

HM King decree for SIO reform

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa issued Decree (61) of 2025 restructuring the Social Insurance Organisation (SIO), based on a proposal of the Minister of Finance and National Economy and following the approval of the Cabinet.

The decree defines SIO's governance, outlines mandates for actuarial, legal, communications, insurance, operations and pensioners' affairs, repealing the Decree (79) of 2019.

The Minister of Finance and National Economy shall implement the decree, which takes effect from the date of issuance and will be published in the Official Gazette.

The follow-through to His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa's visit to Rome took shape yesterday in a sweeping joint statement between the Governments of Bahrain and Italy, setting out a structured agenda that extends far beyond the signing table.

The document places the newly established Strategic Investments and Collaboration Partnership (SIP) at the core of a broader 1 billion cooperation drive aimed at energy transition, industrial innovation, and infrastructure development.

Deep Cooperation

The statement underscores the two nations' plan to reinforce their defence partnership,

expand industrial collaboration, and intensify coordination in energy security and ecological transition. Both sides pledged cooperation on research, water management, and waste-to-energy solutions while inviting public and private sector participation.

Food security also emerged as a major pillar, with Italy and Bahrain agreeing to work together to ensure sustainable supply chains and promote national production capacity.

Future collaboration will in-

clude construction, transport, tourism, and smart cities - giving Italian enterprises opportunities to contribute to Bahrain's expanding infrastructure and housing initiatives.

The statement further builds on earlier customs cooperation, confirming the creation of a Technical Committee to coordinate on best practices, capacity-building, and study visits. The new space-sector memorandum between the Bahrain Space Agency and the Italian Space Agency also opens avenues for

joint research and training.

Shared Stance on Global Issues

Both governments reaffirmed their alignment on regional stability and multilateralism, commending Bahrain's upcoming non-permanent seat on the UN Security Council for 2026-27. They jointly called for a ceasefire in Gaza, the release of hostages, and adherence to the two-State solution, while maintaining support for peace in Syria and Ukraine.

The two sides also highlighted

the importance of stronger EU-GCC cooperation ahead of Bahrain's Presidency of the Council and next year's EU-GCC Summit in Riyadh.

Turning Commitments into Outcomes

Officials said the agreements now form a long-term operational framework linking investment, innovation, and security - turning what began as a high-profile signing in Rome into a roadmap for sustained Bahrain-Italy collaboration.

The Embassy of Malaysia in Manama recently hosted a cultural event titled “Breakfast Culture in Malaysia: Dining Experience in a Multi-Ethnic Society”, celebrating Malaysia’s rich culinary and artistic heritage.

Malaysia’s traditional breakfast practices were officially inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity at the 19th Session of the Intergovernmental Committee for the Safeguarding of Intangible Cultural Heritage held in Paraguay in December 2024.

This marks Malaysia’s first food-related entry on UNESCO’s list. Other Malaysian UNES-

CO-recognized intangible cultural heritage includes Mak Yong, Silat, Dondang Sayang, Songket, Mek Mulung, Ong Chun/WangKang (Malaysia & China), Pantun (Malaysia & Indonesia), and the Kebaya — making a total of nine items.

Comfort foods

The Breakfast Culture in Malaysia celebrates comfort foods enjoyed across Malaysia’s multi-ethnic society.

Signature dishes such as nasi lemak, roti canai, and teh tarik are national favorites, beloved by Malaysians of all backgrounds and widely appreciated by tourists, often praised in vlogs as “the best Malaysian breakfast—hands down!” These dishes reflect Malaysia’s diverse flavors and culinary heritage.

19 illegal workers detained and 127 deported in LMRA inspection drive

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) reported that 19 violating and irregular workers were detained, while 127 others were deported, following 1,109 inspection campaigns and visits conducted between 21 and 27 September 2025.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

It pointed out that 1,083 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 26

joint inspection campaigns, 10 campaigns in the Capital Governorate, 4 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 5 campaigns in the Northern Governorate and 7 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

Participants

Government entities that participated in the campaigns are the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate’s respective Police Directorate, the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, and the Social Insurance Organization.

The Authority affirmed the continuation of joint coordination with government agencies to intensify inspection campaigns in all governorates of the Kingdom, and to address any violations or practices that negatively affect the stability and competitiveness of the labour market or harm economic and social security of the Kingdom.

Court upholds life term in Tubli murder-and-arson

Life sentence upheld yesterday for a man who killed with a hammer and set fire to workers’ lodgings in Tubli; appeal judges also ordered the weapon seized and his deportation after he serves his term.

The High Criminal Court of Appeal kept the life term in place for a premeditated murder and arson case from Tubli and confirmed the orders on the hammer and deportation.

The case traces back to 9 April 2025, when the Public Prosecution received a report of a fire at workers’ accommodation in Tubli.

A man of Asian nationality was found dead inside.

Prosecutors went to the scene with a forensic pathol-

The defendant confessed to striking the victim with a hammer, setting the scene on fire, later reenacting the crime with prosecutors.

ogist and specialists from the Criminal Information Directorate.

Examination of the flat and the body revealed severe head wounds.

The Prosecution ordered samples taken from the site, tests run, and an autopsy to determine cause of death, while directing enquiries to find the attacker.

Unlicensed buildings face jail and hefty fines

Jail terms and fines from BD500 to BD50,000 headline a draft Building Regulation Law before Parliament, empowering the authority to halt unlawful works and, where breaches cannot be fixed, order demolition.

