1,500 China nuke warheads by 2035

Beijing 'significantly' increased efforts to engage with Middle East in 2021: Pentagon

Washington

China and its military "significantly" increased efforts to engage with Middle Eastern countries, according to a Pentagon report released yesterday.

The report on China's military, released annually, also warned that Beijing was on track to have 1,500 nuclear warheads by 2035.

The Pentagon believes China has over 400 nuclear warheads in its current stockpile.

"The (Chinese army) plans to basically complete modernisation of its national defense and armed forces by 2035. If China continues the pace of its nuclear expansion, it will likely field a stockpile of about 1,500 warheads by its 2035 timeline," the report read.

As for the Middle East, the Pentagon highlighted two "key shifts" that China made in 2021 in how it went about the so-called Belt Road Initiative.

China's increased engagement with countries, specifically Iraq, was noticed through its work to begin prioritising public health, digital infrastructure, and green energy opportunities in Middle Eastern countries.

Beijing increased its "Health Silk Road" and "Digital Silk Road" initiatives by providing



global public health leader, and identify the need for new Belt Road Initiative (BRI) projects.

The Digital Silk Road is one way China delivers its technology to other countries, which they try to leverage to "propagate" their own technology standards as they try to set glob-

al standards for next-generation technology, according to the Pentagon.

Some of these methods include Chinese investments in 5G networks, undersea cables and data centers. It also includes satellite navigation systems, artificial intelligence, and quan-

computing for domestic use and export.

"As Beijing's economic interests expand in areas like Africa, Latin America, Central Asia, and the Middle East, we expect to see increased focus on expanding power projection operations globally," the Pentagon said.

In a statement, Japan-based ispace inc. announced it had completed the integration of its HAKUTO-R Mission 1 lunar lander into the SpaceX Falcon 9

"We are pleased to have finished the first phase of the Mission 1 with the final preparations before launch completed," said Takeshi Hakamada, Founder and CEO of ispace.

"To do this, we utilised a design and development model that balanced reliability and low costs by employing proven technologies and components from around the world," he added.

'New booster shots' call as Covid cases rise again

The Ministry of Health has announced that a newly developed Pfizer-BioNTech coronavirus (Covid-19) booster vaccine will be made available at primary healthcare centres across Bahrain from yesterday.

According to sources, the ministry encourages those interested in receiving the booster shot to head directly to their primary healthcare centre without the need to register.

The newly developed bivalent vaccine will be administered as a booster shot and targets the original virus strain and the omicron variant to provide broad protection against Covid-19 and its mutations.

The list of primary health centres and the Pfizer-BioNTech bivalent booster shot is now available on the Ministry of Health's website <https://healthalert.gov.bh>.

The approval of the new

vaccine was taken following a study conducted by the NHRA and the Kingdom's Vaccination Committee at the Ministry of Health, with the support of the study conducted by Pfizer, on the vaccination's quality, safety and efficacy.

Two Covid-19 deaths were reported in the past one week as the death number reached 1,536 yesterday. As of now, there are 1,078 active Covid-19 cases in the Kingdom.

Kingdom's success in containing the spread of the Covid-19 has been attributed to early preparations, high vaccination coverage and continued provision of basic health services by national cadres.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) a few weeks ago launched a case study on the Kingdom's battle victory against Covid-19 at a special event, which was attended by WHO Regional Director for the East-

ern Mediterranean, Dr Ahmed bin Salem Al Mandhari along with health Dr Jaleela Hasan.

charge in line with the concept of welfare state. We are always in the best efforts to ensure the provision of sustainable health services."

The National Medical Taskforce for Combating Covid-19 Pandemic has been urging all those eligible for second or subsequent booster doses to take them without any hesitation.

Booster doses, the Taskforce said, are crucial to raising the immunity and protecting an individual, his family and community from the virus and its variants. "It is crucial to continue strengthening our commitment to precautionary measures to limit the spread of the Covid-19 virus."

The Kingdom's existing success against the pandemic is attributed to its vaccination milestones and preventive measures adopted by the Ministry of Health.

Primary healthcare centres to administer Covid-19 procedures

From December 4, all Covid-19-related testing and vaccination will be administered at primary healthcare centres around the Kingdom, following the closure of the drive-through testing facilities and the vaccination centre in Sitra Mall.

