Katie Ledecky won the 22nd world title of her legendary career yesterday to close in on Michael Phelps's record as Olympic champions David Popovici and Kaylee McKeown also struck gold.

American great Ledecky and Ledecky cruised to a dominant 1,500m freestyle gold, touching the wall in 15min 26.44sec, having threatened her own world record of 15:20.48.

The masterful win in Singapore moved Ledecky four short of Phelps's career tally of 26 world gold medals.

"Growing up it was very inspiring to watch world championships, Olympic Games that Michael was in, trying to learn from the very best," said Ledecky, 28.

"I was always a student of the sport."

Ledecky's dominant win gave her the sixth