The bill, annexed to Decree No. 53 of 2025, sets criminal penalties of BD1,000 to BD20,000 and possible imprisonment for submitting false information to obtain a licence, obstructing inspectors, withholding required records, or building without a licence or in breach of its terms.

Where violations are proven, the authority may sus-

pend works, add conditions to a licence, compel corrective measures, demolish parts that cannot be remedied, and levy administrative fines from BD500 to BD50,000.

Clearances

Licensing is routed through a single competent authority that gathers clearances from other bodies and decides within fixed time limits. Minor and temporary works to be exempt will be set in the implementing regulation.

Private operators may receive applications and check compliance, while approved engineering offices can verify drawings or inspect sites. Refusals may be challenged first by complaint and then before the competent court.

Trump Organization plans second Saudi development in Jeddah

The Trump Organization has signed a deal for a “mixed-use community” in the Saudi coastal city of Jeddah, its development partner Dar Global said Monday, valuing the project at \$1 billion. Trump Plaza, which will have residences and office spaces, with a “Central Park-inspired green spine”, follows the announcement last year of Trump Tower Jeddah, also being built by Dar Global. The project comes after US President Donald Trump made a Gulf tour in May and signed a “strategic economic partnership” with Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman that the White House said would see \$600 billion of Saudi investments in the United States. It is the latest of several property deals across the oil-rich



Gulf by the Trump Organization, which is managed by Trump’s sons, though the president has held onto his shares in the company.

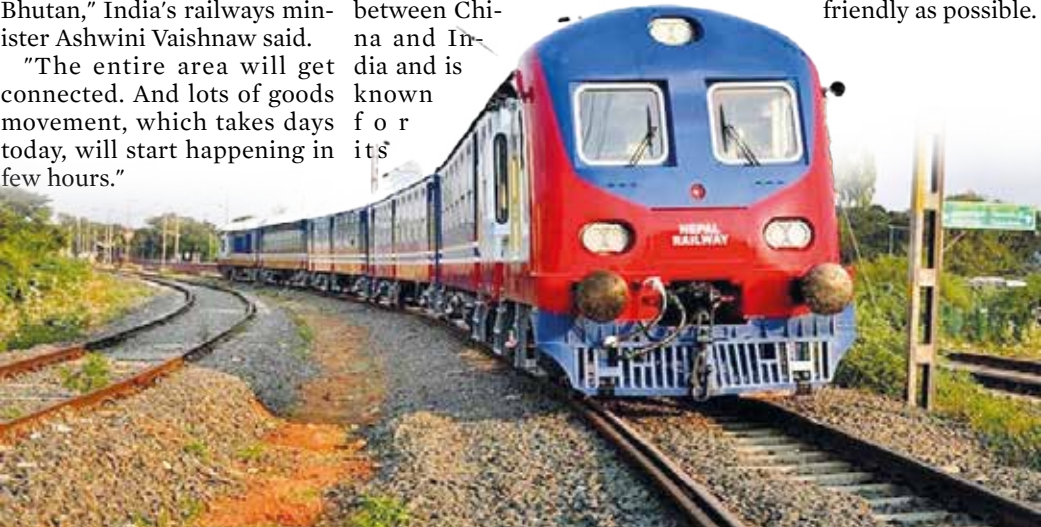
“This project embodies our vision of excellence by blending world-class hospitality, modern living, and dynamic business environments,” Eric Trump said in a statement. Dar Global is also developing a Trump International Hotel and luxury villas in the capital of neighbouring Oman, with completion expected in 2028, according to the firm’s website. Trump has cultivated close ties with Riyadh, choosing the Gulf kingdom for his first foreign trip during his first term as president. He has also defended Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman despite US intelligence agencies concluding he ordered the brutal killing of US-based Saudi critic Jamal Khashoggi in 2018. His son-in-law Jared Kushner later started a private equity firm that received a reported \$2 billion from a fund controlled by Prince Mohammed.

India to build first cross-border railway with Bhutan

India and Bhutan will build the first cross-border railway lines connecting both countries, New Delhi announced Monday, with \$454-million project to be completed in four years. Indian foreign secretary Vikram Misri said his country, which is Bhutan’s main trading partner, “has played a vital role” in the modernisation of the Himalayan kingdom’s infrastructure and economy. The rail project will be of “huge benefit to the people of Bhutan,” India’s railways minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said. “The entire area will get connected. And lots of goods movement, which takes days today, will start happening in few hours.”

An initial 69-kilometre (43-mile) railway, estimated to cost 34.56 billion rupees (\$390 million), will connect India’s northeastern city of Kokrajhar to Bhutan’s Gelephu, a town of 10,000 people near the Indian border. A second 20-kilometre railway line, expected to cost 5.77 billion rupees, will link Bhutan’s northwestern industrial centre of Samtse to Banarhat in eastern India. Tiny and landlocked, with a population of less than 800,000, Bhutan is wedged between China and India and is known for its policy of prioritising “Gross National Happiness” over growth. But it hopes to develop Gelephu as an economic zone to attract foreign investment and tourists, with the new railway key to its development. “It is envisaged as an economic hub connecting Bhutan with South Asia and Southeast Asia,” India’s foreign minister Vikram Misri said. India’s railways minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said that the new trainlines will be electric and that the project is designed to be as environmentally friendly as possible.



