MPs back lifting ‘Karaf’ trawl ban

Parliament yesterday backed an urgent move to scrap Decision 205 of 2018, the ban on bottom-trawl net fishing, known locally as ‘Karaf’.

The vote asks the government to lift the ban and replace it with rules.

The motion was put forward by MPs Khalid Buanaq, Hisham Al Awadhi, Ahmed Qarata, Zainab AbdulAmeer and Ahmed Al Salloom.

Buanaq said the seven years since the ban took effect have not brought a clear rise in fish stocks or diversity in Bahrain’s waters.

He said some fish and shrimp have shifted to neighbouring waters, which has cut the income of local fishermen and thinned supply in markets.

Lawful work

The lawmaker added that licensed fishermen have been shut out of lawful work while unlicensed fishing has grown, tilting fair competition at home.

Rather than a blanket ban, Buanaq called for controlled use of bottom-trawl nets under set rules that keep the marine habitat in mind and protect household incomes.

He said the item was fast-tracked due to its direct effect on fishermen and the marine environment.

Five sentenced in fake employment, social insurance fraud case

● Accused register 55 workers under two fictitious companies

The First High Criminal Court has sentenced the first defendant to five years in prison and a BD10,000 fine, and the second defendant to three years in prison and a BD5,000 fine in a fake employment and social insurance fraud case.

The third to fifth female defendants were each sentenced to three months in prison and fined BD1,000, with the court ordering a three-year suspension of the fifth defendant’s sentence.

All five were convicted of forging employment documents and registering 55 workers under two fictitious companies to fraudulently obtain BD3,199,400 in benefits from the General Organization for Social Insurance (GOSI) between 2022 and 2024.

According to testimony from a court supervisor at GOSI’s Legal Affairs Directorate, the case began when the authority’s Inspection Department detected suspected violations of the Social Insurance Law involving two companies registered in the system.

Medical milestone

RMS affirms ongoing organ donation campaign offers new hope to patients

The national organ donation campaign embodies the Kingdom of Bahrain’s commitment to compassion and solidarity, offering renewed hope to patients in need.

15 illegal workers detained and 73 violators deported

● LMRA conducts 1,582 inspection campaigns, visits

Fifteen violating and irregular workers were detained and 73 violators deported following 1,582 inspection campaigns and visits conducted by the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) between October 19 and 25, 2025.

The inspection campaigns and

visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

Inspection visits

The Authority pointed out that 1,555 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 27 joint inspection campaigns, 16 campaigns in the Capital



Governorate, 6 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 3 campaigns in the Northern Governorate and 2 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The government entities that participated in the campaigns are the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate’s respective Police Directorate, the General Directorate of Verdict Enforcement and Alternative Sentencing, the General Directorate of Crime Detection and Forensic Science and the Coast Guard Command.

Funds misused

Director jailed 15 years for embezzlement and money laundering

● **Ordered to repay and fined more than BD500,000**

The First High Criminal Court has sentenced the director of a social centre affiliated with the Ministry of Social Development to 15 years in prison and ordered him to repay and pay fines exceeding BD500,000, in addition to confiscating funds linked to the crimes.

He was convicted of collecting donations without a license, embezzling the collected funds, and laundering money derived from those offences.

Involvement

The court also sentenced the second defendant to one year in prison for his involvement.

According to the verdict, the court sentenced the first de-

defendant to 10 years in prison, ordered him to return BD192,000, and fined him an equal amount for the charges related to the illegal collection and embezzlement of donations.

The court further imposed an additional five-year prison term and a BD100,000 fine, along with the confiscation of BD97,000 in connection with the money laundering offence.

Report

The case began when the Public Prosecution received a report from a government ministry following the findings of an administrative investigation committee, which uncovered suspected criminal offences committed by the director of one of its affiliated centres.

The investigation revealed that the director had collected funds for public purposes with-

out authorization, appropriated money belonging to the centre, and conspired with another individual to forge and use private documents.