This was announced by the National Medical Taskforce for Combating the coronavirus (Covid-19) yesterday.

The Taskforce added that all Covid-19 triaging and treatment will be centralised at the 'Sehati' building at the Salmaniya Medical Complex, and the make-shift

facility operating at the Bahrain International Hospital will be closed. The Taskforce will also stop publishing the daily statistics report.

Head of the National Medical Taskforce for Combating the coronavirus, Lt General Dr Shaikh Mohamed bin Abdulla Al Khalifa, stressed that the health sector will continue to monitor global developments related to the virus, including the implementation of epidemiological surveillance tools.

The decision has been made after closely following statistics and trends related to hospitalisation rates for Covid-19 patients.

Court upholds 10-year jail term for arsonist

The High Criminal Court of Appeal upheld a 10-year prison sentence for a young man who set three cars and a house on fire.

Public Prosecution charged the defendant for deliberately setting fire three cars owned by two victims on June 20, 2022. The fire then spread to

the house located in East Riffa, endangering people's lives and property.

On June 18, 2022, the defendant resolved to burn the vehicles of one of the two victims due to a personal dispute. He located the victim's house after making inquiries and made plan to burn his cars.

The defendant admitted that on the next day, he prepared



the necessary tools: a large flask to be filled with gasoline and a backpack containing pieces of cloth and a lighter. He took a taxi to a gas station in Awali area and filled the flask with gasoline at a value of BD4.

On the day of the incident, he arrived early and waited for an hour, watching the residential area to ensure that it was free of passersby. Then the defendant

poured gasoline over the first victim's car, lay down pieces of cloth and set them on fire with a lighter.

The flames spread to the victim's two cars, and a third car belonging to the second victim, which was damaged from the back. The fire also surrounded parts of the victims' home which housed their families and children aged between five and 12 years.

Saudi extends term for \$5 bn deposit in Egypt's c.bank-state media

Saudi Arabia has extended the term for a \$5 billion deposit it made to Egypt's central bank, state news agency SPA said yesterday, without saying how long the extension would be.

In March, Saudi Arabia made a \$5 billion deposit in the central bank as Egypt came under increasing financial pressure following Russia's invasion of Ukraine, which pushed up oil and wheat prices and hit tourist numbers from Russia and Ukraine.

Gulf states have deposited at least \$13 bn with Egypt's central bank to support its economy so far this year, bringing their total deposits to \$28 bn, according to central bank and finance ministry data. That includes a further \$5.3 bn of longer-term deposits from Saudi Arabia due to mature in the second half of 2026.

Tata to bolster Air India with Vistara merger

● **Tata group to hold 74.9% of combined entity, SIA 25.1%**

● **SIA to invest \$252 mln into Air India as part of deal**

● **To create a stronger rival to IndiGo, MidEast rivals**

Indian conglomerate Tata Group is merging Air India with Vistara, its joint venture with Singapore Airlines (SIA), to create a bigger full-service carrier that will strengthen its presence in domestic and international skies.


Autos-to-steel conglomerate Tata will hold 74.9% of the combined entity, while SIA (SIAL.SI) will own the remaining 25.1%, the Indian group said in a statement on Tuesday.

SIA will invest \$252 million into Air India as part of the deal, Tata said, with the pair aiming to complete the merger by March 2024, subject to regulatory approvals including from India's aviation ministry, central bank and antitrust watchdog.

Tata Group Chairman N Chandrasekaran said the merger was an important milestone in

efforts to rebuild Air India into a "world-class airline".

"Air India is focusing on growing both its network and fleet,

revamping its customer proposition, enhancing safety, reliability, and on-time performance," Chandrasekaran said.

The proposed merger will create a stronger rival to India's dominant carrier IndiGo (INFL.NS) and give SIA, which

lacks a domestic flying market, a more solid foothold in one of the world's fastest-growing aviation markets.

SIA said in a separate statement it and Tata had agreed to inject additional capital into Air India if required to fund growth and operations over the next two financial years. SIA said it could spend up to \$615 million based on its 25.1% post-completion stake, payable after the merger is sealed.

