cratic march, and to develop laws and legislation that serve the citizens and meet all their needs.

The 258-page annual report of the Council of Representatives includes nine chapters, featuring the Speaker's statement, a summary of the keynote royal speech while opening the second session, and discussions of the Secretariat-General and the sessions.

It also covers the participation of the parliamentary delegation in external events, and the efforts made by the Representatives Council to develop its relations with regional and international parliaments. It also contains

photos, tables, graphs and QR codes to open videos associated with events.

The 169-page Shura Council's annual report consists of an introduction, eight chapters, annexes and a CD containing all the contents of the report.

It contains photos, tables, graphs and statistical information comparing the achievements of the Shura Council in the second session to those of the first.

The introduction includes the Chairman's statement and statistics of the council during the second session, while the chapters highlights the royal keynote speech while inaugurating the second session, in addition to the work of the council's Bureau and standing committees, the discussions of the meetings, and the political statements issued by the council.

RCSI Bahrain adopts blended learning approach

The Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland-Medical University of Bahrain (RCSI Bahrain) has adopted a blended learning approach to open its 2020-21 academic year.

The new system is part of the school's full compliance with the Ministry of Education's regulations to combat COVID-19.

Its blended learning pro-

gramme includes using onsite face-to-face small group teaching sessions, laboratory and practical sessions, as well as live online interactive sessions, delivered by the academic faculty members.

To enhance the learning and teaching process, RCSI Bahrain applied the 'flipped classroom' blended learning approach, which focuses on student participation through active learn-

ing and engagement.

To do so, the on-campus lecture theatres and tutorial rooms were rearranged to include a 'Specktron' screen, which is a large touchscreen computer that acts as a presentation tool for faculty members. Additional TV screens were installed to ensure visibility to students in the back rows.

The lectures are also live streamed to the students attending the lectures from their homes. In addition, the university has acquired a license to 'Turning Point', a live polling system, which promotes greater interactivity.

Students attending a class either face-to-face or online can answer polls and questions posed by the instructor and receive live results through their laptop or mobile device.

RCSI Bahrain president Professor Sameer Ootom said: "There is no doubt that the current academic year is challenging. However, our staff and faculty team have set out extensive plans to ensure that we have a comprehensive strategy to support our students through this period and provide them with the highest quality of teaching".

Construction work: Right on target!

Progress of King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Medical City project moving according to timetable

● AGU is working with its contractors to develop alternative plans and complete the project on time

TDT | Manama

Despite the challenges caused by the coronavirus pandemic, construction work at the King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Medical City is progressing according to the timetable so that the project will be completed by December next year.

It is expected to be operational by the beginning of 2022.

This was confirmed by Arabian Gulf University (AGU) president Dr Khaled Abdul Rahman Al Ohaly who said that while the pandemic has affected the progress of the project, the university is working with its contractors to develop alternative plans to complete the project on time.

He explained that the project cut advanced stages that represent more than 40% of the completion period.

It includes preparations for the next phase such as offering

tenders for the provision of medical devices and furnitures.

The construction work will be implemented in four phases.

The first phase includes the implementation of electricity, water and sewage networks, and fire-fighting, irrigation and rain-water drainage networks, that is in addition to the construction of internal roads and installation of street lighting.

The second phase will be the construction of a main power plant to supply the city with electricity, while the third and fourth phases will include the construction of a sewage plant and the development of the roads networks surrounding and leading to the city.

The King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Medical City is a new major healthcare development being built for the AGU in the Southern Governorate.

It was a grant from the late

King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, who instructed to construct the SR1 billion worth medical city in Bahrain as a gift from the people of Saudi Arabia to the people of Bahrain.

The development aims to become a benchmark for excellence in healthcare and education in the Gulf region.

It will be a multiple phased, mixed use development, comprising an Academic Medical Centre, an innovative teaching hospital built in two phases, a state-of-the-art Medical University Campus with Research and Conference Facilities, on-site accommodation for both staff and students, and other communal facilities to create a self-sustained campus.

The design concept was to create a supportive environment for healing and learning.

Phase 1, the Academic Medical Centre, will offer 269 in-

patient beds, 12 birthing rooms and 11 operating theatres as well as high-quality diagnostic and treatment services in four primary specialties; medicine,

surgery, women's and children's healthcare.

The completion of the development will see the capacity of the hospital increased to over

Al Zayani said that the project would constitute a remarkable model for hosting international conferences, exhibitions and events thanks to its advanced infrastructure equipped with the latest technology and services and in accordance with the highest international standards in the field of exhibition industry.