A financial audit of the centre's operations uncovered serious financial and administrative irregularities, including the unlicensed collection of cash and in-kind donations—such as coupons and Ramadan food baskets—without notifying the ministry.

Funds

The defendant was found to have used part of the funds for personal benefit, while distributing some as loans to social cases, and spending the remainder on bonuses, gifts, and recreational events for employees and residents.

He also used portions of the illegally collected money to fund Eid meals, social programmes, and training courses, in clear violation of the ministry's regulations governing the management of charitable contributions.

‘Humane reasons’

Patients with sickle cell, MS, or broken bones who don't qualify for disability cards could get temporary parking permits under a non-binding proposal passed by Parliament yesterday, which now goes to the government.

If adopted by the government, the scheme would let eligible patients park nearer to hospitals, shopping centres, stadiums, clinics and places of worship.

Temporary permits would be issued on approved medical reports through the Ministry of Social Development or the General Directorate of Traffic.

Logo

The bays would carry a distinctive logo and be supported by a public awareness campaign explaining their location and use.

“I brought this proposal for humane reasons before anything else,” said MP Hanan Fardan during the debate.

“We already have bays for people with disabilities and that right is respected. But there are other groups who need short-term help, people with sickle cell disease, multiple sclerosis, or those coming out of surgery or with fractures, who need spaces close to where they are going.”

Schemes

She added: “Countries such as the UAE, Australia and Canada already run similar schemes that can be adapted to Bahrain. Bahrain is a “Kingdom of Humanity”, and we hope this measure is taken up.”

The plan would sit outside the permanent disability card system so that people with short-term or fluctuating mobility problems can access essential services.

The logo would appear on roadside signs with wording such as “Parking reserved for patients with temporary health conditions”.

One-month window approved to contest criminal orders

● **Current seven-day limit replaced**

One-month window to contest criminal orders won Parliament's approval yesterday, replacing the current seven-day limit.

The change rewrites Article 277 of the Criminal Procedure Law.

The Public Prosecution will have one month from the date the order is issued to object, while other parties will have one month from the date of service.

Objection

An objection lodged with the court registry cancels the order as though it had not been made.

MP Dr Ali Al Nuaimi, who sponsored the measure, said it forms part of work to improve the criminal order process while keeping swift handling of simple cases in view.

“The aim is to give a person subject to an order enough time to study it and decide to accept or object,” he told the chamber.

He added that earlier amendments in 2020 and 2025 dealt with penalty levels and who may issue an order but did not touch the objection period.

“This step fills that gap in the timetable,” he said.

During the review stage, the Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Waqf argued that a longer period cuts against the purpose of criminal orders, which is quick disposal of straightforward cases, noting the current period already runs from the date of service and that appeal rights remain.

The Ministry of Interior said the matter lies outside its remit.

The National Institution for Human Rights said the change does not curb protected rights or clash with relevant international instruments and added that a longer period supports an effective right to object and to seek redress.

Urgent call to link Hamala homes to water network

Parliament yesterday approved, as a matter of urgency, a plan to connect piped water to 30 homes in Block 1012 in Hamala.

The decision directs the authorities to bring the block onto the mains as soon as possible, with priority for households with children and older people.

Residents there have no public water supply, though streets about one kilometre away already have water, power and sewerage.

Proposers say the short distance makes the link a straightforward job.

Without a mains feed, fam-

ilies must hire private firms to refill storage tanks, adding costs many young households cannot carry on top of loans and spent savings.

The proposal was tabled by MPs Dr Muneer Seroor, Khalid Buanaq, Lulwa Al Rumaihi, Jalal Kadhem and Mohammed Al Ahmed.

US kills 14 in strikes on alleged Pacific drug boats

US forces killed 14 people in strikes that destroyed four alleged drug-smuggling boats in the eastern Pacific Ocean, Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth said Tuesday, bringing the death toll from Washington's anti-narcotics campaign to at least 57.

The United States began carrying out the strikes -- which experts say are illegal -- in early September, and has now destroyed at least 14 vessels in the Caribbean and Pacific.

