Labour Minister Leads Fast-Track Job Drive

His Excellency Yousif bin Abdulhussain Khalaf, Minister of Legal Affairs and Acting Minister of Labour, has launched an intensive drive to ensure that every registered

Bahraini job seeker receives three employment offers before the end of the year, following the directives of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Swift execution

The minister said the Ministry has already begun executing the initiative in close partnership with the private sector, describing it as a major shift in employment policy that empowers citizens with greater choice and accelerates their integration into

the labour market. To guarantee smooth implementation, working hours at the Ministry have been extended from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., underscoring the team's determination to meet national targets on time.

Citizens first

H.E. reaffirmed that, under the leadership of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, Bahrain continues to place its citizens at the centre of development. The minister highlighted that investing in Bahrainis' skills and capabilities is, in essence,

an investment in the Kingdom's future and its competitiveness as a leading and attractive investment destination.

Private sector partnership

Khalaf also expressed appreciation to the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry for its strong support, noting the private sector's positive response and cooperation in providing job opportunities to citizens. He praised the private sector's active role within Team Bahrain, describing it as a key partner driving the Kingdom's economic

growth.

Confidence in talent

The minister emphasised his confidence in the Kingdom's national workforce, calling Bahraini human capital a world-class national asset distinguished by competence and dedication. Power shift ahead

Draft law to scrap Electricity and Water Authority, create national utility, and fines up to BD50,000

A draft law would dissolve the Electricity and Water Authority, set up a National Electricity and Water Company and give an independent regulator tariff powers, with fines up to BD50,000 for breaches.

The bill before Parliament repeals the 1996 Electricity and Water Law and the 2007 decree that formed the Authority.

The regulator, answerable to a minister named by decree, would license operators, set technical, health and safety standards, enforce the rules and approve tariffs and fees after Cabinet approval.

Existing operating units may keep working for a limited time under a transition plan set by the regulator.

Licences

Those already carrying out regulated work before the law takes effect may continue for six months, extendable once by the regulator, provided they apply for the required licences within that period.

Earlier laws would fall away, while present regulations would stay in force until new ones are issued under the draft.

The regulator would have its own budget tied to the state fiscal year, funded by general-budget allocations, service fees, accepted grants and donations, and administrative fines.

It must produce annual reports and strategic plans and consult interested parties before issuing rules or decisions with a direct effect.

Standards

General rules to be issued would cover incident reporting, retention of network maps and plans, compliance with approved technical standards and a ban on non-approved materials or devices.

Supply rules would aim to keep electricity and water regular, secure and efficient, protect the public from risk, set installation and connection terms and permit disconnection for non-payment or unsafe equipment.

They would also tackle unlawful use of services and press for careful consumption.

Electrical works would have to meet approved standards, with unlicensed setups barred and test certificates required from specialists.

Rules

Water works would be tied to rules on quality and potability, source monitoring, sample testing, publication of quality data, staff competence and the use of approved devices, with certificates of completion from qualified personnel.

The National Electricity and

water schemes, the company may partner with the private sector, lease state land and help secure permits.

The regulator may direct it to build new production if required capacity cannot be met by current suppliers.

A binding transition plan would move all assets, liabilities and rights from the Authority to the company, which would step into all contracts and dealings.

The Authority would then be dissolved, with staff moved to the company or another government body while keeping their employment rights.

Information

Penalties include up to six months in jail or fines up to BD50,000 for operating without a licence, breaching rules, giving misleading data or refusing to provide required information.

Fines up to BD500 would apply to anyone who hinders regulator staff or licensees, with the proceeds going to the regulator.

Government support would be set by the Cabinet on a proposal from the finance ministry and in coordination with the regulator.

Asian man on trial for human trafficking

The Public Prosecution has finished its inquiry into a human-trafficking case involving forced labour and sexual exploitation, and has sent an Asian national to the High Criminal Court.

The first hearing is set for Tuesday, 7 October 2025.

The case arose from a report by the Anti-Human Trafficking Directorate after two complainants said they came to Bahrain for work.

Passports

On arrival, their passports were taken, their movement curbed, and they were made to work long hours without any rest days and in conditions that did not match the job.

They also reported sexual exploitation.

Prosecutors heard both complainants and ordered their placement in a shelter run by the National Committee to Combat Trafficking in Persons.