Vistara, in which SIA holds a 49% stake, forms an integral part of its multi-hub strategy, the Singaporean airline said in a statement to its local stock exchange.

The proposed deal would enable SIA to "immediately gain exposure to an entity that is four to five times larger in scale compared to Vistara", with access to slots and air traffic rights at key Indian and international airports, it added.

The deal will allow Tata to consolidate its brands around full-service Air India and low-cost Air India Express, which is being merged with AirAsia India after the Indian group bought out former partner AirAsia (AIRX.KL).

Tata's combined airlines will have an Indian market share of 24%, making it the largest domestic carrier after IndiGo, which has a 56% share, and a stronger competitor to full-service Middle Eastern rivals that



Air India, with its maharajah mascot, was once known for its lavishly decorated planes and stellar service. But its reputation declined in the mid-2000s as financial troubles mounted. It was criticised for business class seats in poor repair, customers faced delays and staff and suppliers were not always paid on time. The airline, founded by JRD Tata in 1932 and nationalised in 1953, returned to the Tatas' control in January.

carry a large share of international traffic.

It will give Tata a fleet of 218 aircraft, split between plane-makers Boeing and Airbus (AIR.PA), flying to a combined 38 international and 52 domestic destinations. This will make it India's largest international carrier.

Air India has plans to lease 30 Boeing and Airbus planes, expanding its fleet by more than 25% in the near term. It is also considering a mega-order for up to 300 narrowbody and 70 widebody jets, according to industry sources.

India asked by sanctions-hit Russia for parts for key sectors

Moscow has sent India a list of more than 500 products for potential delivery including parts for cars, aircraft and trains, four sources familiar with the matter said, as sanctions squeeze Russia's ability to keep vital industries running.

The list, a version of which has been seen by Reuters in New Delhi, is provisional and it is unclear how many of the items will eventually be exported and in what quantity, but an Indian government source said the request was unusual in its scope.

An industry source in Moscow, who declined to be named because of the sensitivity of the issue, said Russia's Ministry of Industry and Trade

asked large companies to supply lists of raw materials and equipment they needed.

The source added that further discussion would be needed to agree specifications and volumes and that the outreach was not limited to India.

Tesla readies revamped Model 3 with project 'Highland' -sources

Tesla (TSLA.O) is developing a revamped version of Model 3, according to four people with knowledge of the effort, as the top EV maker aims to cut production costs and boost the appeal of the five-year-old electric sedan.

One focus of the redesign codenamed "Highland" is to reduce the number of components and complexity in the interior of the Model 3 while focusing on features that Tesla buyers value, including the display, according to the people, who asked not to be named because the revamp has not been announced.

The previously unreported redesign comes as the electric

sedan faces increased competition from models from the likes of China's BYD (002594.SZ), Hyundai (005380.KS) and coming releases from other major automakers.

The revamp of the battery-powered sedan, which could also include some changes to the Model 3's exterior and powertrain performance, will go into production at Tesla's

factory in Shanghai and the company's Fremont, California plant, two of the people said. Tesla's Shanghai Gigafactory will put the redesigned Model 3 into production in the third quarter of 2023, they said.

It was not clear when production would start at the Fremont plant or how large a cost savings Tesla would achieve from the redesign.

Adani's firm wins bid to develop vast Mumbai slum

The real estate unit of Indian billionaire Gautam Adani's Adani Enterprises (ADEL.NS) has won the right to redevelop India's largest slum, Mumbai's Dharavi neighbourhood, with a 50 billion rupee (\$612 million) bid, a state official said yesterday.

Adani's winning bid of 50 billion rupees was more than double that of real estate group DLF, which bid 20 billion rupees (\$244.87 million), said SVR Srinivas, CEO of the Dharavi Redevelopment Project, a government enterprise in the western state of Maharashtra.

It was a beautiful Friday afternoon. The weather was fine as ever. Strolling through a tropical landscape to enjoy a marvelous meal was nothing short of a dream. A cool breeze wafted through the hues of blue of the Arabian Sea to calm my mind and relax me.

Novotel Al Dana Resort located in Manama is a sight to behold. If you are looking for the next place to enjoy a brunch with a sea view this Friday, your search ends here. A cozy restaurant located by the beach, Fishbone has been rightly positioned as the destination for an authentic Italian brunch

experience. The brunch at Fishbone is a complete package that pleases all the senses.