"A total of 14 narco-terrorists were killed during the three strikes, with one survivor. All strikes were in international waters with no US forces harmed," Hegseth said in a post on X about strikes carried out the

day before. "The four vessels were known by our intelligence apparatus, transiting along known nar-

co-trafficking routes, and carrying narcotics," he said.

The Pentagon chief's post included video of the strikes, the first of which targeted two stationary boats that appeared to be moored together, and the other two on vessels that were speeding across open water.

Hegseth said that US Southern Command "immediately" started searching for the sole survivor of the strikes, and that Mexican authorities "accepted the case and assumed responsibility for coordinating the rescue."

He did not specify what happened to the survivor or if the person was found.

"We will track them, we will network them, and then, we will hunt and kill them," Hegseth said of drug traffickers.

Israel accuses Hamas of faking recovery of Gaza hostage remains

Israel's military yesterday accused Hamas of staging its search for the remains of a Gaza hostage body, one of 28 the group had agreed to hand over under a ceasefire deal.

"Yesterday (Monday) Hamas operatives were documented removing body remains from a structure that had been prepared in advance and burying them nearby," the military said in a statement, attaching drone footage which it said showed the act.

The aerial footage shows three individuals exiting a damaged Gaza building holding what could be a body wrapped in a white sheet.

The individuals then bury the alleged body moments before a bulldozer parked nearby uncovers it again.

"The Hamas organisation summoned representatives of the Red Cross and staged a false display of discovering a deceased hostage's body," the military statement said.

Three people wearing red vests appear in the video, which AFP was unable to independently verify. The military did not specify the location of the footage which was filmed on Monday.

"This footage clearly shows

that the Hamas organisation is attempting to create a false impression of efforts to locate the bodies, while in fact holding deceased hostages whose remains it refuses to release as required by the agreement," the statement said.

The statement came as Israel accused Hamas of breaking the terms of the US-brokered ceasefire.

Hamas handed over what it said was the body of a 16th hostage Monday but Israeli forensic examination determined Hamas had in fact handed over partial remains of Ofir Tzarfati -- whose body had already been brought back to Israel around two years ago, according to a statement from Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office.

"I can confirm to you today that Hamas dug a hole in the ground yesterday, placed the partial remains of Ofir inside of it, covered it back up with dirt, and handed it over to the Red Cross," government spokeswoman Shosh Bedrosian told journalists Tuesday.

Hamas says it is committed to the ceasefire terms, but lacks the equipment needed to locate and excavate hostage bodies potentially buried under buildings collapsed by air strikes.

US, Japan sign agreement on 'securing' rare earths supply

The United States and Japan signed an agreement on Tuesday for "securing" supplies of critical minerals and rare earths, the White House said, as President Donald Trump visited Tokyo.

The deal comes as the United States tries to boost access to critical minerals with China tightening controls on rare earths.

The two sides also agreed to increase cooperation in shipbuilding, and said a number of Japanese investment projects in energy, AI and other sectors are being considered, although there were few details.

US inks \$80 bn nuclear 'partnership' for AI

The Trump administration has entered into a new \$80 billion "strategic partnership" to boost nuclear power generation to support AI deployment, one of its partners on the project announced Tuesday.

The initiative anticipates "at least \$80 billion of new reactors" across the United States to "accelerate nuclear power and artificial intelligence deployment in America," said a press release from Brookfield Asset Management, which will partner with Westinghouse Electric Company and Cameco

Corporation. The press release did not specify a timeframe for the buildout. A Brookfield spokesman said the announcement was related to Trump's May executive order to have 10 "new large reactors with complete design under construction by 2030."

The US government is responsible for the capital to begin the project, the Brookfield spokesman said.

The announcement marks Washington's most tangible investment in nuclear power since Donald Trump returned to the White House in January.

Tech giants such as Google and Microsoft have also unveiled major nuclear initiatives to meet hefty AI-related energy demand.