“It is a catalyst for many sectors to meet the needs of tourism in order to diversify sources of income and achieve the wise visions of His Majesty the King,” he said.

Auction to sell taxi operating cards to individuals

The Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications is preparing to launch the first auction to sell taxi operating cards to individuals.

This step comes in the Ministry's endeavour to develop and regulate the activities of the taxi sector for individuals in the Kingdom of Bahrain, and based on the Memorandum of Understanding that was signed by the Ministry's Land Transport Affairs with Mazad Company BSC to regulate the circulation of taxi licenses.

On this occasion, Land Transport Affairs Assistant Undersecretary Nada Dean said: “This initiative is a preliminary step to strengthening the role of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications to regulate the taxi sector by organising the process of trading taxi operating cards for individuals through an electronic auction through a single trading platform.

“This would contribute to organising the trading process and making it more transparent to everyone, as well as giving the opportunity to the licensee wishing to sell his operational card through electronic platforms.”

Draft of state budget referred to House of Representatives

● BD530 million to fund government projects in two years

The government referred the draft state budget for the fiscal years 2021-2022 to the House of Representatives.

A BD530 million budget will fund government projects in two years, while BD880 million is earmarked as direct government support to citizens.

The draft budget includes an estimate of expected oil revenues of about BD2.9 billion for the next two fiscal years, in addition to non-oil revenues of BD1.1 billion, and returns from “added value” of BD700 million.

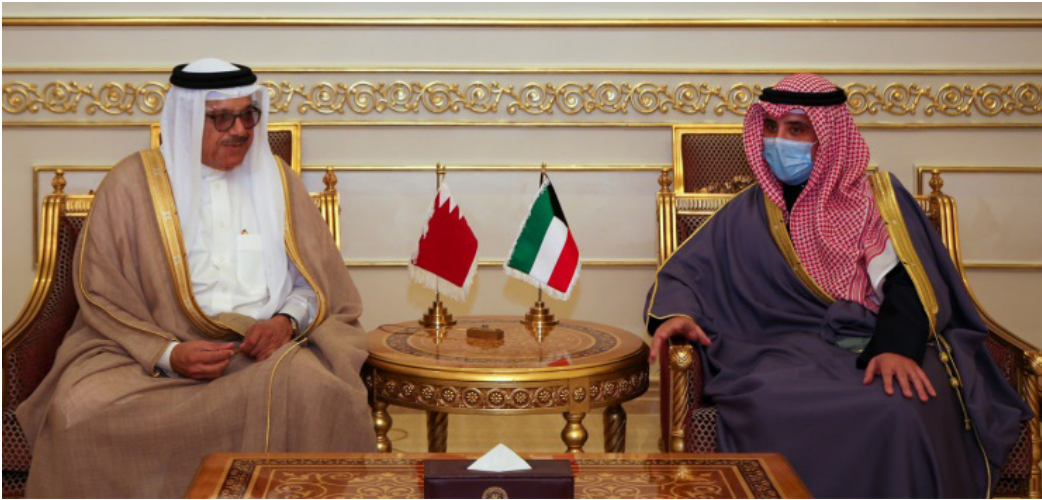
Estimated expenditures amount to about BD3.5 billion

for each fiscal year, of which BD65 million are for projects every fiscal year, while the rest are included in the item “recurring expenditures”.

As for the total deficit, according to government estimates, it is expected to reach BD2.4 billion for the two fiscal years.

The budget to support the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA) in 2021 is about BD48 million. The Authority is expected to achieve the desired balance between its revenues and expenditures in 2022, as part of the fiscal balance program.

BD3.5m Hamad Town Market project deal signed

● **Aims to provide services to residents of Hamad Town and nearby areas**

Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning Minister Eng. Essam bin Abdullah Khalaf has signed a usufruct contract with The Malls Real Estate Development Company for the investment and operation of the popular Hamad Town Market.

Considered one of the strategic projects of the ministry, the agreement will pave the way for the establishment and operation of the market to provide services to the residents of Hamad Town

and its nearby areas.

The Malls Real Estate Development Company Board of Directors chairman Dr Muhammad Jamaan signed the deal in the presence of representatives of Hamad City in the Parliament, Basem Al Maliki, Muhammad Bouhamoud, Youssef Zainal and Abdullah Al Thawadi.

The total cost of the project is BD3.5 million, which The Malls Real Estate Development Company will invest in establishing and operating the market, while the total amount of the usufruct of the ministry during the contract period will be BD3.1 million.