The suspect was questioned and held on remand.

Inquiries

Police inquiries were requested and, according to the case file, supported the account given.

Sentence upheld, suspended

● BD650 repayment key to six-month jail suspension for three years

A man in his thirties kept his six-month jail term after the High Criminal Appeals Court upheld the conviction but ordered the sentence suspended for three years.

Judges took that step after the defendant returned BD650 and the victim signed a waiver.

The Lower Criminal Court had found him guilty of entering the victim's residence and

taking SR6,500, equivalent to BD650, from a wallet.

The victim said he saw the intruder, later identified him with complete certainty from a photograph shown by police, and lodged the complaint that led to the case.

Certificate

On appeal, lawyer Abdulaziz Mousa filed a certificate from the Court Affairs confirming the deposit of the stolen sum with the court treasury, together with a notarised waiver from the victim.

He told the court his client would not repeat the offence and asked for a stay of execution.

In its reasons, the appeals

court said the first-instance judgment set out facts that met all elements of the offence and rested on evidence it accepted, including the victim's statement in the investigation file.

Ruling

The appellant, it added, brought nothing new to disturb the ruling.

The court said penalty assessment and any leniency are matters for the trial court's discretion and need no detailed explanation.

Citing Articles 81 and 83, it upheld the conviction and sentence, and ordered the suspension for three years in light of the repayment and waiver.

East Hidd residential towers



Her Excellency Amna bint Ahmed Al Rumaihi, Minister of Housing and Urban Planning, confirmed that construction on the new-generation residential towers project in East Hidd Housing has reached 86% completion. The project will provide 740 apartments, with all infrastructure works already completed. The Minister made the remarks during a field visit to East Hidd, joined by ministry officials, the Housing Bank, and the engineering team, to review progress on construction packages and infrastructure developments. She emphasised the importance of adhering to timelines to ensure swift delivery of housing services to eligible citizens, praising the efforts of engineers and contractors.

Strategic links

Bahrain and Italy seal data and freight deals in 2025

Data sovereignty and sea-to-air freight deals in 2025 deepen Bahrain-Italy co-operation, with Rome keeping sovereignty over data in Bahraini centres and Italy named a freight partner; non-oil trade reached about \$775m in 2024 and more than 130 Italian firms now operate in the Kingdom.

The two steps follow months of high-level contact.

In January 2025, Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni visited Manama, where the sides announced advanced logistics partnerships and set out plans for closer digital links.

In April, a Bahraini mission led by the Minister of Finance and National Economy visited Rome, Parma and Milan to meet public and private bodies, promote trade and investment, and set out openings in finance, ICT, industry, logistics and tourism.

A standing channel for follow-up has been in place since 2021, when the Bahrain-Italy

Joint Committee was formed; it first met in Rome in 2023 to a three-year plan.

Visit

Earlier, momentum included the 2020 visit by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, after which the Italian Trade Agency (ICE) opened its Manama office and agreements worth more than 330m were signed.

The legal base has been built over two decades.

The 2006 Agreement on the Promotion and Protection of Investments, once ratified, gave Bahraini and Italian investors reciprocal guarantees.

Maritime trade was eased by the 2009 Agreement on Equality of Treatment in Berthing and Port Dues, placing visiting vessels on a par with national ships.

Agreement

At the turn of the millennium, an agreement on mutual tax exemption for air and sea transport aimed to spur flights

and shipping while avoiding double taxation.

Institutional links widened in parallel.

A 2006 memorandum between the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the Union of Italian Chambers of Commerce provided for exchanges of information and delegations.

Memorandum

In 2017, the Economic Development Board signed a memorandum with Confindustria Assafrica & Mediterraneo to build partnerships in logistics, fintech and tourism.

In 2025, a customs memorandum with the Italian Customs Authority added exchanges of expertise and updates to procedures using modern technologies.

Together, the 2025 measures, the joint committee and the treaty framework sit behind a trade relationship that spans industry, energy, services and advanced technologies, with Bahrain positioned as a regional link for cargo that connects sea and air routes.



Denmark bans all civilian drone flights this week due to EU summit: ministry

Denmark will ban all civilian drone flights across the country this week to ensure security as Copenhagen hosts an EU summit gathering heads of government, the transport ministry said Sunday.

Copenhagen is to host an EU summit on Wednesday and Thursday.

