Karzakkan project reaches 40 percent completion rate

The project to construct a port and parking lots on the coast of Karzakkan (Block 1027) in the Northern Governorate has reached about 40 percent completion rate.

The Ministry of Works said that the project aims to enhance the ease of movement of citizens and their access to the coast.

It added that works include the construction of a 1.1 km long port and the construction of car parks for coastal visitors by making dirt leveling and laying layers of burial and paving with asphalt.

New lighting poles will be installed, and a number of ground channels will be laid for use by
