Mandatory health cover for residents to be tendered in **August**

tender to select an in-Asurance firm to run Bahrain's mandatory health package for residents, known as the Hakeem Programme, will open on 4 Au-

The Tender Board will oversee the process, acting on behalf of the Supreme Council of Health (SCH).

The contract will run for five years and cover the insurance of medical services provided under the scheme. The chosen company will be responsible for managing payments and benefits for non-citizen residents.

Project

According to an earlier statement by the chairman of the Supreme Council of Health, the project is due to begin before the end of 2025.

The Hakeem Programme aims to provide full medical cover for residents through general practice, hospital care and emergency treatment. It is also designed to bring in private firms to offer competing services.