"Denmark will host EU leaders in the coming week, where we will have extra focus on security. Therefore, from Monday to Friday, we will close the Danish airspace to all civilian drone flights," Transport Minister Thomas Danielsen said in a statement.

"In this way, we remove the

risk that enemy drones can be confused with legal drones and vice versa," he added.

A violation of the ban can result in a fine or imprisonment for up to two years, the ministry said.

Justice Minister Peter Hummelgaard said in the same statement the purpose of the ban was to simplify the work of police and other authorities.

"The police are on heightened alert, and our authorities must use their forces where necessary to take care of Danes and our guests."

He said the ban would mean police would not have to "spend their efforts on civilian drones" that do not pose a problem to security and police.



Mysterious drone sightings across Denmark since September 22 have prompted the closure of several airports, with Denmark hinting at possible Russian involvement, charges Moscow has rejected.



UK agrees loan guarantee for Jaguar Land Rover after cyberattack

London, United Kingdom

The British government agreed a loan guarantee worth £1.5 billion (\$2 billion) for Jaguar Land Rover to shore up its cash reserves and supply chain, the trade minister said Sunday, after a damaging recent cyberattack. JLR said on September 2 that it had been targeted by hackers, forcing it to suspend production at its UK factories.

The automaker said on Thursday that its IT systems were partly back online as part of a "phased restart", but production would remain on pause until at least October 1.

The government announced that it would back the company with a loan guarantee "expected to unlock up to £1.5 billion to give certainty to its supply chain".

The move does not mean that the government will lend money directly to JLR, which is owned by India's Tata Motors.

Instead, a government credit agency will provide the guarantee for a loan from a commercial bank that will be repaid over five years.

Trade minister Peter Kyle said the guarantee "will help support the supply chain and protect skilled jobs in the West Midlands, Merseyside and throughout the UK".

"This cyberattack was not only an assault on an iconic British brand, but on our world-leading automotive sector and the men and women whose livelihoods depend on it," he said.

JLR has said its partial systems restart was helping to clear a backlog of payments to its suppliers, after unions warned that some were at risk of collapse due to the disruption.

Cyber gangs have increasingly targeted luxury brands and retailers, including Britain's Marks and Spencer, Harrods and the Co-op food chain.

Trump hints at 'something special' in Middle East talks

US President Donald Trump yesterday hinted at a breakthrough in the Middle East crisis, saying "all are on board for something special," on the eve of Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's visit to the White House.

"We have a real chance for GREATNESS IN THE MIDDLE EAST," Trump said in a post on his Truth Social platform. "ALL ARE ON BOARD FOR SOMETHING SPECIAL, FIRST TIME EVER. WE WILL GET IT DONE!!!"

Earlier Friday, Trump had told reporters in Washington "I think we have a deal" on Gaza.

On the same day, addressing the United Nations, Netanyahu vowed to block a Palestinian state while also committing to

"finish the job" against Hamas, days after Britain, France and other Western powers recognized a state of Palestine.

Netanyahu is scheduled to visit Trump at the White House on Monday.

Hamas carried out the worst-ever attack on Israel on October 7, 2023, killing 1,219 people, mostly civilians, according to an AFP tally from Israeli official figures, in the deadliest day in the country's history.

They also took 251 hostages, of which 47 remain in Gaza, including 25 the Israeli military says are dead.

Israel's offensive has killed more than 65,549 Palestinians, also mostly civilians, according to health ministry figures in the Hamas-run territory that the United Nations considers reliable.

◆ The US State Department

said it would revoke the visa of Colombia's leftist President Gustavo Petro, who returned to Bogota on Saturday after being accused of "incendiary actions" during a pro-Palestinian street protest in New York. Petro was in New York for the UN General Assembly, where he fiercely rebuked US President Donald Trump's administration and called for a criminal inquiry into recent US strikes on alleged drug trafficking boats in the Caribbean in his Tuesday address. The Colombian leader shared video on social media of himself speaking through megaphone to a large crowd on Friday, calling on "nations of the world" to contribute soldiers for an army "larger than that of the United States." "That is why, from here in New York, I ask all soldiers in the United States Army not to point their rifles at humanity. Disobey Trump's order! Obey the order of humanity!" Petro said.

