat.

Shares in Nvidia were down around one percent despite posting a profit of \$26.4 billion on record revenue of \$46.7 billion in the second quarter.

Investors had keenly awaited the earnings update late Wednesday from the California-based firm, whose robust growth has largely driven strong gains for tech stocks in recent months.

Its shares fell, however, as

important data centre revenue declined.

The earnings report comes amid market worries over a spending bubble in the artificial intelligence sector that could burst and hurt the chip giant's fortunes.

"The market seems to be ask-

ing whether Nvidia can keep up this pace as competition intensifies and AI enthusiasm starts to look a little overbought," said Joshua Mahony, chief market analyst at traders Scope Markets.

Investors were also reacting to US data showing that the world's

biggest economy grew 3.3 percent in the second quarter, up from an initial estimate of 3.0 percent in July.

"After the initial release, there were concerns that the domestic economy was slowing quite sharply," said Richard Flax, chief investment officer at Money-

farm.

"But these latest data suggest that the economy is a bit stronger than initially feared," he said.

The upward revision mainly reflected improvements in investment and consumer spending, the Commerce Department said.

But overall, growth in the second quarter was also bolstered by a fall in US imports, which are subtracted from the GDP.

This drop came as businesses pulled back on shipments after

rushing to stock up ahead of US President Donald Trump's tariff hikes.

The data could offer insight into the outlook for US interest rates, with the Federal Reserve eyeing further cuts to borrowing costs in a bid to boost the US economy.

"Overall, this release probably doesn't change Federal Reserve thinking too much," Flax said, adding that the central bank was still expected to cut rates by 25 basis points at its September meeting.

"But a stronger than expected result from domestic demand suggests that there might not be that much scope to cut rates over the next 12 months."

In Europe, the Paris stock market extended its recovery, having tumbled early in the week on fears that France's minority government could be toppled.

This was after Prime Minister Francois Bayrou proposed a confidence vote over his proposed budget cuts.

France's borrowing costs have soared since the vote was called Monday, as the government wrestles with how to find around 44 billion euros (\$51 billion) in savings.

US Fed Governor Lisa Cook sues Trump over move to fire her

US Federal Reserve Governor Lisa Cook filed a lawsuit First Private University in Bahrain to Offer Official Bridging Programme in Technological and Dual-Award Degrees in Engineering to challenge Donald Trump's move to fire her from her position -- as the president intensified pressure on the independent central bank.

"This case challenges President Trump's unprecedented and illegal attempt to remove Governor Cook from her position which, if allowed to occur, would (be) the first of its kind in the Board's history," court documents said.

Cook seeks a decision to confirm her status as a Fed governor, allowing her to continue in her responsibilities.

In requesting "immediate declaratory and injunctive relief," Cook also seeks an outcome safeguarding Fed officials' congressionally mandated independence.

On Monday evening, Trump published a letter on his Truth Social platform stating that he had removed Cook from her role. He cited accusations of false statements on her mortgage agreements.

White House spokesman Kush Desai maintained in a statement yesterday that Trump had "determined there was cause to remove a governor who was credibly accused of lying in financial documents from a highly sensitive position overseeing financial institutions."

Among the alleged false statements was that Cook had claimed two primary residences, one in Michigan and another in Georgia.

Cook has not been charged with a crime and the alleged incidents occurred before she was in her current position.

Trump's move marked a dramatic escalation in his effort to exert control over the Fed, in a step that could put the institution's independence at risk, according to analysts.

Prince Harry to visit UK on anniversary of queen's death ◆ Prince Harry will return to the UK to attend a charity award ceremony on September 8, coinciding with the third anniversary of the death of his grandmother, Queen Elizabeth II. "Prince Harry will be celebrating 20 years of the WellChild Awards in London on 8th September," said the charity, which celebrates the achievements of children with serious illnesses. "I am always privileged to attend the WellChild Awards and meet the incredible children, families and professionals who inspire us all with their strength and spirit," Harry, who has been a patron of the charity since 2007, said in a statement.

The toll in northern Thailand from landslides and flooding triggered by Typhoon Kajiki rose to five dead and 15 injured, officials said yesterday, with heavy rain forecast to continue all week. The storm made landfall in Vietnam on Monday, forcing tens of thousands of people to evacuate, before sweeping across Laos and northern Thailand, bringing torrential rain. Five people were killed and 15 injured in 12 provinces in northern Thailand, according to the Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation.