The initiative "will help unleash President Trump's grand vision to fully energize America and win the global AI race," said Energy Secretary Chris Wright. "President Trump promised a renaissance of nuclear power, and now he is delivering."

Besides the AI "race," which the Trump administration characterizes as a national security priority, the press release also hints at a considerable economic lift from the venture.

A Taste of the Tide: Shrimps at Their Best

The best way to enjoy this seasonal crustacean

Plump, juicy, and kissed with a hint of sweetness — shrimps are the jewels of the sea. Take a bite, close your eyes, and you can almost hear the waves crashing on Bahrain's shores. For seafood lovers, this is pure bliss on a plate. Living in Bahrain means we get some of the freshest catch around. The shrimp season runs from August to January, when the waters come alive with flavour. After that, a six-month break lets these little crustaceans grow and thrive, ensuring a plentiful (and delicious) comeback.

What makes shrimp such a star? Versatility. You can grill them, fry them, simmer them in curry, or toss them into a rice dish like machboos or biryani, and they will still steal the show. They soak up flavours beautifully, so whether it is garlic butter or coconut milk, shrimp make every dish sing.

Now, let us set the record straight — shrimps are not as "unhealthy" as some think. In fact, they are low in bad fats, high in good fats, and packed with



SPICY SHRIMP LINGUINE

Ingredients:

- 230 gms linguine or fettuccini noodles
- 400 gms raw large shrimp peeled and deveined
- 1 ½ table spoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 cup broccoli cut into florets
- 1 medium red bell pepper cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 shallot minced
- 2 cloves garlic minced
- 700 gms of readymade spicy arrabiata pasta sauce
- 3 tablespoons minced fresh parsley
- 3 tablespoons finely grated Parmesan optional

Instructions:

- Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Cook the noodles according to package instructions.
- Meanwhile, heat the

olive oil in a deep skillet over medium-high heat. Once the oil is hot, add the broccoli, bell peppers, and salt. Let cook for 2 minutes, then add the shallot. Continue cooking until the vegetables are crisp-tender and the shallots begin to brown, about 3 additional minutes. Add the garlic and cook just until fragrant, about 30 seconds.

- Stir in the pasta sauce. Bring the sauce to a gentle boil. Reduce the heat so that the sauce simmers gently. Stir in the shrimp and let simmer until the shrimp are cooked through (about 5 minutes).
- Drain the pasta and immediately add it to the sauce. Toss to coat the noodles in the sauce and evenly distribute the shrimp and vegetables. Garnish with parsley and parmesan. Enjoy hot.



BANG BANG SHRIMP

Ingredients:

For the shrimp:

- 450 gms Jumbo Shrimp peeled and deveined
- 1 cup buttermilk or substitute with 1 cup whole milk and 1 tablespoon lemon juice and let it sit for 5 minutes first
- ¾ cup cornstarch
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- ¾ teaspoon salt
- ¾ teaspoon garlic powder
- ½ teaspoon black pepper
- 1 green onion finely chopped for garnish

Bang Bang Sauce:

- ½ cup mayonnaise
- ¼ cup sweet chili sauce
- 2 tablespoons sriracha add more if you like it spicier

Instructions:

- In a medium bowl with peeled and deveined shrimp, add buttermilk. Let this sit for 10 minutes for shrimp to tenderize.
- In a small bowl, combine Bang Bang Sauce ingredients as listed. Set aside.
- In a shallow bowl or baking sheet, whisk together cornstarch, salt, garlic powder and black pepper.
- Coat shrimp in cornstarch mixture by dredging it on both sides.
- In a large skillet (10-inch) or heavy bottom pan, add oil. Heat oil on medium heat or at 350 degrees F.
- Once the oil is hot enough, fry shrimp in batches. Fry until you have golden brown shrimp, about 1.5 minutes per side. Do not overcrowd the hot oil or the shrimp won't be crispy. Also do not overcook the shrimp.
- Remove and set aside the cooked shrimp on a wire rack or paper towel lined plate to remove excess oil.
- Transfer crispy shrimp to a large bowl. Pour sauce over top. Gently toss to mix.
- Garnish with green onions. Enjoy!