◆ Netanyahu to meet Trump as Israel faces isolation over Gaza war

Facing increasing isolation abroad and mounting pressure at home, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu will defend his intention to "finish the job" in Gaza when he meets US President Donald Trump today. The meeting comes days after Trump unveiled a 21-point plan aimed at ending the war in the Palestinian territory during discussions with Arab and Muslim leaders on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly. On Sunday, Trump hinted at "something special" to come in Middle East talks, adding in a post on his Truth Social platform: "WE WILL GET IT DONE!!!" On Friday, Trump had told reporters in Washington "I think we have a deal" on Gaza, even as Netanyahu, speaking at the UN, vowed to "finish the job" in Israel's war against Hamas.

◆ **A visit** to Egypt by Washington's top envoy to Israel, Mike Huckabee, has been postponed, a US official said yesterday. Earlier, a US embassy spokesperson had said that Huckabee would be visiting Cairo for talks with Egyptian officials, making what media reports said would have been a rare trip by a sitting US envoy. "The trip has been postponed," the official said, without providing further details. Media reports said the talks had been expected to focus on the Gaza war, which has strained relations between Israel and Cairo. Egypt, along with the United States and Qatar, has been mediating between Israel and Hamas in efforts to end the war. Cairo has criticised Israel's ongoing air and ground assault in Gaza City, where the United Nations estimated a million people resided before the offensive began. Since the war broke out in October 2023, Egypt has repeatedly warned that the fighting risks driving hundreds of thousands of Palestinians across its border into the Sinai Peninsula.

China sentences former agricultural minister to death

China's former agricultural minister was sentenced to death yesterday on corruption charges, with a two-year reprieve, a court statement said.

Tang Renjian accepted cash and property bribes totalling more than 268 million yuan (\$38 million) between 2007 and 2024, the People's Court of Changchun in northeast Jilin province said in a statement.

The court ruled that the bribes "caused particularly severe losses to the interests of the state and the people, and therefore warranted the death penalty", adding that Tang had confessed to his crimes and expressed remorse.

Tang's sentencing is the latest in President Xi Jinping's sweeping anti-graft campaign that has brought down several high-level figures.

Supporters of Xi's anti-corruption drive say the campaign promotes clean governance, but critics argue it provides the president with the power to purge political rivals.

Tang previously served as governor of the northwestern province of Gansu, as well as the vice chairman of southern

autonomous region Guangxi. His downfall follows similar graft investigations into former defence ministers Li Shangfu and Wei Fenghe.

Li was removed from office just seven months into the job, and later expelled from the Chinese Communist Party for offences including suspected bribery, state media said.

His successor Dong Jun was also reportedly placed under investigation on corruption charges.

Aides charged after rally stampede **kills 40**

Police charged three close aides of a popular actor and politician with culpable homicide and negligence yesterday after a stampede at his rally in southern India killed at least 40 people, officials said.

Some 27,000 people thronged a public road in Tamil Nadu state in the hope of seeing the politician, known by the single name of Vijay, on Saturday but panic broke out, triggering a deadly crush.

Police filed a case against three senior members of Vijay's party, whom they identified as Bussy Anand, G.R. Nirmal Kumar and V.P. Mathiyazhagan.

"A case has been registered and the investigation will reveal all who are involved," senior police officer S. Davidson Devasirvatham told reporters.

All three have been charged with "culpable homicide not amounting to murder" and negligent conduct endangering human life.

Witnesses cited hours of delays, insufficient police presence and people falling from a tree branch onto the audience as reasons contributing to the crush.

Vijay was addressing the rally in Karur district when the crowd surged suddenly, forcing him to halt his speech.

Videos on social media showed him tossing water bottles to supporters shortly before the panic broke out.

"I am at a loss for words to express the pain my heart endures," the 51-year-old star said in a statement on Sunday.

"This is indeed an irreparable loss for us," he said, adding that he would pay two million rupees (\$22,000) to each of the victims' families as compensation.

Senior district official M. Thangavel said 40 people had been killed in the stampede, raising an earlier toll of 39.

Nine children were among the dead.

Huge crowds

State police chief G. Venkataraman said crowds had been waiting for hours after the public was told that Vijay would arrive at the venue by noon.

"The crowds started coming in from 11 am. He came at 7:40 pm," Venkataraman told reporters. "The people lacked sufficient food and water under the hot

sun."