The popular Hamad Town Market project, which is being built on a land area of 12,303 square metres, is an integrated commercial service landmark

that takes the traditional Bahraini Arab character.

It takes into account the needs of citizens, as the market is located in Complex 1212 of Hamad Town on Shaikh Hamad Street and close to Shaikh Street Khalifa bin Salman Highway which is located in the area adjacent to the entrances to Hamad Town Roundabout No. (17).

is abandonment behaviour by residents; their owners could no longer afford to keep them, plain and simple.

Dog lovers and those who either hate dogs or are afraid of them say this problem is the

result of a lack of community and government effort, limited resources and funding, as well as irresponsible dog ownership.

Hundreds of street dogs, including those abandoned by their owners or with owners

that are allowed to roam, have taken up residence in different areas in the Kingdom, and they multiply!

The government must introduce and improve animal protection legislation and initia-

tives, not only to protect humans coming into contact with these animals, but also to protect the health and welfare of the strays themselves.

Spaying and neutering – rather than euthanising them – is the best way to fix the problem.

This is something that active local animal volunteer groups like Bahrain Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (BSPCA) and individuals like Fathiya Al Bastaki, a passionate Bahraini animal lover, are diligently working on. However, they can’t do it alone, and the public plays an important role.

Ultimately, establishing shelters is logical and very efficient step in taking care of abandoned dogs and preventing further growth of its population.

It will also pilot the scheme in Chongqing city and the Hainan free trade zone. In September, the State Administration of Foreign Ex-

change (SAFE) granted fresh quotas under its outbound Qualified Domestic Institutional Investor (QDII) scheme for the first time since April 2019. Last month, Xinhua said fresh quotas worth \$10 billion would be issued in several batches under QDII scheme.

UAE cabinet approves new cybersecurity body, climate change envoy

The United Arab Emirates yesterday approved the establishment of a new national cybersecurity council, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Prime Minister and Vice-President and ruler of Dubai, said on Twitter. The cabinet of the UAE government also appointed Industry and Advanced Technology Minister and head of Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC) Sultan al-Jaber as a special envoy for climate change. Al-Jaber, who holds a PhD in business and economics, is also the chairman of Abu Dhabi's renewable energy company known as Masdar. An advocate for clean energy, al-Jaber has held several positions and advisory roles on issues related to energy, economics and sustainable development.

UK's Raab says next week will be very significant for Brexit deal

The next week will be very significant for Brexit, foreign minister Dominic Raab said on Sunday when asked how near the deadline was in trade talks with the European Union. "This is a very significant week, the last real major week subject to any further postponement," Raab told the BBC. He said negotiations were down to their final two basic issues and a deal was possible if the EU showed some pragmatism.

Israel 2021 budget worth \$129 billion to be presented to PM

Israel's Finance Ministry will present a long awaited 2021 state budget to Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu yesterday that will total 426 billion shekels (\$128.5 billion), a ministry source said yesterday. The source told Reuters that the budget will include 40 to 50 reforms aimed at helping the economy recover from the coronavirus pandemic and does not include any tax increases. Israeli media noted that the 2021 budget to be presented is only 15 billion shekels more than the unapproved

2020 budget and based on a growth estimate of as much as 5 per cent, versus an expected contraction of up to 8pc this year. The Ynet news site quoted

40 The source told Reuters that the budget will include 40 to 50 reforms aimed at helping the economy recover from the coronavirus pandemic

Finance Minister Israel Katz as saying he intends to bring the budget to the cabinet for approval by mid-December. However, Israel's leaders are locked in a political standoff over the budget, so it is unclear whether the budget will be approved. Failure to approve a 2021 budget by March 31 would trigger a snap election, which would be Israel's fourth in two years. The political squabbling has also prevented the 2020 budget from being approved. That must be approved by Dec. 23 or it could trigger a new election.

Italy's UniCredit will hold informal discussions yesterday on governance issues, a person familiar with the matter said, as doubts mount over the future of Chief Executive Jean Pierre Mustier. Mustier's mandate comes up

for renewal in the spring, and three people familiar with the matter said there was a growing rift with the board over strategy which called into question whether he would stay on as CEO. UniCredit declined to comment. A potential bid for bailed-out Monte dei Paschi di Siena and a plan to split UniCredit's domestic and foreign assets are the focus of tensions, the people said. Il Sole 24 Ore reported on Sunday the board was set to discuss conditions set by Mustier to stay on at Italy's only "global systemically important" bank for another three years.