Mediterranean Affair with French Flair

The Ritz-Carlton, Bahrain has recently opened La Terrace, an outdoor dining concept designed to make any day feel special. Nestled by the poolside amidst lush greenery, the chirping of birds, and the gentle rustling of leaves, this open-air restaurant is a haven for nature lovers. Imagine a place where you can close your eyes, feel a soft breeze on your skin, and let your palate savour flavours that transport you to the French Riviera or the sun-drenched shores of the Mediterranean. Here, worries simply melt away.

The menu is curated by Krug enthusiast and Chef de Cuisine Alexis Knecht from Alsace, France. A master of his craft, he brings a touch of elevated French cuisine and Mediterranean flair to Bahrain. Each dish is generously portioned yet light on the stomach, a combination that is both satisfying and praiseworthy. Expect culinary masterpieces such as a luxuriously creamy duck foie gras terrine served with the zest of confit Bahraini lemon and toasted butter brioche, succulent escargot in garlic and parsley butter, and the opulent Kaspian caviar service. Fresh oysters served with shallot vinegar and lemon allow the natural flavours to shine, offering a delicate taste of the sea to accompany a glass of your favorite beverage.

A warm welcome from server Miguel set the tone for the experience, followed by a refreshing beverage infused with cranberries and a kiss of rose. Its striking pink hue was instantly

inviting, and the drink's balanced flavours were impressively refreshing. A complimentary bread basket with butter accompanied the drink, enjoyed alongside the calming and cheerful French melodies softly playing in the background.

I began my meal with a Caesar salad with crispy chicken and a truffle croque monsieur. The salad featured crunchy romaine lettuce tossed in classic Caesar dressing, topped with perfectly breaded chicken scented with rosemary, croutons and grated parmesan—a delight in every bite. The truffle croque monsieur, combines comfort and luxury. It is unmissable and best when eaten warm. This dish promises a bite of comfort, a

smear of luxury, with the truffle bechamel. There is no skimping on that unique, warming truffle taste. The velvety smooth bechamel is slathered on white bread, with smoked turkey ham and a layer of sautéed mushrooms. The sandwich, blanketed with Emmental cheese, is toasted until the cheese melts perfectly.

No Mediterranean lunch is complete without fresh seafood. In a candid conversation with Executive Chef Joergen Sodemann, I learned that the hotel sources seafood locally or regionally whenever possible, ensuring freshness shines through in every dish. I opted for the seafood platter and the catch of the day—seabream. The seafood platter featured salmon, shrimp, and seabass, grilled simply with



salt and pepper to highlight their natural flavours, served in beautiful, locally made clay crockery. Dessert is equally indulgent. The profiteroles are irresistible and perfect for sharing: three

flawless choux buns filled with creamy vanilla ice cream, topped with toasted almond slivers, and drenched in hot chocolate sauce for a stunning hot-and-cold effect. Yum! The crème brûlée (serves two) and chocolate mousse are equally delightful, while a sundae bar with a variety of toppings offers a fun alternative.

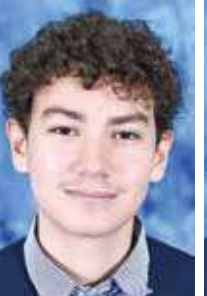

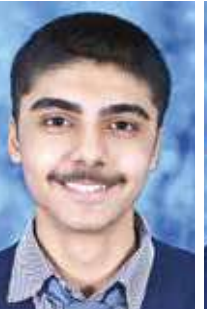

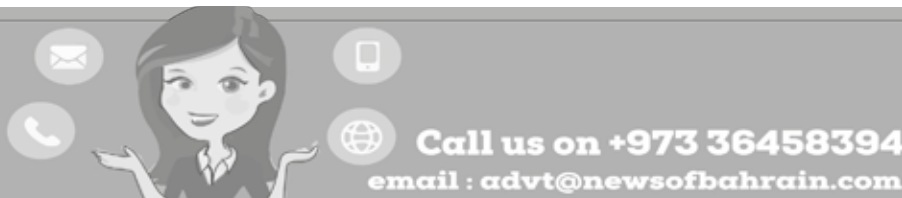

Borislav Nikolic Summons Challenger’s Mentality For First World Title Defense At BRAVE 100

When Borislav Nikolic steps inside the cage on Friday, November 7, in the main event of BRAVE 100, the weight of his first World Title defense won’t rest heavily on his shoulders – it will ignite the fire that got him here.