He said 10,000 people were expected but about 27,000 had turned up.

Survivor B. Kanishka said he was "pushed down by the crowd all of a sudden".

"There was absolutely no space to move," he told the Hindu newspaper. "I subsequently fainted."

Others said poor organisation

and an hours-long wait left people restless before the gathering spiralled out of control.

Another survivor, identified as Karthick, told the paper that the disaster could have been prevented "if people were not forced to wait for hours together".

"Poor planning and execution of the programme and lack of police personnel at the spot were also the reason," he said.

tion aimed at undermining the rights and interests of its people will face a firm and appropriate response," it added.

The return of the sanctions ends months of tense diplomacy aimed at reviving nuclear talks derailed since June, when Israeli and US forces bombed Iranian nuclear facilities.

Despite the reimposition, Western leaders stressed channels for dialogue remained open.

Kaja Kallas, the European Union's top diplomat, on Sunday said the reimposition of sanctions "must not be the end of diplomacy", adding that "a sustainable solution to the Iranian nuclear issue can only be achieved through negotiations".

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio urged Iran to "accept direct talks, held in good faith".

He also called on UN member states to "immediately" implement sanctions to "pressure Iran's leaders to do what is right for their nation, and best for the safety of the world".

The British, French and German foreign ministers said in a joint statement they would continue to seek "a new diplomatic solution to ensure Iran never gets a nuclear weapon".

They also called on Tehran "to refrain from any escalatory

action".

'No choice'

Iran had allowed UN inspectors to return to its nuclear sites, but President Masoud Pezeshkian said the United States had offered only a short reprieve in return for handing over its whole stockpile of enriched uranium, a proposal he described as unacceptable.

An 11th-hour effort by Iran allies Russia and China to postpone the sanctions until April failed to win enough votes in the Security Council on Friday, leading to the measures taking effect at 3:30 am in Tehran (0000 GMT) on Sunday.

Germany, which triggered the return of sanctions alongside Britain and France, had "no choice" as Iran was not complying with its obligations, Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul said.

"For us, it is imperative: Iran must never acquire a nuclear weapon," he told the UN General Assembly.

"But let me emphasise: we remain open to negotiations on a new agreement. Diplomacy can and should continue."

Russia made clear it would not enforce the sanctions, considering them invalid.

The sanctions "finally ex-

posed the West's policy of sabotaging the pursuit of constructive solutions in the UN Security Council, as well as its desire to extract unilateral concessions from Tehran through blackmail and pressure," Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov said.

Iran has long contended that it is not seeking nuclear weapons.

Newspapers in the Islamic republic gave contrasting reactions to the reimposition of the sanctions.

The ultraconservative newspaper Kayhan, which opposes any dialogue with the United States, suggested the sanctions would likely have been imposed even if Iran had engaged in negotiations.

The reformist daily Ham Mihan wrote: "The big question is whether Russia and China will maintain their position".

Economic impact

The sanctions are a "snapback" of measures frozen in 2015 when Iran agreed to major restrictions on its nuclear programme under a deal negotiated by former president Barack Obama.

The United States already imposed massive sanctions when President Donald Trump with-

drew from the deal in his first term.

Iran and the United States had held several rounds of Omani-brokered talks earlier this year before they collapsed in June when first Israel and then the United States attacked Iranian nuclear facilities.

Iran recalled its envoys from Britain, France and Germany for consultations on Saturday, state television reported.

On the ground, Iranians lamented the likely impact of the new sanctions on an already squeezed economy.

"The current (economic) situation was already very difficult, but it's going to get worse," said an Iranian engineer who asked to be identified only by his first name Dariush.

"The impact of the renewed sanctions is already evident: the exchange rate is increasing, and this is leading to higher prices," the 50-year-old said, complaining that the standard of living is "much lower" than it was two or three years ago.

The economic strain was underscored on Sunday when the Iranian rial plunged to a record low against the US dollar on the black market, trading at around 1.12 million per dollar, according to the currency-tracking websites Bonbast and AlanChand.



Iran has been under various international sanctions since 1979, but the most extensive were imposed by the United States, the European Union, and the United Nations over its nuclear programme. At their peak in 2012, these sanctions cut Iran's oil exports by more than half, from about 2.5 million barrels per day to just 1.1 million barrels per day, severely impacting its economy.