There are two ways of getting to the restaurant; you could either drive directly to the restaurant, or park at the main parking lot and walk through the hotel. I chose the latter because I did not want to miss out on the picturesque details such the traditional touch to the architectural design, the pergola walkways, the swimming pool bustling with cheerful guests, the serenity of the greenery and the beach.

I wanted to experience the indoor as well as outdoor seating. They have very a comfortable, air-conditioned indoor ambience. The large glass panels of the restaurant ensure that you do not miss out on the beautiful view of the beach and the sea. It takes a good meal to take your eyes off a view like that and I can say without a second thought that it did.

Upon being welcomed into the restaurant, I made myself comfortable on the well-cushioned, fish print designed chair and glanced at the beverage menu while listening to the live DJ music. An aperol spritz and mint lemonade were the ideal beverages to quench my thirst and prepare my taste buds for the meal. Unlike other buffet style brunches, the brunch at Fishbone is served at the table. The food arrives at the table hot, fresh and when you are ready. The menu has been tastefully orchestrated and does not disappoint. Beginning with the bread basket, the freshly

baked focaccia, bread sticks and Tuscan bread paired perfectly with the fresh and light dips - a very light labneh with extra virgin olive oil, a tomato dip prepared with balsamic vinegar and an olive tapenade.

Next on the table was a duet of hot appetizers; arancini and 'Crisps of the Sea'. Arancini are delicious rice balls prepared with Arborio risotto, coated



the lightly battered, golden and crisp calamari and zucchini. I particularly enjoyed the spicy tomato jam.

The salads arrived in all their colorful vibrancy. I ordered two salads - Mango quinoa salad and 'Rock the dates'. Both the salads were delightfully fresh. The quinoa salad had good texture and derived its flavors from the tart mango and red grapes. My favorite salad was 'Rock the dates'. I highly

flawlessly cooked, chunky fillet of fish. The lemon caper sauce had a perfect consistency - flowy and slightly thickened due to the flour which was used to coat the fish. The seared vegetables included bell peppers, eggplant, broccoli, carrot and charred lemon. I would crown this top dish of the day.

The beef stufato was slow cooked, pulled beef brisket served with au jus and creamy mashed potatoes. It was very delightful and rich. The stuffed chicken consisted of spinach stuffed chicken breasts in a creamy white sauce.

Head Chef Ali Ismail who is a seasoned industry professional, explained how the brunch was developed to be authentic Italian with some dishes that could not be found at other restaurants.

in breadcrumbs and deep fried until golden brown. These arancini were prepared with mushroom risotto. The rice was cooked to perfection and the combination of cheese used in the filling gave each bite a delicious, salty kick and paired well with the accompanying sauces. Arancini originates from the beautiful island of Sicily which is




recommend this salad. I finished the whole bowl despite being someone who is very picky when it comes to salads. What makes this salad very special is the extremely smart combination of textures and flavors of arugula/ rocca leaves, dates, parmesan, sliced almonds and the pomegranate molasses dressing. After that delightful salad, it was time to order the main course. I would like to mention that they have a couple of tasty vegetarian items on the main course menu, but the Branzino (Mediterranean seabass) caught my attention.

The seabass platter had a medley of steamed vegetables and a lemon caper sauce. The fish had a light dusting of flour that helped with the exterior crust and was tender and flakey as it was cooked with the utmost attention by the chef. It was such an impressive,



breath-takingly beautiful just like the view I was enjoying.

The 'Crisps of the Sea' is a basket of batter-fried calamari and zucchini that is served with spicy tomato jam, spicy avocado sauce and tartar sauce. Each condiment paired perfectly with

Who could possibly leave without relishing dessert? I ordered two desserts; panna cotta and tiramisu and decided to enjoy these outdoors at their terrace. The panna cotta was scrumptious with speckles of vanilla bean and beautifully set. The fresh berries gave it a pop of acidity that cut through the creamy richness of the panna cotta. The tiramisu was light,

not overly sweet and had a pronounced espresso flavor. The texture was spot on as well.

This brunch experience at Fishbone takes you on a delightful journey and makes you appreciate the little things in life - fresh air, the beauty of nature while enjoying magnificent Italian delights.