The reigning BRAVE CF Bantamweight World Champion returns to action inside the Khalifa Sports City in Isa Town, Bahrain, to put his coveted gold on the line against hometown hero Hamza Kooheji, the No. 2-ranked contender and one of the nation’s most beloved mixed martial artists.

Over four months ago, the 32-year-old authored a career-defining performance at BRAVE CF 96, where he submitted Nicholas Hwende with a spectacular ninja choke in front of his countrymen to seize the bantamweight crown.

But as he prepares for his first World Title defense, the Serbian standout is embracing an entirely different kind of battle – one waged not just against his opponent, but against comfort, pressure, and expectation.

“Being a champion isn’t about where you fight; it’s about who you are when you step inside that cage,” Nikolic said.

“A true champion doesn’t depend on the crowd, the country, or the comfort. You show up, wherever it is, and you prove yourself.”



For the CDS Novi Sad Serbia representative, stepping into enemy territory in Bahrain is not an obstacle – it’s an opportunity.

He already expects the roaring crowd to rally behind Kooheji, the national icon who will have the full backing of his people.

But rather than seeing that as intimidation, Nikolic views it as inspiration.

“I know the crowd will be behind Hamza, and I respect that. But I’m not bothered by it. In fact, I want that noise. I want that fire. I’ll turn that energy into my motivation and use it to fuel me every second of the fight,” he shared.

It’s a rare mindset for a reigning champion – to adopt the

hunger of a contender when sitting at the pinnacle of the division. Yet, that’s precisely how Nikolic intends to approach BRAVE 100.

“Even though I’m the champion, I see myself as the underdog,” he admitted. “That mindset keeps me sharp. I’m fighting like I have everything to gain, not something to protect. That’s what drives me.”

That hunger has defined Nikolic’s career – a journey built on resilience and a relentless will to prove himself.

His matchup with Kooheji symbolizes that drive once again – the visiting champion venturing into the heart of his opponent’s homeland, willing to silence a partisan crowd through performance and poise.

India’s Iyer ‘stable’ after lacerated spleen: Suryakumar

Indian batsman Shreyas Iyer is stable and has been in touch with the team from hospital after suffering a lacerated spleen, India’s T20 skipper Suryakumar Yadav said Tuesday.

Iyer, 30, sustained the injury as he pulled off a sensational catch to remove Alex Carey, a key moment in the third one-day international against Australia that India won by nine wickets in Sydney.

The Indian ODI vice-captain was forced off the field and hospitalised.

“I have been talking to him over the last two days, he has been replying,” Suryakumar told journalists ahead of the team’s first T20 international in Canberra on Wednesday. “It’s looking good,” Suryakumar said. “They will keep him under observation for a few days.”

He added that doctors and physiotherapists described the injury as “rare”.

“But rare things happen to rare talent. God is with him and he will recover soon and we will take him along with us.”

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) later said a repeat scan on Tuesday showed “significant improvement” with Iyer “on the road to recovery”.

“The BCCI Medical Team, in consultation with specialists in Sydney and India, will continue to monitor his progress,” said the BCCI.

Iyer is not part of India’s T20 squad, which will play five matches in Australia that will serve as a tune-up for the T20 World Cup in India and Sri Lanka in February-March.

China and Korea impress as badminton tournament opens in Bahrain

The Asian Youth Games badminton tournament kicked off yesterday at Isa Sports City's Hall D, launching with a full day of mixed doubles and singles action across four courts. China and Korea quickly set the pace, delivering confident early performances that signaled their intent to dominate the competition.