But the person said directors would only have an informal discussion before kicking off the process of renewing the board next week. UniCredit has already said it will put forward former Economy Minister Pier Carlo Padoan for the role of chairman. Seen at risk of leaving UniCredit after presiding over its turnaround, Mustier this year turned down the top job at HSBC. Since his arrival in mid-2016, he has rid UniCredit of most of its problem debts, while raising cash from investors and selling assets for more than 25 billion euros (\$30 billion).

Canada adds extra C\$691 million to agriculture sector

Canada's government said yesterday it will pump an additional C\$691 million (\$531.87 m) to support the country's dairy, poultry and egg farmers, and also reduced the timeline for payment promised to dairy farmers last year. Agriculture Minister Marie-Claude Bibeau said the government slashed its initial eight-year schedule and will deliver the remaining C\$1.405 billion from a total of C\$1.75 bn promised in August 2019, directly to farmers in only three years. The package for dairy farmers also build on a \$250 m CETA on-farm investment program, Bibeau said in a statement. The Canada-European Union Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), the free trade agreement between Canada and the European Union, sets out the removal of tariffs on 99 per cent of all goods types traded between the EU and Canada, some over a period of up to seven years. The government's compensation payments recognize business dairy and poultry farmers have lost out after trade pacts were struck with the European Union and Pacific nations. Bibeau last year promised that Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's government will make no further dairy market-access concessions in other trade negotiations. Dairy Farmers of Canada President Pierre Lampron welcomed the compensation plan. Lampron said the latest move will place the dairy farmer group in a better position to compete with increased imports of dairy products made from foreign milk.

Amazon workers at German warehouse to strike again

Trade union Verdi yesterday called on workers at a German Amazon warehouse to strike for the second time in a week to disrupt the processing of orders following the 'Black Friday' discount shopping sales on Nov. 27. Scheduled to begin on Monday's night shift and finish at the end of Tuesday's late shift, the strike follows on from a three-day walkout between Thursday

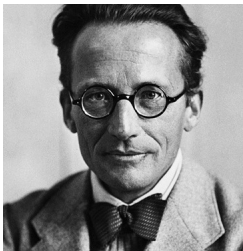

and Saturday last week in which more than 500 workers took part, Verdi said. Verdi has been organising strikes at Amazon in Germany - the company's biggest market after the United States - since 2013, along with other unions hoping to force the e-commerce company to recognise collective bargaining agreements that apply to retail employees at other firms. An Amazon spokesman said last month that the company offered "excellent" salaries,

with benefits and working conditions comparable with other major employers. The US retail giant has seen sales soar globally as restrictions to prevent the spread of the coronavirus sent consumers online, making it difficult for some bricks-and-mortar shops to compete. Verdi argues this has strengthened the case for higher wages, adding workers were not sufficiently protected against the spread of the coronavirus.