China says North Korea's Kim Jong Un to attend September 3 parade ◆ China said yesterday that North Korean leader Kim Jong Un will attend a huge military parade in Beijing on September 3 to mark 80 years since the end of World War II. Beijing's assistant minister of foreign affairs, Hong Lei, announced Kim's attendance at a press conference yesterday morning. The North Korean leader last visited China in January 2019 for talks with President Xi Jinping. Some 26 leaders, including Russian President Vladimir Putin, will also attend the parade that will showcase China's latest equipment and see Xi inspect troops in Beijing's Tiananmen Square.

Argentina hunts Nazi-looted painting revealed in property ad

Argentine police hunted Wednesday for a 17th-century painting which was allegedly stolen by the Nazis from a Dutch Jewish art collector and resurfaced this week in a property ad, only to disappear again. The painting, believed to be "Portrait of a Lady" by Italian baroque portraitist Giuseppino Ghislandi (1655-1743) was identified by the Dutch newspaper AD on Monday in a picture of a house for sale in the seaside resort of Mar del Plata. The authenticity of the artwork cannot be proven until it is recovered but it is believed to have been stolen from Amsterdam art dealer Jacques Goudstikker during World War II. In the for-sale notice of the house in Mar del Plata, published by Robles Casas & Campos realtors, the painting of a noblewoman in a gilded frame was seen hanging in the living room, above a green sofa. After AD journalists spotted it, Argentine prosecutor Carlos

Martinez ordered a search of the residence. But while firearms were seized during Tuesday's raid, the painting had disappeared. "The painting is gone. Only a carbine and a .32-caliber revolver were seized," the prosecutor told reporters. The property has also been removed from the website of Robles Casas & Campos, who did not respond to AFP's request for comment. The international police agency Interpol is assisting in the investigation. The Mar del Plata house is believed to belong to Patricia Kadgien, daughter of the late Friedrich Kadgien, a senior SS officer who fled to Argentina after the war. Kadgien has not been charged in the affair. Her lawyer, Carlos Murias, told La Capital, a local newspaper in Mar del Plata, that she and her husband would cooperate with the authorities. Goudstikker's heirs are determined to recover the painting, which appears on an international list of missing artworks.

Russian strike kills 15 in Kyiv

Russian strike shatters homes as Zelensky accuses Moscow of rejecting ceasefire efforts

- Four children among dead
- Kyiv apartment blocks hit
- Russia launched 629 drones and missiles overnight
- EU offices and British Council hit by blast

Russian missiles and drones ripped through apartment blocks in the Ukrainian capital Kyiv yesterday, killing at least 17 people, including four children, in an attack that President Volodymyr Zelensky said highlighted Moscow's rejection of peace moves. Russia has rained down aerial attacks on Ukrainian cities despite US President Donald Trump's push for a ceasefire and even as it talks up the importance of ending the war launched by its full-scale invasion in February 2022. The attack -- one of the deadliest on Kyiv -- blasted a five-storey crater in one apartment block, ripping the building in two. The European Union mission and a British government cultural building were also damaged, setting off international protests. AFP reporters saw rescuers carrying several victims away from the apartment block in body bags throughout the day as they sifted through the smouldering rubble. "Glass was flying ... we were screaming when the bombs went off," Galina Shcherbak, who was at a parking lot close to one of the strikes said. Ukraine's air force said Moscow fired 629 drones and mis-

siles. That would make it the second-largest overnight barrage of the war, according to an analysis of Kyiv's data. Andriy, whose flat was destroyed in the strike, told AFP that he had only just made it out alive. "If I had gone to the shelter a minute later, I would not be here now, I would have been buried." "I came out, could not hear anything, there was fog everywhere, and my left eye was completely covered in blood." "Diplomacy ruined" Zelensky called the attack "a horrific and deliberate killing of civilians". "The Russians are not choosing to end the war, only new strikes," he said on social media, calling for Moscow to face fresh sanctions. "For the spurning of ceasefire and for the constant Russian attempts to weasel out of negotiations, new strong sanctions are

needed," he added. "All deadlines have already been broken, dozens of opportunities for diplomacy ruined. Russia must feel accountable for every strike, for every day of this war," he said. The Kremlin, which claimed to have targeted military sites, insisted it was still interested in diplomacy, but that its strikes on

Ukraine would "continue". "The Russian armed forces are fulfilling their tasks," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters. "They continue to strike military and military-adjacent infrastructure facilities." "At the same time, Russia remains interested in continuing the negotiation process. The aim is to achieve our goals through political and diplomatic means," he added. The European Union and British government summoned Russia's ambassadors after the barrage damaged the buildings of the EU's mission and the British Council in Kyiv. EU officials posted photos of blown-out windows and the office ceiling partially collapsed. EU chief Ursula von der Leyen said she held calls with Trump and Zelensky following the attack. "Putin must come to the negotiating table," she said on X.

