## **Dele Alli signs new Spurs deal**

England midfielder Dele Alli has signed a new long-term contract, keeping him at Tottenham until 2024, the Premier League club announced yesterday.

The 22-year-old joined Spurs in 2015 and has scored 48 goals in 153 competitive appearances for the club.

He joins Harry Kane, Son Heung-min, Davinson Sanchez and Harry Winks in signing long-term deals at the club in recent months.

"We are delighted to announce that Dele Alli has signed a new contract with the Club, which will run until 2024," Spurs said on their website.

"The midfielder joined us as a teenager from boyhood club MK Dons in 2015 and immediately set about making an impact in the Premier League, being named PFA Young Player of the Year and earning a spot in the PFA Team of the Year in each of his first two seasons with us."

## **Injured Varane out** for up to a month

The 25-year old left the field after 45 minutes in the club's 5-1 defeat to Barcelona on Sunday.

"He's been diagnosed with a groin injury to his right leg," Real said in a statement without noting how long the French international would be out for.

AS said he would be sidelined for up to a month, meaning he could miss France's games in November against the Netherlands and possible Uruguav.

He will also miss Real's fixtures against Melilla in the Spanish Cup on Wednesday, Saturday's league match against Valladolid, and the midweek trip to victoria Pizen in the Champions League. He will also be out for the following weekend league match against Vigo.