New Gaza-bound flotilla sets off from Sicily

A flotilla of 10 vessels set off for Gaza from Sicily, southern Italy, on Saturday, with 60 people on board including elected officials from nine nations, said organisers.

A statement from the Freedom Flotilla Coalition (FFC) and the Thousand Madleens to Gaza (TMTG) said they intended to "break the illegal Israeli block-

ade" to deliver aid to the Palestinian territory.

"For the most part, our boats carry medical supplies, dry food and school equipment, as this was highlighted as some of the biggest priorities by Palestinians on the ground," they added.

They intend to join the Global Sumud Flotilla which is also bound for Gaza carrying aid supplies.

On board are elected officials from the European Parliament and from countries including Belgium, France, Ireland, Spain and the United States.

On Wednesday, the United Nations called for an investigation into alleged drone attacks off Greece against the Global Sumud Flotilla, which activists have blamed on Israel.

World's **highest bridge** opens to traffic in China

The world's highest bridge opened to traffic in China on Sunday, capping an engineering feat three years in the making and snatching the record from another bridge in the same province.

The Huajiang Grand Canyon Bridge towers 625 metres (2,051 feet) above a river and vast gorge in the country's rugged southern province of Guizhou, also home to the 565-metre Beipanjiang Bridge that is now the world's second highest.

Live drone footage broadcast by state media on Sunday showed vehicles traversing the immense structure, its blue support towers partially engulfed in clouds.

Crowds of onlookers including project engineers and local officials gathered on the bridge for a ceremony to mark the occasion, several expressing their pride and excitement in live interviews to state media.

"The opening of the Huajiang Grand Canyon Bridge reduces travel time between the two sides from two hours to two minutes," Zhang Yin, head of the provincial transport depart-

ment, said at a press conference Wednesday.

Its opening makes "enormous

improvements to regional transportation conditions and (injects) new impetus into regional

economic and social development", she said.

China has invested heavily in

major infrastructure projects in recent decades, a period of rapid economic growth and urbanisa-

tion in the country.

The hilly province of Guizhou in particular is crisscrossed by thousands of bridges -- which now include the world's two highest. State news agency Xinhua said Wednesday that nearly half of the world's 100 highest bridges are located in the province.

The Huajiang Grand Canyon Bridge took more than three years to complete, Xinhua reported. Its 1,420-metre main span makes it the "world's largest-span bridge built in a mountainous area", it added.



Apart from the world's highest bridge, the tallest -- measured in terms of the height of its own structure, rather than the distance to the ground -- remains France's Millau viaduct at 343 metres.

India warns not to condone 'terrorist epicenter' Pakistan

India on Saturday warned countries against turning a blind eye to what it called support for terrorism from Pakistan, which has basked in closer relations with US President Donald Trump.

Addressing the UN General Assembly a day after Pakistan used the forum to appeal for talks, Indian Foreign Minister Subrahmanyam Jaishankar demanded "much deeper global cooperation" against terrorism.

"India has confronted this challenge since independence, having a neighbor that is an epicenter of global terrorism," Jaishankar said, without saying Pakistan's name.

"For decades now, major international terrorist attacks are traced back to that one country," he said.

"Those who condone nations that sponsor terror will find that it comes back to bite them," he said, also without naming countries.

India in May launched attacks on military sites in Pakistan after suspected Islamist gunmen massacred tourists on the Indian side of divided Kashmir.

Jaishankar said that India "exercised its right to defend its people against terrorism."

Pakistan denied responsibility. In his own UN address on Friday, Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif said In-

dia showed "arrogance" and received a "bloody nose" with counterattacks.

Sharif before the UN summit traveled to Washington to meet alongside Pakistan's military chief with Trump, who has voiced hope of mediating between India and Pakistan.

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi has played down Trump's role in reaching a ceasefire in May and stuck to New Delhi's refusal of outside mediation on Kashmir.

Pakistan by contrast has heaped praise on Trump and

said he deserves the Nobel Peace Prize, rekindling Islamabad's relationship with Washington that had grown tense during the two-decade Afghanistan war.

Trump has ramped up tariffs on India, pointing to its purchases of oil from sanctioned Russia.

Jaishankar in his speech said that India will need to correct "overdependence on a particular market."

"We now see tariff volatility and uncertain market access. As a result, de-risking is a growing compulsion," he said.