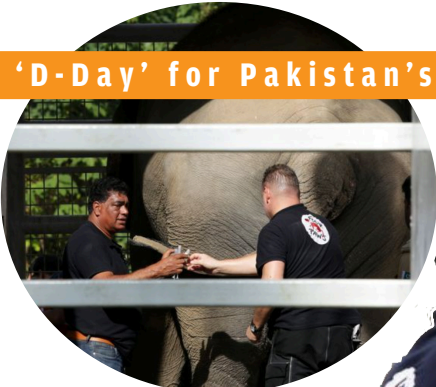

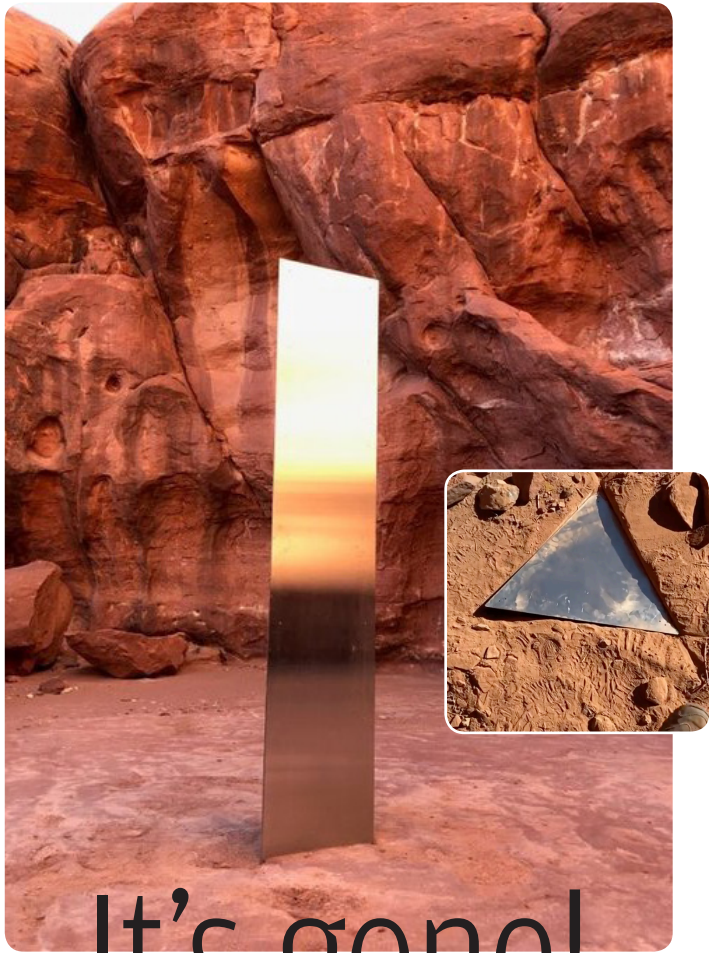

Mysterious metal monolith in Utah desert suddenly vanishes

A mysterious metallic monolith discovered deep in a Utah desert has suddenly vanished just days after it was first spotted by biologists from the air.

The 12-foot-tall structure apparently disappeared Friday night, according to “credible reports,” the Utah Bureau of Land Management said in a statement.

The “illegally installed structure” was removed by an “unknown party,” and not by department personnel, according to the BLM. There will be no investigation into its disappearance by the BLM because the monolith is “private property” and not part of the public lands, the statement added.

The monolith, which eerily resembled a mini version of the structure featured in the classic science-fiction movie “2001: A Space Odyssey,” was installed in the remote red rock country of southeast Utah.

Biologists from the Utah Department of Wildlife Resources spotted it from a helicopter Nov. 18 as they were counting big-horn sheep in the area.

But internet sleuths, using historical images with the help of Google Earth, discovered that the monolith appeared between August 2015 and October 2016, CNET reported. The futuristic TV series “Westworld” was being filmed nearby at the time, noted CNET, which could be a clue to its origins.

State officials quickly debunked the idea that the monolith was placed by space aliens. But they conceded it would have been difficult to place it in such a remote location. Some speculated it was an elaborate art project by artists unknown.

Tourists were flocking to the site in recent days to view the structure.

He made the most of the opportunity and did well to hold on to his lead at the lights. He later was pressured by Hitech Grand Prix's Nikita Mazepin right behind him after a virtual safety car, but was able to extend his gap the rest of the way with clean air in front.

Shwartzman claimed the chequered flag after 23 laps in a total winning time of 43 minutes 15.992 seconds. It was his fourth win of the F2 season and his second in a Sprint Race.

Mazepin followed 5.283 seconds behind as the runner-up to make it a Russian one-two, while taking third was Louis Deletraz of Charouz Racing System, who made a brilliant late charge to secure his podium place 6.472s back.

Marcus Armstrong, who started beside Shwartzman on the front row, came fourth for ART Grand Prix.

Guanyu Zhou of Uni-Virtuosi was an impressive fifth, fending off an exciting challenge from the three cars behind him. They included Christian

Lundgaard in ART's other car, Shwartzman's Prema teammate and championship leader Mick Schumacher, and Feature Race winner Felipe Drugovich of MP Motorsport, who were engaged in some exciting wheel-to-wheel battles. They were classified sixth through eighth, respectively, completing the points scorers.

Early in the race on lap seven, Callum Ilott in the other Uni-Virtuosi car collided with Jehan Daruvala, forcing the Carlin man into an early retirement. Ilott was later handed a drive-through penalty for the incident, dropping him to 18th.

The F2 field returns to action at BIC next weekend in support of the F1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix, which will be the final round of its 2020 season. Racing will be held along BIC's 3.543km Outer Track then.

Hamilton just keeps on winning!

Mercedes superstar avoids plenty of race drama to claim 11th win of 2020 and fourth in F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix at BIC

- **Haas’ Romain Grosjean crashes into barrier moments after race start, resulting in huge explosion and car engulfed in flames**
- **Both cars of Mercedes, Red Bull, McLaren and Renault in top 10**

Seven-time F1 world champion Lewis Hamilton won a drama-filled Formula 1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2020 last night at a brilliantly floodlit Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) in Sakhir.