White House fires US health agency head after she refused to quit

The Trump administration confirmed Wednesday it had fired the head of the top US public health agency after she refused to step down during a standoff with vaccine skeptic Health Secretary Robert F. Kennedy Jr. The escalating dispute over Kennedy's sweeping overhaul of US vaccine policy also led to five other senior officials at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announcing their resignations, according to a union representing some of the agency's workers. Susan Monarez, a health scientist and longtime civil servant, had been the CDC's head for less

than a month when Kennedy's Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced on X that she "is no longer director." But Monarez's lawyers said she would not step down because she had neither resigned nor received notification from the White House regarding her

dismissal. The White House later confirmed that Monarez had been fired. "As her attorney's statement makes abundantly clear, Susan Monarez is not aligned with the President's agenda of Making America Healthy Again," White House spokesman Kush Desai



The CDC director was fired less than a month into her role, with her lawyers stating only the president could fire a Senate-confirmed officer, deeming her termination legally deficient

said in an emailed statement. "Since Susan Monarez refused to resign despite informing HHS leadership of her intent to do so, the White House has terminated Monarez from her position with the CDC," he added. However, her lawyers said she "was notified tonight by a White House staffer in the personnel office that she was fired."

UN experts decry ‘enforced disappearances’ at Gaza aid sites

Reports claim missing Palestinians after visiting aid sites, sparking UN calls for accountability

UN rights experts voiced alarm yesterday at reports of “enforced disappearances” of starving Palestinians seeking food at distribution sites run by the Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF), urging Israel to end the “heinous crime”.

The seven independent experts said in a joint statement they had received reports that a number of individuals, including one child, had been “forcibly disappeared” after going to aid distribution sites in Rafah, southern Gaza.

The GHF said there was “no evidence” of enforced disappearances at its aid sites.

“Reports of enforced disappearances targeting starving civilians seeking their basic right to food is not only shocking, but amounts to torture,” said the experts, who are mandated by the UN Human Rights Council, but who do not speak on behalf of the United Nations itself.

“Using food as a tool to conduct targeted and mass disappearances needs to end now.”

Israel’s military was reportedly “directly involved” in the matter, said the statement signed by the five members of the UN Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances, along with Francesca Albanese, the UN special rapporteur on rights in the Palestinian territories, and her counterpart on the right to food, Michael Fakhri.

Israel’s military was “refusing to provide information on the fate and whereabouts of persons

they have deprived of their liberty”, in violation of international law, the statement said.

“The failure to acknowledge deprivation of liberty by state agents and refusal to acknowledge detention constitute an enforced disappearance.”

‘Heinous crime’

The UN declared a famine in Gaza governorate last week, blaming “systematic obstruction” of humanitarian deliveries by Israel.

Israel, which has accused Hamas of looting aid supplied by the

UN, imposed a total blockade on Gaza between March and May.

Once it began easing restrictions, the GHF, a private organisation supported by Israel and the United States, was established to distribute food aid, effectively sidelining UN agencies.

The experts pointed to how “aerial bombardment and daily gunfire at and around the crowded facilities have resulted in mass casualties”.

“The Gaza Humanitarian Foundation is obligated to provide secure distribution sites and has contracted private military

security companies to that end,” they said.

The UN human rights office said last week it had documented that 1,857 Palestinians had been killed while seeking aid since late May, including 1,021 near GHF sites.

Now, the experts warned, “the distribution points pose additional risks for devastated individuals of being forcibly disappeared”.

When asked by AFP about the experts’ statement, GHF said: “We operate in a war zone where serious allegations exist against all parties operating outside our sites. But inside GHF facilities, there is no evidence of enforced disappearances.”

The experts meanwhile urged Israeli authorities to “put an end to the heinous crime against an already vulnerable population”.