Before entering politics, Trump’s best-known real estate project was Trump Tower in New York City, completed in 1983. The 58-storey skyscraper has a six-storey atrium with a waterfall and luxury shops, and it served as both his corporate headquarters and a symbol of his brand’s rise in the 1980s.

Trump renews tariff threat on movies made abroad

Washington, United States

US President Donald Trump yesterday renewed his threat of imposing steep tariffs on films made outside the United States, claiming his country's industry has been "stolen" by others.

Trump's remarks come shortly after he threatened a slew of new tariffs to be imposed this week on branded pharmaceutical products, furniture, as well as heavy trucks respectively.

On Monday, Trump returned his focus to the film industry, charging in a Truth Social post that other countries have taken business from the United States, "just like stealing 'candy from a baby.'"

He criticized California Governor Gavin Newsom as "weak and incompetent," adding that the state has been heavily impacted.

"In order to solve this long time, never ending problem, I will be imposing a 100% Tariff on any and all movies that are made outside of the United States," Trump wrote.

He did not provide further details on his plans, or a timeline for when these tariffs might be enacted.

Trump's latest post echoes a threat he made in May, when he said the US movie industry was "dying a very fast death."

At the time, he said he was authorizing the Department of Commerce and US Trade Representative to start the process of instituting a 100-percent tariff.

AI company Whitebridge hit with complaint over selling personal data

A privacy campaign group yesterday filed a complaint with Lithuanian authorities against Whitebridge AI, accusing it of illegally collecting and selling personal data via "reputation reports" generated by artificial intelligence.

Prominent Vienna-based organisation, Noyb -- whose name stands for "none of your business" -- said the company marketed its services as an AI tool that "will find everything about you online", offering "reputation reports" to "anyone willing to pay".

These reports illegally "compile large amounts of scraped personal information about unsuspecting people", including "AI-generated" data that is "not factual", Noyb said.

The AI-generated information includes "alleged personality

traits", background checks and data about "political or religious content".

"It seems the business model is largely based on scared users that want to review their own data that was previously unlawfully compiled," Noyb said in a statement.

"The amount of personal data that Whitebridge AI processes is downright spooky," said Noyb lawyer Aitana Pallas.

"This is made even worse by the fact that Whitebridge AI completely ignores data subjects when they try to exercise their rights.

Noyb said two complainants had requested access to the data about themselves, which contained "false warnings" about "sexual nudity" and "dangerous political content".

Their requests -- including for rectification of "false data

-- were either ignored or rebuffed by the Lithuania-based company.

The complaint cites several violations of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) relating to the processing of their data and their right of access and rectification.

Every European citizen has the right to access their personal data free of charge.

The NGO has asked the Lithuanian data protection authority to compel Whitebridge to comply with the access requests, to stop the illegal processing of data and to impose a fine.

Noyb has launched several legal cases against US technology giants such as Meta and Google, often prompting action from regulatory authorities over violations of the GDPR.



WhiteBridge is building tools to let people control and monetise their own online data and reputation, rather than having big tech platforms sell it without consent. Their model is based on giving users transparency and potentially earning opportunities from their digital footprint, instead of being passive data sources.

Switzerland and US agree on no currency manipulation

Zurich, Switzerland

Switzerland and the United States said yesterday they had agreed that monetary policies should not target exchange rates to gain a competitive advantage.

The joint statement followed the US Treasury adding Switzerland to a watch list in June for countries that manipulate their currencies.

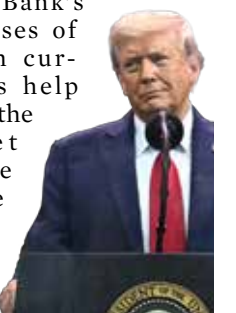
Swiss authorities affirmed in the statement that "monetary policy will remain oriented towards maintaining appropriate monetary conditions to safeguard price stability and will not target exchange rates for competitive purposes".

The United States made a similar engagement.

Many investors consider the Swiss franc a "safe haven" asset and will buy the currency when they sell off risky assets.

This can cause the value of the franc to rise, creating problems for the Swiss economy as its exports become less competitive while the price of imports falls, prompting the country's central bank to intervene on the currency markets.

The Swiss National Bank's purchases of foreign currencies help reduce the market value of the franc.

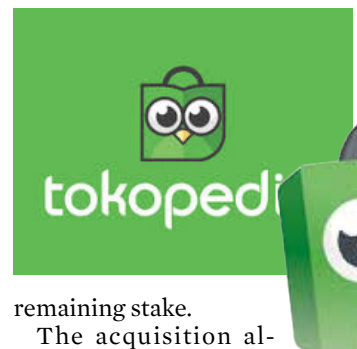


Indonesia fines TikTok over late Tokopedia acquisition notice

Indonesia's antitrust agency has fined TikTok 15 billion rupiah (\$900,000) for failing to notify regulators in time about its acquisition of e-commerce platform Tokopedia, an official said on Monday.

TikTok, owned by China's ByteDance, completed an \$840 million deal in January 2024 to acquire 75.01 percent of Tokopedia from PT GoTo Gojek Tokopedia, which retained the



remaining stake.

The acquisition allowed TikTok to relaunch its online shopping service in Indonesia, after the

government banned social media-based sales to protect small businesses.

Deswin Nur, spokesperson for the Indonesia competition commission (KPPU), said TikTok Nusantara (SG) Pte -- the entity established for the transaction -- failed to notify the agency within the required timeframe.

"Although KPPU previously conditionally approved this acquisition and assessed that it has no negative impact on business competition, administrative negligence was still categorised as a violation," Deswin said.