◆ Israeli troops shot dead three Palestinians in the occupied West Bank yesterday, Palestinian officials said, before a suspected car-ramming attacker was killed after seriously wounding a woman, Israeli medics and the army said. The army confirmed its troops had fired on "rioters" who attacked soldiers in two separate West Bank clashes overnight. The 20-year-old woman was in "severe condition" with a head injury following the suspected car-ramming north of Jerusalem, medics said. Jerusalem's Shaare Tzedek hospital confirmed the alleged attacker had been killed.

◆ Former boxing referee Carlos Padilla has admitted cheating to help fellow Filipino Manny Pacquiao defeat Australian Nedal "Skinny" Hussein in a fight more than two decades ago. Pacquiao was 21 and a rising star when he went 10 rounds against Hussein for the WBC International super-bantamweight title near the Philippine capital Manila in 2000. But in a stunning confession, Padilla -- known for refereeing the "Thrilla in Manila" between Muhammad Ali and Joe Frazier in 1975 -- said he helped Pacquiao secure victory by "prolonging" the standard 10-count when the Filipino was knocked down and left dazed in the fourth round. "I am a Filipino and everybody is Filipino watching the fight, so I prolong the count. I know how to do it," Padilla, who was recently inducted into the Nevada Boxing Hall of Fame, said in an interview posted on the World

Boxing Council's YouTube page. "When he get up I said to him 'hey are you okay?' -- and that's prolonging the fight," a smiling Padilla said. Pacquiao later headbutted Hussein, leaving the Australian with a cut above his left eye. But Padilla classified the head clash as a "punch". Pacquiao won by a technical knockout after the doctor stopped the fight due to Hussein's bleeding. "I declare it a punch but it's (a headbutt)," Padilla said, which allowed the fight to continue.

The tree only lights up fully while someone keeps pedalling really hard, which encourages families with their kids to stop and give it a try. The bicycle also charges a battery that, along with solar panels, powers up the rest of the lights around the Budapest square. "One the one hand, we keep moving in this cold weather. On the other, we can experience how much one needs to pedal to light up a six meter-high Christmas tree decoration," said Gergely Orsi, the mayor of Budapest's 2nd district. "For us, it shows an exam-

ple that sustainability is the future." His municipality decided to cancel most of the usual Christmas light decorations this year due to the energy crisis. "Every year this square is decorated beautifully. We would have been sad if we did not have them this year, but I think this is an excellent compromise," a local resident, Nora, said after she had pedalled the bicycle with her young son watching.

Iran general says over '300 dead'

Iran has for the first time reported that more than 300 people have died in over two months of protests sparked by the death of Mahsa Amini in police custody.



A wave of unrest has rocked Iran since Mahsa Amini, 22, died on September 16 after her arrest by the morality police in Tehran for allegedly breaching the country's dress code for women and the Islamic republic now says more than 300 people died in the unrest

The Islamic republic has deployed state security forces against what it labels "riots" that broke out after the 22-year-old died on September 16, three days after her arrest for allegedly breaching Iran's dress code for women.

"Everyone in the country has been affected by the death of this lady," said Brigadier General Amirali Hajizadeh of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) in a video published by the Mehr news agency.

"I don't have the latest figures, but I think we have had perhaps more than 300 martyrs and people killed," among them some of "the best sons of the country", said Hajizadeh, head of the Guards' aerospace division.

The Iranian toll includes those who have taken to the streets as well as dozens of police, troops and Basij paramilitary force members who have died in clashes with demonstrators or who were killed elsewhere.

The latest official toll is much

closer to figures published by human rights groups based abroad.

Oslo-based non-governmental organisation Iran Human Rights said at least 448 people had been "killed by security forces in the ongoing nationwide protests", in an updated toll issued on Tuesday.

The group says its toll includes those killed in violence related to the Amini protests and in distinct unrest in the southeastern province of Sistan-Baluchistan, which borders Pakistan and Afghanistan.

Thousands of Iranians and around 40 foreigners have been arrested and more than 2,000 people have been charged, according to judicial authorities.