French far right, hard left reject compromise deal to save PM

France’s far-right and hard-left parties yesterday rejected a compromise with Prime Minister Francois Bayrou over his government’s cost-cutting budget, saying it was “too late” to make a deal.

Bayrou has staked his political survival on a confidence vote he called for September 8, after months of deadlock over the government’s plans to slash the country’s mounting public debt.

But with the far-right and left-wing parties pledging not to back him, his premiership appears doomed, only months after he took office in December.

“Too late. Mr prime minister, you have missed many opportunities to construct a budget that benefits the French people,” the far-right National Rally’s (RN) deputy leader Sebastien Chenu told TF1 television.

“The page has been turned. Dialogue is in the past.”

US tells UN it will snub regular rights review

The United States told the United Nations in a letter yesterday that it will not take part in an upcoming regular review of its record on human rights.

“I write to inform you that United States of America will not participate in the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) ... scheduled to take place in Geneva on November 7,” the US mission in Geneva said in a letter addressed to UN rights chief Volker Turk.

The standard review is an examination that all 193 UN member states must undergo in turn every four to five years to assess their human rights record.

The US decision to snub its review was linked to President Donald Trump’s order back in February withdrawing Washington from a number of UN bodies, including participation in the Human Rights Council (HRC).

“As with other HRC mechanisms, engagement in UPRs implies endorsement of the council’s mandate and activities and ignores its persistent failure to condemn the most egregious

human rights violators,” a US State Department official, who asked not to be named, told AFP.

Thursday’s letter said that the UPR system, which was created after the establishment of the rights council in 2006, was meant to be “based on objective and reliable information and conducted in a manner that ensures equal treatment” of all countries.

“However, this is not the case

today,” it charged, adding that “the United States objects to the politicisation of human rights across the UN system, as well as the UN’s unrelenting selective bias against Israel”.

It also accused the UN of “ignoring human rights abuses in China, North Korea, Cuba and Venezuela”, which it said had “tarnished the UPR process” and other rights council mechanisms.

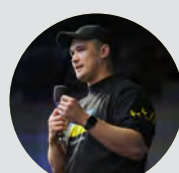

Taylor Swift ‘restricted access to new album to only five people’

Taylor Swift has reportedly restricted access to her new album *The Life of a Showgirl* to only five people. The 35-year-old singer-songwriter recorded the record in secret in Sweden alongside longtime collaborators Max Martin and Shellback during breaks from her ongoing Eras Tour, and a source has now said she also even kept some contributors left in the dark about the final product.

According to the Daily Mail, only a handful of people – including Taylor’s boyfriend Travis Kelce – have heard the finished record, with tight non-disclosure agreements

in place and extreme security measures taken to protect its contents.

An insider told the publication: “Everyone, from the writers, producers, studio engineers and studio interns went through a rigorous vetting process to make sure they could be trusted.

“Everyone was asked to sign ironclad NDAs and weren’t even allowed to discuss their contribution with family and friends. She really wants to keep it safe for her fans.”

The Daily Mail reported in addition to Travis, 35, the only other

people who have heard the full 12-track album are Tree Paine – Taylor’s long-time publicist – as well as Swedish producers Max Martin and Shellback as well as one unidentified studio engineer.

Travis revealed during Taylor’s recent appearance on his podcast *New Heights* he had been played the entire album, making him one of the few granted early access.

Alongside news of the restricted listening circle, Taylor has released two new limited-edition vinyl variants of *The Life of a Showgirl*.

Dubbed *The Tiny Bubbles* in Champagne Collection, the records became available on Monday. Previous limited versions, launched last week, sold out within an hour of release, the Daily Mail said.

The first of the two latest variations, *Under Bright Lights* Pearlescent, features a champagne-toned colour scheme,

while the second, *Red Lipstick and Lace* Transparent, carries orange tones.



Matt Damon almost choked to death during Jimmy Kimmel dinner party

Matt Damon almost choked to death at Jimmy Kimmel’s house.

Speaking to *Variety*, Jimmy, 57, recalled: “Matt Damon was over at my house one night for dinner.

The late night talk show host has recalled a night the 54-year-old Hollywood star came over for dinner and got some pork “stuck in his throat for about an hour and a half”.

“I made pork ribs. He came late, was very hungry, and started eating fast. He started choking on a pork rib.