"Notification must still be submitted in a timely manner by the acquiring business entity."

A TikTok spokesperson told AFP the company respected KPPU's ruling and remained committed to upholding fair business competition principle

Electronic Arts to be bought by Saudi-led consortium for \$55 bn

Video game giant Electronic Arts announced Monday it would be acquired by a consortium led by Saudi Arabia's Public Investment Fund for \$55 billion, in what EA said would be the largest all-cash private equity buyout in history.

The consortium also includes US investment firms Silver Lake and Affinity Partners, the Miami-based firm founded by Jared Kushner, former White House advisor and son-in-law of President Donald Trump.

"This moment is a powerful recognition of their remarkable work," EA Chairman and CEO Andrew Wilson said of the company's employees in a statement, adding the deal would help "unlock new opportunities on a global stage."

EA, known for popular franchises including FIFA soccer games, Madden NFL, The Sims

and Battlefield, reported revenue of \$7.5 billion in its most recent fiscal year.

The acquisition is expected to close in early 2027 and requires approval from EA shareholders and regulatory authorities.

Saudi Arabia's PIF, which already holds a 9.9 percent stake in EA, will roll over its existing investment as part of the transaction.

The deal will be financed through approximately \$36 billion in equity from the consortium members and \$20 billion in debt committed by JPMorgan Chase.

Upon completion, EA will be delisted from the Nasdaq stock exchange and remain headquartered in Redwood City, California, under Wilson's continued leadership.

The deal marks PIF's latest major investment in the gaming sector as Saudi Arabia seeks to diversify its economy beyond oil revenues.

◆ **Switzerland said Monday**

it would return nearly \$29 million to Equatorial Guinea after auctioning luxury cars seized from the son of the African nation's longtime ruler in a court case. The Swiss foreign ministry announced the signing of the deal that detailed "the return of 22.8 million Swiss francs" (\$28.6 million) to Equatorial Guinea in a press release. The funds aim to "improve the quality of and access to primary healthcare services for vulnerable peoples" in four provinces, the statement said, adding that there would be "a specific governance and monitoring system". The assets were seized in a criminal procedure initiated by the Geneva public prosecutor in October 2016 against Equatorial Guinea's Vice President Teodoro Nguema Obiang Mangue, known as Teodorin -- the president's son. He and two others were charged with money laundering and mismanagement of public funds. As part of the probe, the Geneva courts seized 25 luxury vehicles belonging to the vice president including Ferraris, Lamborghinis, Bentleys, a Maserati and a McLaren.

◆ **A 47-year-old** Chinese woman on Monday told a UK court that she played a leading role in a multibillion pound fraudulent Bitcoin scheme. Chinese businesswoman Zhimin Qian, alias Yadi Zhang, pleaded guilty at London's Southwark Crown Court following what is believed to be the single largest cryptocurrency seizure in the world, now worth about £5.5 billion. She admitted acquiring and possessing criminal property, namely cryptocurrency. "Between 2014-2017, Zhang orchestrated a large-scale fraud in China through defrauding over 128,000 victims and went on to store the illegally obtained funds in Bitcoin assets," London's Met Police said in a statement. "She then fled China using false documents and entered the UK, where in September 2018 she attempted to launder the proceeds via purchasing property," it added.

◆ **A North Korean** minister said yesterday in a rare address to the UN that Pyongyang would never surrender its nuclear weapons but left open the door to diplomacy. Vice Minister for Foreign Affairs Kim Son Gyong made the trip to New York to attend the United Nation's annual high-level week -- a role previously performed at a lower level by the country's ambassador. "(The) imposition of 'Denuclearization' on the DPRK is tantamount to demanding it to surrender sovereignty and right to existence and violate the Constitution," said Gyong. "We will never give up nuclear which is our state law, national policy and sovereign power as well as the right to existence. Under any circumstances, we will never walk away from this position."

**Taliban shut down communications
across Afghanistan**

Taliban authorities yesterday imposed a nationwide shutdown of communications, weeks after they began severing fibre optic connections to prevent "vice".

Connectivity was operating at less than one percent of its normal levels, according to internet watchdog Netblocks, who called it a "comprehensive, or total blackout".

In the minutes before it happened, a government official told AFP the shutdown would last "until further notice".

"It is going to be cut, it will happen gradually tonight, there are eight to nine thousand telecommunications pillars it will shut down," he told AFP on condition of anonymity.

"There isn't any other way or system to communicate... the banking sector, customs, everything across the country will be affected."

AFP lost all contact with its bureau in the capital Kabul at around 5:45 pm (1315 GMT).

Afghanistan's Taliban authorities began the crackdown on access earlier this month, effectively shutting down high-speed internet in several regions.

Telephone services are often routed over the internet, sharing the same fibre lines, especially in countries with limited telecoms infrastructure.

"A nation-wide telecoms

blackout is now in effect," said Netblocks, a watchdog organisation that monitors cybersecurity and internet governance, adding it "appears consistent with the intentional disconnection of service".

"It may turn out that disconnecting internet access while keeping phone service available will take some trial and error."

Over the past weeks, internet connections have been extremely slow or intermittent.

On September 16, Balkh provincial spokesman Attaullah Zaid said fibre optic internet was completely banned in northern province on the Taliban leader's orders.

"This measure was taken to prevent vice, and alternative options will be put in place across the country to meet connectivity needs," he wrote on social media.

