

HM King appoints Egypt Ambassador

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa yesterday issued Royal Decree (86) of 2022, appointing the Head of the Kingdom of Bahrain's Diplomatic Mission to the Arab Republic of Egypt, based on the nomination of the Foreign Minister, and following the approval of the Cabinet.

The decree stipulates the appointment of Fawzia Abdulla Zainal as Head of Bahrain's Diplomatic Mission to Egypt, with the title of Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary. His Majesty issued Royal Decree (87) of 2022, appointing an Ambassador at the Foreign Ministry, based on the proposal of the Foreign Min-

The decree stipulates the appointment of Shaikh Khalifa bin Mohammed bin Atiyatullah Al Khalifa as Ambassador at the Foreign Ministry.

HM the King also issued Royal Decree (85) of 2022, appointing an Ambassador at the Foreign Ministry, based on the proposal of the Foreign Minister,

and following the approval of the Cabinet.

Under the decree, Fawzia Abdulla Zainal was appointed as an Ambassador at the Foreign Ministry.

The Foreign Minister shall implement the provisions of the decrees, which come into force immediately, and will be published in the Official Gazette.