Vietnam to evacuate 250,000 from coast ahead of Typhoon Bualoi

Vietnam plans to evacuate more than 250,000 residents from coastal areas on Sunday ahead of the arrival of Typhoon Bualoi, which is expected to lash the country's steel-producing central belt.

The storm -- the 10th to affect Vietnam this year -- is currently at sea generating winds of 130 kilometres per hour (80 miles per hour) and is expected to make landfall at 7:00 pm (1200 GMT), according to the meteorology agency.

Central Vietnam's largest city Danang plans evacuate more than 210,000 residents, state media reported, while more than 32,000 residents of Hue

living near coastal areas are also set to be moved to safer areas.

More than 15,000 residents in Ha Tinh -- known as a key steel production hub -- have been slated for evacuation to schools and medical centres converted into temporary shelters, authorities said.

Nearly 117,000 military personnel have been mobilised. Four domestic airports were shut and all fishing boats in the typhoon's path have been called back to harbour.

"I feel a bit anxious but still hopeful that everything will be fine in the aftermath. We were all safe after the recent typhoon Kajiki. I hope this one will be the same or less severe," Nguyen Cuong, 29, a resident of Ha Tinh City, told AFP.

The typhoon is expected to pack winds of around 133 kph as it makes landfall on Sunday evening, Vietnam's National Center for Hydro-Meteorological Forecasting said on its website.

"This is a fast-moving storm with very strong intensity and a wide area of impact, capable of causing a combination of various types of natural disasters such as strong winds, heavy rain, floods, landslides, and coastal inundation," state media quoted centre director Mai Van Khiem as saying.

Scientists warn that storms are becoming more powerful as the world warms due to the effects of human-driven climate change.

cent times in order to pursue a doctorate at the University of Oxford, and Emma has revealed that she doesn’t miss some aspects of the industry.







Emotional Marquez wins seventh MotoGP title

Spaniard seals first MotoGP crown since 2019 after comeback from injuries

● Marc Marquez wins seventh MotoGP world title

● Finishes second behind Bagnaia in Japan

An emotional Marc Marquez said he was “at peace” with himself after winning his first MotoGP world title since 2019 yesterday, capping a remarkable comeback from an injury nightmare.

The Spaniard finished second at the Japan grand prix behind fellow Ducati rider Francesco Bagnaia to clinch his seventh world title with five events to spare.

It marked a triumphant return from a gruelling struggle with injuries since breaking his right arm in 2020 that almost forced him to hang up his helmet.

The 32-year-old said his title was “written in the stars” but admitted he had doubts he would return to the top.

“Of course I feel happy but the first feeling is that I feel at peace with myself,” he said.

“It was Marc against Marc during five years, Marc against injury, but especially about the mental side was difficult.

“I took super difficult decisions but I closed the circle in the perfect way,” he added.

Marquez has been in brilliant form all year and knew that placing first or second would clinch the title regardless of where his brother and closest champion-

ship rival Alex finished.

He wrapped up the world championship in Japan for the fourth time in his career, following 2014, 2016 and 2018, and now draws level with Italian motorcycle legend Valentino Rossi on seven titles.

After crossing the line, Marquez raised both arms aloft before sobbing and yelling as his achievement began to sink in.

“One of the good things of humans is you can’t forget the bad moments,” he said.

“It’s difficult to forget because still today, I feel it some days. But the dream comes true.”

Bagnaia had a scare when smoke started coming out of his Ducati with around nine laps remaining but he held on to win in Japan for the second year running.

Honda's Joan Mir finished third, followed by Aprilia's Marco Bezzecchi. Alex Marquez was sixth.

Marc Marquez is in his first season with Ducati and he said it had been “a very long journey” to the championship.

“We took some difficult, important decisions but always followed my instincts,” he said.

“The people around me help a lot to take the decisions, but just to give me the chance to follow my instincts.”

Outgoing world champion Jorge Martin was ruled out of the grand prix after fracturing his collarbone in a crash with team-mate Bezzecchi in Saturday's sprint.

Houghton and Najashi Rashdan in the Senior MAX, and Abdulqader Qasem and Musaad Albassam in the DD2 MAX.