In 2024, Kabul had touted the 9,350-kilometre fibre optic network -- largely built by former US-backed governments -- as a "priority" to bring the country closer to the rest of the world and lift it out of poverty.

Since regaining power, the Taliban have instituted numerous restrictions in accordance with their interpretation of Islamic law.

It is the first time since the Taliban government won their insurgency in 2021 that communications have been shut down in the country.



Donald Trump Meets Israeli Pm Benjamin Netanyahu

Trump announces Gaza peace plan, with Netanyahu backing

Washington | USA

President Donald Trump unveiled a wide-ranging Gaza peace plan Monday and won cautious backing from Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who warned he was still ready to "finish the job" against Hamas.

However, Hamas had yet to comment and Netanyahu's warning reflected the complexities lying ahead. "If Hamas rejects your plan, Mr President, or if they supposedly accept it and then then basically do everything to counter it, then Israel will finish the job by itself," Netanyahu said at a joint press conference in the White House.

The 20-point plan, which Trump has also circulated to Arab leaders, calls for a ceasefire, release of hostages by Hamas, disarmament of Hamas and gradual Israeli withdrawal from Gaza. Other key points include deployment of a "temporary international stabilization force" and creation of a transitional authority headed by Trump himself and featuring other foreign leaders.

The deal would demand Hamas militants fully disarm and be excluded from future roles in the government. However, those who agreed to "peaceful co-existence" would be given amnesty. Following Israeli withdrawal, the borders would be opened to aid and investment.

In a crucial change from Trump's earlier apparent goals, Palestinians will not be forced to leave Gaza and instead, the document said, "we will encourage people to stay and offer them the opportunity to build a better

Netanyahu apologizes to Qatar PM for strike in Trump- led call

Washington, United States

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu yesterday apologized to Qatar's prime minister for strikes against Hamas in the Gulf country in a telephone call placed from the White House, a diplomat

said.

The diplomat, speaking to AFP on condition of anonymity, said Netanyahu voiced regret for the violation of Qatari sovereignty and the death of a Qatari security guard in the September strikes.

Gaza." Netanyahu made clear he was in favor, saying it "achieves our war aims," while Trump said he was hopeful that Hamas would also give its backing. Approval from all sides was "beyond very close," Trump said.

However, many important details remained to be clarified. Netanyahu stressed to reporters that Israeli forces would retain responsibility for Gaza security "for the foreseeable future." He also cast doubt on whether the Palestinian Authority, which runs the West Bank territory, would be allowed a role in Gaza's governance.

"Gaza will have a peaceful,

civilian administration that is run neither by Hamas nor by the Palestinian Authority," said Netanyahu.

- Trump frustration with Netanyahu

The US president had met key Arab leaders at the United Nations last week and said Sunday on social media that "ALL ARE ON BOARD FOR SOMETHING SPECIAL, FIRST TIME EVER." Netanyahu had recently given little reason for optimism, vowing in a defiant UN speech Friday to "finish the job" against Hamas and rejecting Palestinian statehood -- recently recognized by several

Western nations. But normally a staunch ally of Netanyahu, the US president has shown increasing signs of frustration ahead of the Israeli premier's fourth White House visit since Trump's return to power.

Trump was infuriated by Israel's recent strike on Hamas members in key US ally Qatar. And he warned Netanyahu last week against annexing the Israeli-occupied West Bank, as some of Netanyahu's cabinet members have urged, a move that would seriously complicate the route to Palestinian statehood. Netanyahu's coalition government is propped up by the far-right ministers who oppose a peace deal.

Voices from Gaza

Meanwhile, Israeli strikes continued across the Gaza Strip, killing at least four people in Khan Yunis, according to the Hamas-run territory's civil defense agency. Families of Israeli hostages held in Gaza urged Trump to uphold his Gaza proposal.

And in Gaza, people expressed a mix of hope, exhaustion and distrust ahead of the White House meeting. "I don't expect anything from Trump, because Trump supports Netanyahu in destroying the Gaza Strip," said Mohammed Abu Rabee, 34.

The Gaza war was triggered by Hamas's October 7, 2023 attack that killed 1,219 people, mostly civilians, according to an AFP tally from Israeli official figures. Israel's offensive has killed 66,055 Palestinians, also mostly civilians, according to health ministry figures in the Hamas-run territory that the United Nations considers reliable.

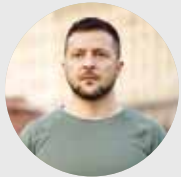

Madagascar protests reignite, UN says at least 22 dead

Two days of protests last week erupted in clashes with police

● Experienced frequent popular uprisings since gaining independence in 1960

● Some demonstrators held signs reading "We want to live, not survive"

Thousands of demonstrators poured into the streets across Madagascar on Monday, as police fired tear gas to disperse the latest bout of unrest in the poor country that the UN said had left at least 22 people dead in less than a week.

Two days of protests last week erupted in clashes with police as mostly young demonstrators, called to action on social media through a movement called "Gen Z", demonstrated against persistent water and power cuts across the nation.

The Indian Ocean island nation, among the world's poorest, has experienced frequent popular uprisings since gaining independence in 1960, including mass protests in 2009 that forced former president Marc Ravalomanana from power.

UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Volker Turk condemned Madagascar's "violent response" to the protests which his office said had left more than

a hundred injured" in the latest bout of unrest.