On Court 1, Korea's Jeong Da Hwan and Kim Han Bi produced one of the day's stand-out results by upsetting China's Qiu Haoyan and Li Yue Yu in straight games. Nearby, Hong Kong's Cheung Sai Shing and Chu Wing Chi edged Taiwan's Lee Yu-jui and Wen Shu-Yu in a close three-game mixed doubles match. Despite the early loss, China rebounded strongly elsewhere, with Xu Ji Ning and Luo Jing Yu advancing comfortably in Boys' Singles, while Yin Yi Qing powered through two decisive Girls' Singles victories on Court 4.

India and Indonesia soon joined the frontrunners. On

Court 2, India's Suryaksh Rawat impressed with back-to-back straight-game wins over Md Raisul Raj (BAN) and Huang Jyun-Kai (TPE) to reach the Boys' Singles quarterfinals. Indonesia also had a strong showing as Bjorn Jaison and Angel

Punera advanced in Mixed Doubles, and Maharishiel Gain registered key wins on Courts 3 and 4 to stay alive in the draw.

Hosts Bahrain faced tough early opposition but showed determination on home soil. Fatima Hasan fell 21-4, 21-2 to Thai-

land's Ketklieng Yataweemin, and Sayed Hasan was edged out 21-18, 21-14 by Cheung Sai Shing (HKG). Though both were eliminated, their efforts reflected the growing exposure of Bahrain's young players to high-level continental competition.

Uzbekistan's Sattorova sprints to gold in girls' road race

Uzbekistan's Gulhaya Sattorova powered to victory in a dramatic sprint finish to claim the gold medal in the girls' road race yesterday at the third Asian Youth Games.

Racing over the NBH Loop course, Sattorova led a tightly bunched peloton across the finish line in 1 hour, 59 minutes, and 26 seconds, averaging 33.4 km/h. It was a perfectly timed finish from the Uzbek rider, who held off a strong challenge from Kazakhstan's Valeriya Kuznetsova, while Hong Kong's Law Ching Kiu took bronze.

All three medallists crossed at the same time, reflecting how competitive the race

proved to be from start to finish. Uzbekistan's Sabrina Altinbekova narrowly missed the podium in fourth, also clocking 1:59:26, as the leading group sprinted shoulder to shoulder in the final stretch.

China's Li Mengping placed fifth, followed closely by Maritanya Krog of the Philippines and Yang Chiao-hui of Chinese Taipei. The top ten riders all finished within seconds of one another in what was one of the tightest finishes of the Games so far.

Further down the field, Bahrain's Dana Aldoseri, Zainab Karam, Jood Aloraibi, and Aseel Salman did not finish, as the humid morning conditions and fast pace took their toll on several competitors.



Golden Dreams Await AYG Boxing Stars

The third Asian Youth Games in Bahrain continued yesterday with fireworks in the ring, as young fighters from India, Uzbekistan, and Kazakhstan traded heavy blows in the semifinals at Exhibition World Bahrain. Every contest was hotly contested, setting up an exciting day of gold medal bouts.

In the girls' 46kg division, India's Khushi Chand and China's Luo Jinxiu both secured 5-0 victories over Mongolia's Altangadas Altanzul and Chinese Taipei's Chen Fang-yu to reach the finals. India's Chandrika

The 66kg girls' bracket saw India's Harnoor Kaur and Kazakhstan's Ayaulym Ospanova claim 5-0 victories, and in the +80kg semifinals, Anshika (IND) defeated China's Guo Jiaqing 5-0, with Kazakhstan's Elnura Kongyrat stopping Iran's Fatemeh Rastegarmehjenabi in round three.

The boys' contests were equally intense. In 50kg, India's Lanchenba Singh Moibungkhong dominated DPR Korea's An Phyeong Guk 5-0, while Kazakh-

stan's Zhumagali Nurmakhan overcame Japan's Kira Hasegawa 4-1.