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Crown Prince and Prime Minister, was at BIC yesterday.

Hamilton crossed the finish line under safety car conditions, as the chequered flag was waved by National Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) member and Bahrain Defence Force (BDF) Hospital Infectious Disease Consultant and Microbiologist Lt Col Dr Manaf Al Qahtani.

Dr Al Qahtani was one of many of the Kingdom’s frontline health workers, first responders and their immediate family members invited to enjoy the event. Their invitation came following the directives of HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, in appreciation of their

tremendous efforts and sacrifices in Bahrain’s national response to COVID-19. The initiative was being held under the theme “#ThankYou_OurHeroes”, and another batch of health professionals and their loved ones will be able to watch next weekend’s F1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix at BIC, which will be the second race of the Kingdom’s first-ever F1 double-header.

The Red Bull pair of Max Verstappen and Alexander Albon joined Hamilton on the podium.

Yesterday’s 57-lap night racing spectacle had three major incidents on track, two of which took place without even a lap being completed.

The first involved Romain Grosjean, who crashed his Haas into the barrier just moments after the start, resulting in an immediate red flag. Following over an hour’s delay, the race was re-started but then Lance Stroll’s Racing Point challenger flipped over, forcing a brief safety car period.

Both Grosjean and Stroll were able to walk away from each incident and they received immediate medical attention. Each instance involved both drivers making contact with AlphaTauri’s Daniil Kvyat.

The third incident took place two laps before the end, when Sergio Perez in the other Racing Point car was third and on his way to a podium finish. But bad luck hit and flames started to come out from the car’s rear, forcing him to pull over and retire. Albon inherited third place.

When racing resumed after Stroll’s flip, Hamilton put in an-

other masterful drive to continue his magnificent winning run this F1 season. He was able to build a massive gap from the rest of the field en route to the finish, but following Perez’s car trouble, the yellow flag came out and it was a crawl to the end behind the safety car.

Hamilton was classified as the winner in a total time of two hours 59 minutes 47.515 seconds, 1.254 seconds ahead of Verstappen and 8.005s in front of Albon.

Following the race, which lasted about three hours including the stoppage, Hamilton commented: “It was physically very demanding. With the break we had at the beginning - you get into a mindset of going out and getting a good start - but with that 45-minute wait we had, it is so easy to step out of the zone.

“They (the Red Bulls) had a lot of speed today so I was flat out all the way trying to keep them at bay.

“It’s physical, this track has always been physical. We’ve got lots of high-speed corners so I was definitely feeling it.

“I managed to just about re-

ply to him (Max Verstappen) when I needed to but I was sliding around a lot out there and I wasn’t really quite sure how it would play out at the end.

“So I’m massively thankful to my team. They did a great job with the strategy and what a privilege it is to get another result like this.”

Fourth win in Bahrain

Hamilton’s victory was the 95th of his F1 career, his 11th of the 2020 season, and his fourth in the Bahrain Grand Prix, tying the record of Ferrari’s Sebastian Vettel. It was also his fifth straight race triumph this year, and second successive at BIC.

Rounding out the points winners from fourth through 10th place, respectively, were McLaren’s Lando Norris and

Carlos Sainz, AlphaTauri’s Pierre Gasly, Renault’s Daniel Ricciardo, Valtteri Bottas in the other Mercedes, Esteban Ocon for Renault and Ferrari’s Charles Leclerc.

The rest of the drivers were classified in the following order: Kvyat, Williams’ George Russell, Ferrari’s Sebastian Vettel, Williams’ Nicholas Latifi, Alfa Romeo’s Kimi Raikkonen and Antonio Giovinazzi, Haas’ Kevin Magnussen and Perez. Perez was classified 18th having completed most of the race.

Grosjean’s incident took place just moments after the start as he clipped the front-left wheel of Kvyat, spun out of control, and then hit the barrier. He was later taken to nearby BDF Hospital for further evaluation. The race was stopped and the other compet-

itors lined up in the pit lane to await its resumption, while the barrier was replaced and the track cleared of oil and debris.

At the first re-start, the drivers lined up on the grid once again but in the positions they were in when Grosjean’s crash took place. Hamilton was able to get away cleanly, followed by Verstappen and Perez. But soon after, Stroll’s car had flipped after making contact with Kvyat on turn eight. That led to a safety car period as his car was being craned off.

That set the stage for Hamilton’s triumph, Perez’s late disappointment and Red Bull’s double podium.