President Andry Rajoelina was due to speak around 1700 GMT, after protests hit several cities across Madagascar including the capital, where security forces dispersed crowds with tear gas, AFP journalists saw.

Growing crowds marched through the capital Antananarivo, many dressed in black and chanting calls for Rajoelina to resign.

He first came to power following a coup sparked by the 2009 uprising.

Some demonstrators held

signs reading "We want to live, not survive," a central slogan of the movement.

Police detained an opposition lawmaker during the march in Antananarivo, footage shared on social media showed, prompting calls from his colleagues for his release.

At least one other protester was also arrested, prompting the UN's Turk to urge the authorities to "ensure respect for freedom of expression and peaceful assembly".

A statement released by the protest movement late Sunday called for the government and

Antananarivo's prefect to resign. They have also targeted figures close to the president including Prime Minister Christian Ntsay and businessman Mamy Ravatomanga.

The movement has adopted as its rallying symbol a pirate flag from the Japanese anime series "One Piece", a logo also used recently by youth-led, anti-regime protests in Indonesia and Nepal.

'Anonymous individuals'

Thursday's protests in the capital were followed by widespread looting throughout the night, which encountered no

police response.

The Gen Z movement said in its Sunday statement that "groups of anonymous individuals were paid to loot numerous establishments in order to tarnish the movement and the ongoing struggle".

The movement was named after Generation Z, a nickname attributed to people born between the late 1990s and early 2010s.

Protests were also widespread in Antsiranana at the northern tip of Madagascar.

The demonstrations were the largest since 2023 when protests erupted ahead of the presidential elections, which were boycotted by opposition parties



Despite having natural resources, Madagascar remains one of the poorest countries in the world and is among the most corrupt, ranked 140 out of 180 countries in Transparency International's Corruption Perceptions Index. Nearly 75 percent of the population lived below the poverty line in 2022, according to the World Bank.

Harry Potter author J.K. Rowling on Monday condemned Emma Watson as "ignorant" over her transgender rights views, in a stinging riposte to the former child star.

In a long post on X, the writer expressed her irritation that Watson, 35, and Daniel Radcliffe, 36 -- who starred in the film adaptations of Rowling's best-selling books -- "continue to assume the role of de facto spokespeople for the world I created".

Radcliffe, who played boy wizard Potter, and Watson, who played his friend Hermione Granger, have both taken issue with Rowling's stance on gender issues.

But Rowling, who has not previously been so outspoken about Watson, suggested that the star's privilege meant she was unable to properly grasp the issues at stake.

"I wasn't a multimillionaire at fourteen. I lived in poverty while writing the book that made Emma famous," she said.

"I therefore understand from my own life experience what



the trashing of women's rights in which Emma has so enthusiastically participated means to women and girls without her privileges."

Rowling has long been at the forefront of the debate about gender identity and has previously denounced trans activism, leading to accusations of transphobia.

She has defended herself saying her concern was the impact it has on women's rights and single-sex spaces for women.

'Pour petrol on flames'

Rowling, 60, also revealed her annoyance at receiving a one-line note from Watson in 2022.

Following an awards ceremony at which Watson publicly made a dig at Rowling she sent her a message saying "I'm so sorry for what you're going through".

"This was back when the death, rape and torture threats against me were at their peak, at a time when my personal security measures had to be tightened considerably and I

was constantly worried for my family's safety," the author said.

"Emma had just publicly poured more petrol on the flames, yet thought a one line expression of concern from her would reassure me of her fundamental sympathy and kindness," she said.

Rowling also hinted she had only decided to be "this honest" about the "Beauty and the Beast" and "Little Women" actress now because of comments last week in which Watson announced that she still loved and treasured the author.

This was "a change of tack I suspect she's adopted because she's noticed full-throated condemnation of me is no longer quite as fashionable as it was," Rowling said.

"Adults can't expect to cosy up to an activist movement that regularly calls for a friend's assassination, then assert their right to the former friend's love.

"Emma is rightly free to disagree with me and indeed to discuss her feelings about me in public -- but I have the same right, and I've finally decided to exercise it," she said.

Jaguar Land Rover on Monday said it will partially restart production in the coming days after a damaging cyberattack halted operations at its UK factories.

The Indian-owned automaker said on September 2 that it had been targeted by hackers, severely disrupting sales and production and forcing the company to seek emergency funding.

"As the controlled, phased restart of our operations continues, we are taking further steps towards our recovery," JLR said in a statement.

"Some sections of our manufacturing operations will resume in the coming days," it added.

The UK government at the weekend agreed to a loan guarantee worth £1.5 billion (\$2 billion) to help shore up the firm's

cash reserves and supply chain.

A government credit agency will guarantee a commercial bank loan, to be repaid over five years by JLR.

IT systems at the company owned by India's Tata Motors partly came back online last week as part of a phased restart.

The partial systems restart helped to clear a backlog of payments to its suppliers, after unions warned that some were

at risk of collapse owing to the disruption.

As part of its investigation, JLR believes that "some data" was accessed by the hackers, but has provided no further details.

'Significant impact'

JLR operates the largest supply chain in the UK automotive sector, employing around 120,000 people.

It employs 34,000 people di-

rectly in its UK operations, with factories in England's West Midlands and northwest.

The government recently warned of "significant impact" from the cyberattack following an emergency meeting with UK car trade body SMMT.

According to the BBC, JLR is losing at least £50 million per week in lost production.

Cyber gangs have increasingly targeted UK luxury brands

and retailers, including Britain's Marks and Spencer, Harrods and the Co-op food chain.