In round one, Charlie claimed his Micro MAX win after completing the nine-lap final in nine minutes 18.624 seconds. He powered to the front early in the race and finished ahead of Abdulaziz Alsarraf, while Shiv Tummala joined them on the podium in third.

In the Mini MAX, Oliver claimed a pole-to-flag victory in 9:01.867 after nine laps. Jude Andrews was the runner-up 1.976s behind, while Tariq Soofi finished third 6.392s back.

Charlie and Oliver were also the winners of the pre-finals in their classes.

Tense Finishes

Shun triumphed in the Junior MAX final after an impressive start that saw him take the lead in lap one. He then defended his position throughout 15 laps and won in 14:11.637. Shun pipped Nathan at the finish line by just 0.192s, while Leopold Juch was a close third, 1.052s back. Nathan had earlier won the pre-final.

In the Senior MAX category, Houghton took the win after a heated battle with Mohammed Alhasan and Tye Mejia. Houghton captured the advantage on lap four and never relinquished his leading position, taking the chequered flag after 15 laps in 13:45.717.

Pole-sitter Alhasan, who won the pre-final, lost two places early on but was able to overtake Mejia on lap 12 en route to finishing just 0.159s behind the winner. Mejia secured the final podium step 0.485s back.

In the DD2 MAX, Qasem was the outright winner after starting from pole. He triumphed with a time of 13:35.974 and completed the 15-lap event 6.021s ahead of Albassam. Raoul Sadi came fourth 7.501s adrift. Qasem had also triumphed in the pre-final earlier in the day.

Champions Consolidate

In the SRMC's second round, Charlie completed his Micro MAX double for the weekend after gaining the lead on lap one and charging on to the cheq-

uered flag. He clinched his class after nine laps in 9:21.805, finishing with a comfortable gap from Abdulaziz in second place. Charlie had also taken the pre-final.

Oliver joined him in securing back-to-back Mini MAX wins after a tight battle with Jude in the final's concluding laps. Oliver prevailed in 9:03.933, but was just 0.122s ahead of Jude at the finish. Rayyan Najjar clinched third place 6.439s behind. Tariq put in a strong drive to win the pre-final.

Category Rivalries Intensify

In the Junior MAX category, Nathan overtook pole-sitter Shun on lap one and gradually extended his advantage over the 15-lap final. He triumphed in

13:59.989 and was 4.324s clear of Shun. Ahmed Jawed joined them on the podium after finishing 5.254s adrift. Nathan had also triumphed in the pre-final earlier in the round.

The Senior MAX class saw plenty of heated action throughout the field, as Rashdan was able to get the better of Houghton on lap three and maintain his lead despite a thrilling challenge from his closest rivals until the very end. Rashdan, who also took the pre-final, won in 13:46.907, with Houghton just 0.044s behind in second place after 15 laps. Houghton was able to overtake Fahad Almuqla on the final lap, as Almuqla was forced to settle for third 0.576s from first.

In the DD2 MAX, Albassam led Qasem and Sadi from start to finish, winning in 13:32.685, creating a good distance from Qasem who was 8.500s back. Sadi finished 12.096s adrift in third. The trio finished in the same order in the pre-final.

Season Continues

This year's SRMC features four rounds in all. The series wraps up with another double-header on 17 and 18 October with meetings three and four lighting up the BIKC track.

That will then set the stage for the new BRMC season, which is set to feature eight rounds, flagging off on October 31 and continuing until April of next year.

Varma's heroics seal Asia Cup glory for India in dramatic final

A magnificent, unbeaten 69 from Tilak Varma guided India to a nail-biting five-wicket victory over arch-rivals Pakistan to clinch the Men's T20 Asia Cup in a tense final at the Dubai International Stadium yesterday.

Chasing a target of 147, India's innings was in tatters at 20-3 after a devastating opening spell from Faheem Ashraf (3/29) and Shaheen Shah Afridi. With the top order back in the pavilion, Varma displayed immense composure,

anchoring the chase with a calculated 53-ball knock.

He first steadied the innings with a 57-run partnership with Sanju Samson (24) before a blistering 60-run stand with Shivam Dube (33 off 22) turned the tide. Rinku Singh then smashed a boundary to seal the win with two balls to spare, sparking wild celebrations.

Earlier, Pakistan had collapsed from a strong position of 84/0 to be bowled out for 146. A fiery 57 from Sahibzada Farhan and 46 from
