

At a workshop convened to shape the strategy, His Excellency Dr. Shaikh Abdulla bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications, said the initiative will reinforce Bahrain's role as a regional and international hub, while building on more than 75 years of national aviation legacy and integrated infrastructure.

By defining four distinct pathways, the plan seeks to strengthen the aviation system, boost resilience, and contribute to sustainable economic growth. Passenger aviation, business aviation, cargo operations, and MRO services together represent a comprehensive diversification of the sector.

The workshop was attended by H.E. Abdulla bin Adel Fakhro, Minister of Industry and Commerce, and H.E. Sameer Abdulla Nass, Chairman of the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry, highlighting economy-wide alignment behind the s trategy.

The Transportation Minister underlined that the strategy is aligned with Bahrain's Economic Vision 2030, focusing on sustainable development, innovation, and competitiveness.