British police in July arrested four people suspected of involvement in attacks against the three retailers, which saw hackers demand ransom payments after breaking into their IT systems.

Such cyberattacks have cost companies hundreds of millions of pounds in lost sales.

YOU KNOW WHAT

Jaguar Land Rover is the largest car manufacturer in the United Kingdom, and its vehicles are exported to over 120 countries worldwide. Despite being deeply associated with British heritage and design, JLR has been owned by India's Tata Motors since 2008—a move that surprised many at the time, but under Tata's ownership, JLR revived iconic models and expanded globally, making it a profitable luxury carmaker again.

Marks and Spencer, whose online services were crippled for weeks, took a £300-million hit to annual operating profit.

While the Co-op on Thursday said the incident impacted its first-half operating profit by £80 million and revenue by £206 million.

The cyberattack is the latest setback for JLR, which reported a sharp reduction in sales after it halted exports of its cars to the United States in April in response to President Donald Trump's tariffs.

A trade agreement between London and Washington reduced the tariff on UK car exports to 10 percent from 27.5 percent, on a limit of 100,000 vehicles annually.

But the luxury car and SUV maker said it still planned to cut up to 500 UK management jobs.

India sets sights on 200 million vehicles by 2047

India plans to double automobile production in the next five years and is targeting output of 200 million vehicles by 2047 under a new National Automotive Mission Plan (AMP), which is likely to be unveiled by the end of this fiscal year.

The blueprint, aligned with the government's Viksit Bharat goals, will prioritise localisation of sustainable mobility solutions such as hydrogen, electric, CNG, and biogas vehicles, while not restricting conventional petrol and diesel

models.

According to officials, production is projected to reach 50 million vehicles in 2030, before scaling up to 200 million units by 2047. Export volumes are also expected to rise from around 30% of domestic passenger vehicle output in 2030 to 40% by 2047.

"These numbers are part of initial discussions and may evolve after consultations with economists and think tanks like Niti Aayog," a senior industry executive said. The final plan is expected to be ready before the close of the current fiscal.

Nissan to showcase new midsize SUV concept on October 7

Nissan is gearing up to unveil its upcoming C-SUV concept on October 7, with the design vision to be presented by Alfonso Albaisa, Senior Vice President of Global Design, and Ken Lee, Senior Design Director.

The new midsize SUV will share its platform with the next-generation Renault Duster and is set to compete with established players such as the Hyundai Creta, Kia Seltos, and

Skoda Kushaq.

Test mules spotted in India hint at a bold design, featuring a flat front fascia with a rectangular grille, wraparound LED headlamps, rectangular taillights, roof spoiler, roof rails, and shark fin antenna.

Under the hood, the SUV is expected to house a 1.3-litre turbo-petrol engine producing 152 BHP and 250 Nm, paired with a 7-speed dual-clutch automatic transmission.

The new Nissan midsize SUV is expected to make its market debut by mid-2026.

Chery files design patent for Tiggo 8 SUV in India

China's Chery Automobile has filed a design patent for its Tiggo 8 SUV in India, signalling a possible entry into the competitive midsize-to-large SUV segment.

The 4.7-metre-long SUV with a 2.7-metre wheelbase sports a bold design, highlighted by an octagonal front grille and split headlamps.

Inside, the Tiggo 8 is equipped with premium features, including a 15.6-inch floating touchscreen infotainment system, a digital instrument cluster, and a 3-spoke flat-bottom steering wheel. It also offers a 12-speaker audio system, wireless charging, am-



bient lighting, and a panoramic sunroof.

On the safety front, the SUV comes with ADAS offering 19 active safety functions, nine airbags, and a built-in dash-cam.

Powering the Tiggo 8 is a 2.0-litre turbo-petrol engine that generates 241 BHP and 390 Nm, paired with a 7-speed dual-clutch automatic gearbox and a ZF-sourced four-wheel-drive system.

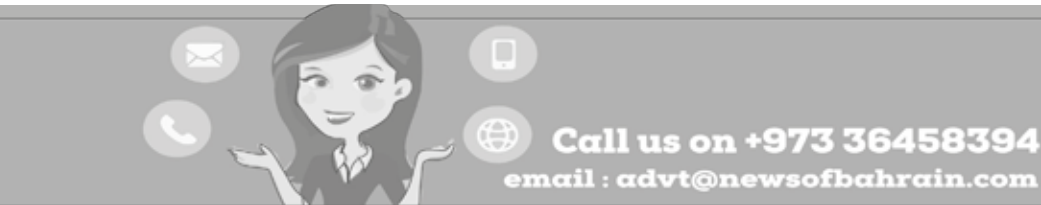

Alcaraz fights back in Tokyo to emulate Nadal with 10th final

Carlos Alcaraz battled back to beat Casper Ruud 3-6, 6-3, 6-4 on Monday in Tokyo and reach his 10th final of a spectacular season, emulating fellow Spaniard Rafael Nadal.

The world number one and US Open champion Alcaraz will face his Laver Cup conqueror Taylor Fritz in Tuesday's decider of the Japan Open.

No man since the legendary Nadal in 2017 has reached 10 finals in a season.

Alcaraz has wowed the crowds this week but he was in danger of being outshone by world number 12 Ruud, who pulled off a series of spectacular winners to take the first set.

Alcaraz, who suffered an ankle injury on Thursday in his opener, regained control in the second set before closing out the match with another ferocious display of power-hitting.