“It was stuck in his throat for about an hour and a half.”

The TV star joked he was worried about a prison sentence if Matt ended up dying

at his home.

He added: “His brother was there. I said, ‘We have got to get him to the hospital,’ because if he dies in my house, I’m going to prison for the rest of my life.

“I will never be able to explain this as anything other than a murder.”

They went online to look for advice, and ended up turning to “little bits of bread” after the Heimlich Manoeuvre proved ineffective.

Jimmy said: “We did a lot of YouTube-ing and finally concluded that eating little bits of bread was the way to get that rib to work its way down into his stomach – and bread saved him. We tried the Heimlich many times.

“It was too far down.”

For the last 20 years, Matt and Jimmy have been embroiled in a tongue in cheek ‘feud’, which started with a lighthearted quip on the latter’s late night show in 2005.

Despite never booking the actor at the time, he joked: “Apologies to Matt Damon, but we ran out of time.”

Medvedev fined \$42,500 over US Open meltdown

Daniil Medvedev has been fined \$42,500 following his meltdown during Sunday's stormy first round defeat to France's Benjamin Bonzi, tournament organisers confirmed.

Medvedev was fined \$30,000 for unsportsmanlike conduct, and was given a further \$12,500 penalty for racket abuse.

The amount is approximately 40 percent of the \$110,000 Medvedev received for ap-

pearing in the first round at Flushing Meadows.

The fiery 29-year-old Russian erupted on Sunday following an incident in the third set when Bonzi was preparing to serve for the match.

A photographer mistakenly wandered onto the court, prompting chair umpire Greg Allensworth to award Bonzi a first serve.

Medvedev raced across the court to remonstrate with Allensworth, accusing the official of wanting to end the match early.

Alcaraz, Djokovic advance at US Open

Carlos Alcaraz stormed into the third round of the US Open with a blistering straight-sets victory on Wednesday as Novak Djokovic overcame an early scare to advance. Alcaraz, who could meet Djokovic in the semi-finals at Flushing Meadows if the draw follows the seedings, blew away Italy's Mattia Bellucci 6-1, 6-0, 6-3 in just one hour 36 minutes on the Arthur Ashe Stadium main court. The 22-year-old Spanish second seed unfurled a stream of 32 winners in a dominant display against the 65th-ranked Bellucci, whose best performance in a Grand Slam came with a run to the third round at Wimbledon earlier this

year. "I played great to be honest, from the beginning until the last ball," said Alcaraz, who will face another Italian, 32nd seed Luciano Darderi, in the next round. "The less time I spend on court the better for me, to go to bed early," he added. Elsewhere Wednesday, Serbian legend Djokovic kept his dream of a record 25th Grand Slam singles title alive after a four-set defeat of American qualifier Zachary Svajda. Djokovic though was forced to dig deep after losing the first set before claiming a 6-7 (5/7), 6-3, 6-3, 6-1 win. Djokovic, 38, said that while not at his best, he is hoping to play himself into form as the tourna-

ment progresses. "That's what I'm hoping, the deeper I go into the tournament the better I feel about my game," he said.

Djokovic's victory sees him into the third round at the US Open for a record-equalling 19th time, where he will face Britain's Cameron Norrie, who defeated Argentina's Francisco Comesana 7-6 (7/5), 6-3, 6-7 (0/7), 7-6 (7/4).

In other men's action on Wednesday, Norwegian 12th seed Casper Ruud, the 2022 US Open finalist, exited to Belgium's Raphael Collignon, losing 6-4, 3-6, 3-6, 6-4, 7-5.

Fourth seed Taylor Fritz advanced safely, beating South Africa's Lloyd Harris 4-6, 7-6 (7/3), 6-2, 6-4, while American compatriot Frances Tiafoe, seeded 17, also progressed with a four-set defeat of qualifier Martin Damm. Tiafoe won 6-4, 7-5, 6-7 (8/10), 7-5.

'No class' rant

In the women's draw, meanwhile, defending champion and world number one Aryna Sabalenka moved into the next round with a workmanlike display to dispatch unseeded Russian Polina Kudermetova 7-6 (7/4), 6-2.

Sabalenka started slowly but after taking the first set on a tie-break, asserted her control to

pull away in the second. The Belarusian will play Canada's Leylah Fernandez in the third round.