200 fishermen rescued from drifting ice in US lake

About 200 early-season ice fishers were caught by surprise and stranded in a Minnesota lake when the frozen slab under their feet broke free and drifted into open water -- triggering a complex rescue operation.



Ice fishing is a popular winter sport in the northern US state of Minnesota, the so-called Land of 10,000 Lakes

A member of the group called emergency services Monday when they realized the people ice fishing -- a popular winter sport in the northern US state known as the Land of 10,000 Lakes -- were slowly drifting away from the shoreline of Upper Red Lake, local police said on Facebook.

"The Beltrami County Sheriff's Office and other first responders arrived on scene and discovered a large portion of the ice with up to 30 yards (27 meters) of open water stranding the fishermen," Chief Deputy Jarrett Walton said in a statement.

Some of the group had not even realized the ice floe had snapped free. But "due to the

urgent nature of getting people off the ice," Beltrami County sent out an alert to the fishermen's cellphones to notify them they would soon be rescued in an emergency evacuation.

The alert "allowed notifications to be sent to cell phones of those who are not enrolled in the local notification system and provided GPS coordinates of the evacuation site," the sheriff's department said.

It took over three hours to complete the evacuate from the

ice. "A number of apparatus were deployed including airboats, water rescue boats, ATVs, drones and a temporary bridge," the sheriff's department said.

It also warned other local fishermen to use "extreme caution" on unsteady ice.

"The Beltrami County Sheriff's Office reminds those who are thinking of heading on the ice that early season ice is very unpredictable," the statement said.

Dwayne Johnson convinced 'Black Adam' makers to onboard Henry Cavill







Louis van Gaal's Dutch side ended with seven points at the top of Group A, while Senegal joined them in the knockout phase as runners-up after beating Ecuador 2-1.

The Oranje will next take on the second-placed team from Group B for a quarter-final spot on Saturday.

Koulibaly sinks Ecuador to fire Senegal into knockouts

Kalidou Koulibaly sent Senegal into the World Cup knockouts for just the second time in their history with the winner in yesterday's dramatic 2-1 win over Ecuador.

The Netherlands' dominant victory in the other match meant only a win would see Senegal through to the knockouts from Group A, while Ecuador would have progressed with a draw.

Senegal opened the scoring through Ismaila Sarr's penalty late in the first half, but despite managing to keep Ecuador captain Enner Valencia quiet throughout, Brighton's Moises Caicedo levelled in the 67th minute before Koulibaly sent his team through and Ecuador

home.

Senegal manager Aliou Cisse promised before the game his experienced side "would not overthink" the occasion and it was the Africans who opened the game furiously, with Everton's Idrissa Gana Gueye lashing the ball just wide of an open goal

after only three minutes.

Less than a minute later, Ecuador goalkeeper Hernan Galindez needed to bail out his side's high backline, sliding in to stifle a counter well outside his box.

On the 10 minute mark, Senegal's Boulaye Dia found himself one-on-one with Galindez, but

he cut the ball just wide of the post.

Seemingly sparked into life by Senegal's fierce opening, Ecuador pushed forward and won a free-kick 30 metres from goal, with the South Americans taking the opportunity for a rare breather before Valencia slammed the ball into the wall.

After the furious opening exchanges, both sides began to settle and the first half looked set to end goalless before Ecuador defender Piero Hincapie clattered into Sarr, giving referee

Clement Turpin no choice but to point to the spot.

Sarr stepped up and coolly dispatched a fine spot-kick past Galindez, maintaining eye contact with the keeper as the ball went in.

Ecuador started the second half fresher and more determined, perhaps reassured that the Netherlands' dominance meant they only needed a draw to go through.

From a free-kick, defender Felix Torres rose high to head the ball on to Caicedo, who was waiting at the far post and slammed the ball home.

Senegal struck back immediately and in almost identical fashion, with Koulibaly lurking unmarked at the far post following a free-kick which was deflected into his path by Hincapie.

Coming into the match on a yellow card, Gueye picked up a second-half booking and will miss Senegal's last-16 game against the winners of Group B.

My first goal could have been Ronaldo's, says Portugal's Fernandes

“I am focusing on the 24 play-


ers who are here. I'll let you talk about that and debate it if you want, but I am not going to talk about things that don't affect what we are doing here from day to day.”