His opponent in the final will be world number five Fritz, the American who beat the Spanish superstar in San Francisco two weeks ago.

"I'm feeling great. Obviously being able to play another

final is always a pleasure," said Alcaraz, who made it ninth straight final going back to Monte Carlo in April.

"It's why we're working, trying to make the final in every tournament I'm

playing. I'm really happy with the way that I'm feeling on court."

Alcaraz picked up from where he left off in his quarter-final win over Brandon Nakashima, pounding Ruud with some huge forehands early in the match.

But the Norwegian had a few tricks up his sleeve as well, drawing applause from Alcaraz when he floated a winner to the baseline from a difficult angle.

Ruud fought off two break points in the seventh game and went on to hold his serve with a swerving ace

down the middle.

He broke Alcaraz in the next game and took the first set when the 22-year-old, beginning to show signs of frustration, hit a return long.

Alcaraz came back strongly, sending down nine aces in the second set alone to tie up the match.

He began to turn on the style and lifted a finger to acknowledge the crowd's applause after hitting a stunning winner midway through the final set.

Alcaraz went on to break Ruud in that game and never looked back, sealing victory with another jackhammer forehand.

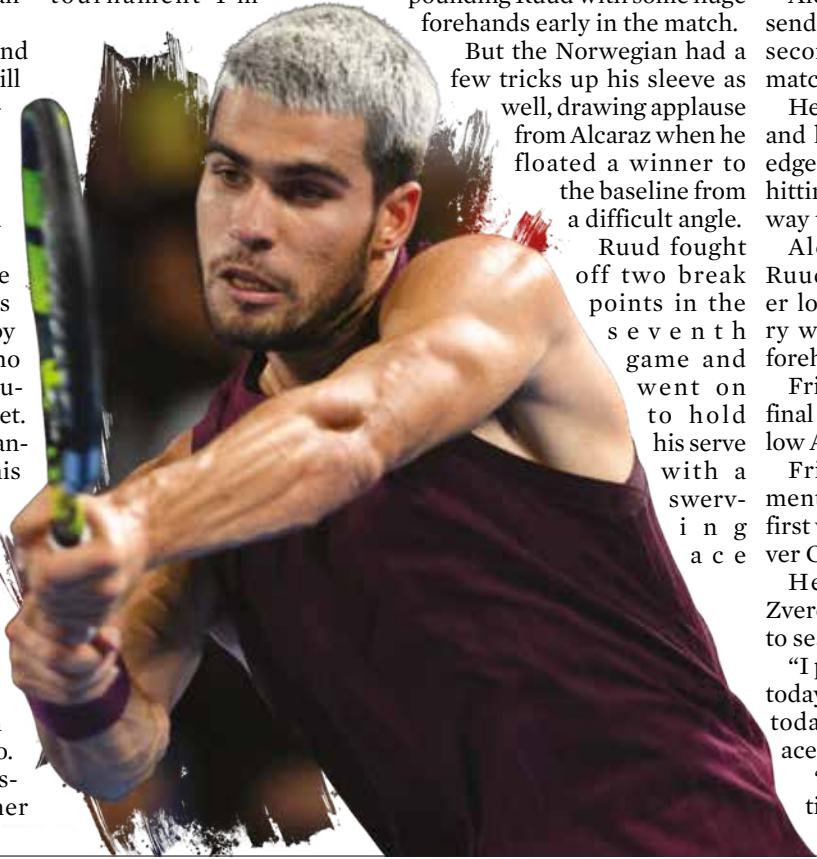
Fritz booked his place in the final with a 6-4, 6-3 win over fellow American Jensen Brooksby.

Fritz came into the tournament fresh from notching his first win over Alcaraz at the Laver Cup.

He also beat Alexander Zverev at the team tournament to seal victory for Team World. "I played a pretty good match today, I think I served my best today," said Fritz, who hit 13 aces.

Wayne Rooney says Manchester United have lost their soul and he has no faith in the ability of beleaguered manager Ruben Amorim to turn things around.

Amorim has taken 34 points from his 33 Premier League games in charge following Saturday's 3-1 loss at Brentford and is yet to oversee consecutive top-flight wins.

United endured their worst league campaign for 51 years last season, finishing an embarrassing 15th in the Premier League.

They spent freely in the summer transfer window, bringing in Matheus Cunha, Bryan Mbeumo and Benjamin Sesko, but are languishing in 14th spot in the table after their latest defeat.

Rooney, United's all-time leading goalscorer, said he goes to games expecting the team to lose.

"I just don't know what's

going on," the 39-year-old said on his BBC podcast.

"I have tried my hand in management and it didn't work out too well, so I get it. Ruben Amorim is my age, he's still a young manager and I'm sure he's got a massive future, but what's going on at Man Utd, this is not Man Utd.

"I honestly hope he can turn it around and he does. But... after everything I've seen, honestly, I've got no faith in it."

Rooney, who won five Premier League titles and the Champions League with United, said he did not recognise the club.

Bahrain's Manama Club suffered their third defeat at the 37th Arab Basketball Championship for Men's Clubs, losing 76-65 to Kuwait SC yesterday in Dubai. Early Tight Battle

In the second quarter, Manama edged ahead 12-13, highlighted by Hassan Nowrooz's quick three-pointer, which prompted a timeout from Kuwait's coach. Mohamed Bualay added another three-pointer, temporarily extending the lead to four points. Kuwait quickly