"The first set was super-tight, super-aggressive. I was glad I was able to handle that pressure and put it back to her. In the second set I felt much better in the return game."

Elsewhere Wednesday's Latvia's 25th seed Jelena Ostapenko was upset 7-5, 6-1 by Taylor Townsend before unleashing a furious on-court tirade at the

American.

Townsend said Ostapenko accused her of lacking "class" during her rant.

"She told me I have no education, no class, and to see what happens if we play each other outside of the US," Townsend said. "It was unfortunate, but, you know, it's something I can put on my TikTok."

Ostapenko said on Instagram she had been angered by Townsend's failure to acknowledge a net cord in her favour during the match.

In other matches, Britain's Emma Raducanu continued her solid start to the tournament after dispatching Indonesian qualifier Janice Tjen in straight sets, winning 6-2, 6-1.

Tjen had become the first Indonesian player to reach the main draw of a Grand Slam in 21 years and followed that up with a first round upset of 24th seed Veronika Kudermetova.

But she was beaten comfortably by Raducanu, who is aiming to recapture the US Open title she won as an 18-year-old qualifier in 2021. Raducanu will face ninth seed Elena Rybakina in the next round.

Bahrain’s Royal Guard are preparing for what promises to be the most intense edition of the Royal Rumble yet, with the fourth event officially announced to take place on November 27 at the Crowne Plaza Bahrain. The announcement came during a press conference yesterday afternoon, where organizers outlined the scale of the event, upcoming entertainment, and the highly capable opposition from the UK Armed Forces.

Speaking exclusively to TDT, Royal Guard team captain Rasheed Mehrinfar described the build-up as both nerve-wracking and exhilarating. “As an athlete who’s competed in every single Royal Rumble in front of royalty and home fans, it’s nervy and also a huge pleasure. I’m looking forward to it, so roll on November 27. There are sacrifices you have to make in life, discipline you have to maintain, and consistency to show up for training. There are days when we don’t feel like waking up and putting in the work, but we do it anyway.”

Boxers and Leadership

Tony Davis, head coach and technical manager, echoed Rasheed’s comments about the hard work behind the scenes, describing the event as “a cracker.” “We should have never beaten the British Army 6-2 in past events, but it’s all about how you get the philosophy across to the guys. These boxers show up to training at 6am, showing how badly they want it. The UK Armed Forces will be looking to

come in and demolish us, but we won’t let that happen.” Davis also praised individual team members balancing professional life with training. He cited Ali Al Aradi, who will not be competing this time around, as a prime example, noting how the team’s discipline mirrors his broader ambition to expand Bahrain’s boxing representation following successes at the ISF Gymnasiade. Maryam Khamis, one of Bahrain’s women boxers, reflected

on the unique pressure of performing under the Royal Rumble spotlight. “The feeling of going out in the ring is different to anything I’ve experienced. You’re eager to put in a performance under the pressure,” she said. The full Bahrain team set to compete includes Maryam Khamis, Prakash Limbu, Mohamed Fakhr, Rasheed Mehrinfar, Israel Davis, Issac Augustine, Fahad Al Abdulla and his brother, Abdullah Al Abdulla. **Scale, Spectacle, and Star Power** The press conference also revealed entertainment and ceremonial highlights. On November 26, the weigh-in will take place at the British Embassy, hosted by HMA Alistair Long, featuring five former world champions. Two of these champions, DAZN commentators, will interview the teams and provide live fight commentary. Amal Anbary will perform at both the weigh-in and fight night. The main event will include a military display, national anthem performance on HH Shai-

kh Khalid’s arrival, and a charity auction with prizes. “Boxing will be split into sets, with Amal Anbary performances in between. Guests can have dinner, enjoy the show, and see the best of the British Army, Royal Navy, and Royal Air Force in action” **Building on Past Success** Royal Rumble IV also promises continuity and growth. Rasheed Mehrinfar compared it to the domestic Dilmun boxing event: “The Dilmun event featured local talent and some from the region, but this Royal Rumble is on a much grander scale. We’re boxing against the best of the British Army, so we have to be at the top of our game. We delivered at Dilmun, and the plan is to do the same here.” Prakash, another Royal Guard boxer, added context from his personal experience: “I lost a couple of fights at Dilmun, including the Olympic qualifier representing Nepal. The Royal Rumble will be tough, but I’m first in, and I’ll do my best like
